Big Weekend: UCLA and National Championship Banner

PROVO, Utah (Jan. 25, 2005) – The BYU men's volleyball team will be back in Provo for a showdown with the No. 1 team in the nation, the UCLA Bruins, Friday and Saturday at 7 p.m. The 2004 team will be honored by the unveiling of the National Championship banner before Friday's match.

Historically, UCLA has dominated the world of NCAA men's volleyball, having won 18 National Championships, the most recent in 2000. The Cougars have replaced the Bruins as the team to beat in the last six years though, winning the championship in 1999, 2001 and 2004.

Almost all the players from the 2004 team will be in attendance to be honored before the match on Friday for their amazing run to the National Championship. The team included four All-Americans, including BYU's first AVCA National Player of the Year, Carlos Moreno, fellow First-Team All-American Fernando Pessoa, and Second Teamers Victor Batista and Joe Hillman. Only Batista is playing with the current squad.

Coach Tom Peterson said he hopes the Fieldhouse will be packed to honor the 2004 team and cheer the current group on to victory.

"It will be a fun night for the crowd," Peterson said. "I hope we have to turn people away at the gates because we are so full. The crowd support helps us so much. We have the best fans in the country."

The Bruins own the best record in the country at 7-0 overall and 3-0 in the Mountain Pacific Sports Federation. UCLA's record includes wins over Long Beach State, Cal Baptist, Pepperdine, and UC Irvine.

"They'll be the best team we play," Peterson said. "Most people would consider them to be the team to beat this season."

Peterson said BYU will need to be on top of its game to defeat the Bruins.

"We will have to overcome all the ups and downs we've had," Peterson said. "We'll have to play a great match to beat them. We can't have the same ups and downs we've had in the last few weeks. This could determine who wins the regular season in the MPSF."

The Cougars split two matches with UC Santa Barbara last weekend and now stand at 5-2 overall and 1-1 in the MPSF. BYU fell in four games on Friday in a match filled with errors and missed opportunities. The Cougars were on fire Saturday as they swept the

The Peterson File

Tom Peterson, BYU alum and the 1994 NCAA Coach of the Year, enters his third year as the head coach of the Cougar men's volleyball program. Peterson led the Cougars to a 29-4 record last season and the team's third National Championship. Under his guidance, the 2004 team also won the MPSF regular season and post-season tournament, becoming only the second team in Cougar history to win both titles in the same year. In 2003, he guided BYU to second place finishes at the national championship and the MPSF regular season and a first place finish in the MPSF post-season tournament.

Peterson's career record currently stands at 309-143 with stints coaching the Penn State men's team and the women's teams at Salt Lake Community College, Utah State, and New Mexico. Before his NCAA coaching career, Peterson also coached the BYU men's club team from 1984-88.

Peterson came to BYU in 2002 with over 20 years of volleyball coaching experience, including 17 years of collegiate head-coaching experience. He is the only coach to win a National Championship at two different schools (Penn State, 1994 and BYU, 2004).

The Rankings Game

The Cougars fell from their No. 2 ranking after splitting two matches with UC Santa Barbara. BYU is now the No. 3 team in the country according to the USA Today/CSTV Top 15 Division I-II Men's Coaches Poll. With two matches against UCLA this weekend, the No. 1 team in the country, the Cougars will have a chance to move back up in the rankings.

Cougars Get Offensive

A day after one of their worst hitting nights of the season, the Cougars had their best Saturday, hitting .506 (52-10-83) in their sweep of UC Santa Barbara. Batista's big night was a major reason for the high percentage but Russell Holmes and Rob Neilson had four and two kills respectively without errors. Taylor Evans had a season-best 13 kills while hitting .455 (13-3-22).

The Bruin Bulletin

The UCLA Bruins have been very impressive throughout the 2005 season, starting undefeated at 7-0 overall and 3-0 in the MPSF. Middle blocker Paul Johnson has been dominant for the Bruins, averaging 3.46 kills per game while hitting .521. Opposite hitter Steve Klosterman and outside hitter Jonathan Acosta are second and third on the team in kills averaging 3.17 and 3.12, respectively. As a team, UCLA is out-hitting its opponents .358 to .259. UCLA's undefeated start includes a five-game win over Cal Baptist and sweeps against UC Irvine, Long Beach State and Pepperdine.

BYU vs. UCLA

The Bruins and Cougars will be meeting for the 35th and 36th times. UCLA owns the all-time series with a 23-11 advantage. BYU has won six of eight and five straight at home. These will be some of the most important matches of the season as they could determine the MPSF regular-season champions.

Next up for the Cougars

Following Friday and Saturday's matches with UCLA, the Cougars will hit the road and head east to Springfield, Mass. for the Hall of Fame Classic. It will BYU's first appearance in the annual tournament. The Cougars will face Ball State in the first round on Friday, Feb. 4, and Penn State or Springfield College on Saturday in the second.

2005 Season Outlook

The BYU men's volleyball team enters its third season under Tom Peterson on top of the collegiate volleyball world. The Cougars claimed the 2004 National Championship, BYU's third in six years, by defeating Long Beach State in five games. The team showed great composure in the championship match, coming back from a 10-6 deficit and two Long Beach match points in the final game to claim the match.

Even with the loss of three All-Americans in setter Carlos Moreno, outside hitter Fernando Pessoa, and opposite-side hitter Joe Hillman, and two other starters in Jon Alleman and Shawn Olmstead, the Cougars have reloaded and are ready to make their third straight trip to the NCAA Final Four. In 2003, the Cougars finished second in the nation after losing to Lewis in the championship match. The Cougars return second team All-American Victor Batista and highly regarded middle blocker Michael Burke. Burke and Batista had the highest hitting percentages and blocking averages on the team in 2004. With the return of two stars and a great group of young talent to replace the departed seniors, the Cougars should be able to continue their championship tradition in 2005.

The following is a position-by-position breakdown of the 2005 BYU Cougars:

OUTSIDE HITTER


Despite the loss of two starters, BYU will be strong at the outside hitter position. Victor Batista, who earned All-America honors at the middle blocker position in 2004, will be joined by a large group of players that are brimming with potential, including redshirt freshman Ivan Perez, junior Taylor Evans, senior Casey Patterson, and junior Matt Heyes. Batista led the team in blocks per game at 1.24 and total blocks with 129. He hit a careerhigh 18 kills on three different occasions and a recorded a career high of nine total blocks twice. He was also one of the Cougars' top service threats, finishing second on the team with 19 aces. Evans and Patterson are the only others besides Batista who have any game experience. Patterson mostly saw action at setter in 2002 and 2003 and Evans saw limited playing time on the outside in 2004.

OPPOSITE

The opposite-side hitter position will be very deep for the Cougars and one of their strengths. Peterson attributes the depth to the fact that many of the players are very versatile and can play more than one position. Evans is one of many players competing for the starting position at opposite-side hitter. He hit for a career high 15 kills last season against George Mason. Patterson returns to BYU after sitting out the 2004 season. He can also play setter and provide power on the outside. While a good setter, Peterson feels Patterson can be a bigger contributor as a hitter.

MIDDLE BLOCKER

The middle blocker position will be thin in numbers but having a healthy Michael Burke will make the middle strong for BYU. Burke, who missed the first 12 matches of 2004 due to injury, starts the 2005 season as one of the best middle blockers in the nation. Despite joining the team in mid season, Burke was a major contributor for BYU, leading the Cougars with a .506 hitting percentage and finishing second on the team in blocks per game at 1.17. He also earned Third-team All-MPSF honors. On April 15 against USC, Burke hit for a career high .923 hitting percentage, finishing with 12 kills on 13 attempts. Redshirt freshman Russell Holmes and sophomore Bryan Stewart, a transfer student from Utah Valley State College, will join Burke in the middle.

SETTER

Junior Rob Neilson will step into the starting role vacated by All-American Carlos Moreno, who completed his athletic eligibility in 2004. Despite the big shoes to fill left by the AVCA National Player of the year, Peterson is more than confident that Neilson is capable of directing the team. Neilson was the backup in 2004. In preseason action during the fall of 2004, Neilson looked confident and capable of helping preserve BYU's tradition of excellence. Peterson will also rely on freshman Brian Congelliere, Patterson and sophomore-transfer Allan Mount from UCLA.

LIBERO

Junior Brian Rowley, who saw limited playing time last season, will step in as the new libero. Despite limited playing time, he practiced everyday against the National Champions and performed very well. Joining Rowley will be senior Rob Congelliere.

Despite the loss of several key contributors, the Cougars will again be a very deep squad. The coaching staff will have the option of choosing from several athletes who can play more than one position to field a competitive team every match. With Burke, Batista, and Neilson having been key contributors in the National Championship run, they will be a steadying influence for Cougars.

"This team has a lot of potential," Peterson said. "It will depend a lot on ball control, especially passing. If we can get some of the same magic, the same concept of team and work hard as a team, not just as individuals, we could go a long way."




