BYU will play its fourth-straight neutral site game when the Cougars face Oregon in Salt Lake on Dec. 3 at 3 p.m. MST, in EnergySolutions Arena. Listen live on the radio beginning with the pregame show at 2 p.m. MST on KSL Newsradio 102.7 FM and 1160 AM or via the Internet at KSL.com. The game will be televised live on ESPNU.

#### **QUICK HITS**

- Senior Noah Hartsock has been BYU's most consistent contributor this season, averaging 16.8 points, 5.7 rebounds, 2.0 assists, 2.0 blocks and 1.0 steal per game. He is shooting .606 from the field, .500 from three and .773 from the free throw line and is the only BYU player to score in double figures in every game so far this season.
- Freshman Anson Winder has seen significant playing time at point guard the last four games, including starts in the last two. In those four games Winder has averaged 7.0 points, 4.0 assists and has an assist/turnover ratio of 2.7 to 1, first in the West Coast Conference.
- BYU leads the West Coast Conference in four categories (FG %, 3-Pt FG %, blocks, assists) and is second in the league in five (scoring offense, scoring defense, 3-Pt FG % def, rebounding defense, defensive rebounds).
- Seniors Noah Hartsock and Charles Abouo led BYU against Nevada. Hartsock tied his career high with 21 points on 9 of 12 shooting and Abouo hit 8 of 12 from the field and 4 of 5 from three for 22 points.
- Dave Rose is one of the most successful coaches in the history of BYU basketball. He is second in program history in wins (163), first in winning percentage (.776) and has led the Cougars to five-straight NCAA Tournament berths and four conference titles. He also earned three Mountain West Conference Coach of the Year awards.

**6** The number of 20-win seasons for BYU head coach Dave Rose. He is the second coach in BYU history to begin his career with six-straight 20-win seasons. Rose is tied with Roger Reid and Stan Watts for the most 20-win seasons in BYU history. Rose also has five 25-win seasons, a program record.

15 The number of 3-pointers BYU made against Longwood (15 of 26, 57.7 percent). The 15 threes ties the BYU single-game record, set previously against UNLV in 2007 and at Air Force in 2011.

17 The number of points BYU allowed in the first half against BYU-Hawaii, the fewest since Mississippi Valley State scored 10 in the first half on Nov. 23, 2010.

**27** The number of 3-pointers BYU hit during a two-game stretch (vs. Longwood and Prairie View A&M). The 27 3s are a BYU record for most 3s in a two-game stretch. The Cougars shot .563 (27 of 48) from three during the two games.

51 The number of rebounds for BYU against BYU-Hawaii, the most by a Cougar squad since posting 57 vs. Mississippi Valley State on Nov. 23, 2010.

**163** BYU head coach Dave Rose's win total. He is second all-time in career wins at BYU behind Stan Watts (371 victories from 1949-72), a member of the Basketball Hall of Fame.

# LAST TIME OUT - BYU VS. WISCONSIN

HOFFMAN ESTATES, Illinois – After playing a strong first half, the BYU men's basketball team struggled in the second period and fell 73-56 to the No. 11 Wisconsin Badgers in the Chicago Invitational Challenge Championship on Saturday night.

Senior Noah Hartsock scored 18 points and added six rebounds and four blocks, both team highs. No other Cougar scored in double digits, but Brandon Davies and Damarcus Harrison contributed nine points apiece while Charles Abouo and Stephen Rogers managed six apiece.

Hartsock and Abouo were named to the All-Tournament Team. Hartsock averaged 17.3 points and five boards while Abouo added 15 points and 8.8 boards throughout the Chicago Invitational Challenge. BYU struggled from beyond the arc and hit just 1 of 10 treys. Wisconsin countered the Cougars' struggles by nailing 13 of 24 from three, a 54.2 percent rate. BYU did manage to force the Badgers into a season high 12 turnovers.

Wisconsin jumped out to a quick 9-4 lead behind two Jordan Taylor threes. The Badgers expanded the lead to 17-8 by hitting their first six

shots, including five treys. Although they trailed by nine, the Cougars started strong by hitting four of their first five shots.

The Cougars took their first lead since they led 2-0 at the 5:11 mark after Stephen Rogers nailed a jump shot to put BYU up 28-26. Hartsock led the 18-4 BYU run with his eight first half points. Wisconsin ended the half on a short 8-4 run to take a 34-32 lead into the locker room. Wisconsin took a 42-38 lead quickly out of the half before the Cougars tied the game at 42-42 by forcing Badger turnover and taking it for a layup. The Badgers responded to the tie with an 11-0 run, which swung the momentum to Wisconsin and made the score 53-42.

The Badgers continued to pull away from BYU, largely due to the second half play of Taylor and Ben Brust. Taylor finished with 18 points while Brust nailed 7 of 10 threes, including five in the second half, to finish with a game-high 21 points. BYU worked to finish the game strong but finished with just 24 points in the second half. Hartsock led the Cougars with 10 second half points.

#### FRESHMEN FINDING THEIR WAY

Several freshmen came up big in BYU's 92-60 victory over Longwood. Damarcus Harrison hit 3 of 5 threes and both of his free throw attempts for 11 points. Anson Winder had his first career points and assists, hitting 2 of 4 threes for eight points and dishing out five assists. Nate Austin and Josh Sharp pitched in down low as Austin had four points, three boards and a block and Sharp had one point, three assists and four rebounds. In all, the four newcomers totaled 24 points, 10 assists, eight rebounds and one block.

The freshmen had another impressive outing against Prairie View A&M. Winder totaled 11 points and four assists and Sharp contributed five points and six boards. In all the newcomers totaled 23 points, 10 rebounds, seven assists and two steals.

#### NO. I WON'T GET OUT OF YOUR WAY

Junior Forward Brandon Davies has made a habit of making the opposition pay when driving to the basket. Against Utah State, Davies drew four charges. He took three charges against BYU-Hawaii, two against Prairie View A&M and one against Nevada to bring his season total to 10. Nate Austin assumed Davies' role against Longwood, taking three charges.

#### **GOING GREEK**

BYU men's basketball went on a 10-day, four-game tour of Greece in August. The Cougars won their first two games against the Athens All-Stars (88-56) and ASE Doukas (114-45) while also playing a friendly game against US Navy personnel on a base in Crete. While in Greece, BYU was invited to participate in the Acropolis of Athens Tournament against the Greek and Italian National Teams, both ranked among the top 10 in the world by FIBA. Against Greece, Stephen Rogers led BYU with 20 points in an 83-54 loss. Brock Zylstra exploded for 26 points and four 3-pointers in BYU's 102-63 loss to an Italian team that featured three NBA stars.

#### **NEW HOME**

In 2011-12, BYU men's basketball enters its first season as a member of the West Coast Conference. The Cougars have played each member of the league at least twice all time. Last season, BYU defeated St. Mary's 74-73 in the South Padre Island Invitational championship game and Gonzaga 89-67 in the third round of the NCAA Tournament to advance to the Sweet 16. ### **COACHING STAFF**

For the second-straight season there was a change to the coaching staff. Former associate head coach Dave Rice, who had been with the staff since Rose became the head coach in 2005, left to take the head job at his alma mater, UNLV. Rose hired Mark Pope as an assistant coach in May 2011. Pope comes to BYU after one season as an assistant at Wake Forest. Prior to Wake Forest, Pope was the director of basketball operations at Georgia. Pope played his college ball at Washington and Kentucky. In 1996, he was a team captain and helped Kentucky win the NCAA National Championship. Pope was selected by he Indiana Pacers in the second round of the NBA draft and played seven seasons in the NBA. He played in the Eastern Conference Finals with Indiana (1998) and Milwaukee (2001).

Nate Austin and Ian Harward are true freshman and are coming off two-year missions for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. 
