### COUGARS TRAVEL TO AIR FORCE TO TAKE ON THE FALCONS

Following a victory over conference rival Wyoming in Provo, the Cougars travel to Air Force looking for another conference victory. The Falcons enter the game with a .500 record and are coming off of a bye week. In its last game, Air Force defeated New Mexico 28-23. Last year the Falcons barely edged BYU, 24-10 in a game that was a lot closer than it appeared. The Cougars were driving deep into Falcon territory trailing by seven, but a fumble by running back Marcus Whalen dashed BYU's hopes of a comeback. Air Force added a touchdown as time expired to account for the final score.

#### **SERIES INFORMATION**

The series between BYU and Air Force has become a lot more competitive over the last few seasons. The Falcons have won three out of the last five meetings and the two teams have each own five wins in the last ten games, but the series wasn't always this close. The series began in 1956 with BYU earning a 34-21 victory over the Falcons. The Cougars won sixteen of the first seventeen games, including 12 in a row from 1983 to 1994. Air Force broke through with a 38-12 victory in 1995 and has won five out of the last seven games. The last time the two teams met in Falcon Stadium, Air Force won soundly 52-9 behind the running of Chance Harridge. BYU head coach Gary Crowton has posted a 1-2 record against the Falcons with his only win coming in 2001.

#### **GO WEST YOUNG MEN**

BYU has two players from Colorado on its roster, John Denney (Thornton) and Nick Alletto (Parker). The Cougars also boast cornerback Brandon Heaney, who played quarterback on Air Force's J.V. team before transferring to BYU in 2000.

#### **BYU'S RECORD IN THE MWC**

After defeating Wyoming, the Cougars record in the MWC improved to 23-15. BYU has won one outright MWC title in football when it posted a 7-0 conference record in 2001, the only perfect conference record in the brief history of the MWC, and has tied for one championship (1999). In all sports, BYU has won an overwhelming number of MWC championships, bringing home 53 out of a possible 95 championship titles.

#### **UP OR DOWN**

The following BYU coaches will be working from the sidelines for the Boise State game: Gary Crowton (head coach), Todd Bradford (wide receivers), Bronco Mendenhall (defensive coordinator and safeties), Paul Tidwell (special teams coordinator), Jeff Grimes (offensive line) and Steve Kafusi (defensive line). The remaining aassistant coaches, including Lance Reynolds (running backs), Mike Empey (tight ends), Barry Lamb (linebackers) and Brian Mitchell (cornerbacks), will coach from the booth.

#### WATCH OUT FOR THESE GUYS

Four members of the 2004 BYU football team—Aaron Francisco, Brady Poppinga, Daniel Coats and Matt Payne—have been selected to various "watch lists" for post-season awards.

**Aaron Francisco**, **6-2**, **215**, **Safety:** Aaron Francisco has been selected to the Thorpe Award "watch list," which honors the nation's top defensive back. Last year he earned first-team All-MWC honors and was an honorable mention selection as a sophomore. Francisco is second on the team in tackles with 60, including four tackles for loss and one sack. He recorded back-to-back games of 16 tackles against No. 1 USC and No. 21 Boise State. Against Wyoming, Francisco recorded his first interception of the year, returning it 34 yards.

**Brady Poppinga, 6-3, 257, Defensive End:** Brady Poppinga has been selected to the Bronko Nagurski Award "watch list." The award honors the nation's top defensive player. Poppinga ranks third on the team in tackles with 52, including ten tackles for a loss and leads the team with six sacks for a loss of 32 yards. Against Notre Dame, Poppinga was a one-man wrecking crew, leading the team in tackles with twelve while recording one sack on Irish quarterback Brady Quinn for a loss of 10 yards. He recorded his second double-digit tackle game of the season after recording 11 tackles against the Cowboys.

**Daniel Coats, 6-3, 250, Tight End:** Daniel Coats has been named to the John Mackey Award "watch list." The John Mackey Award is given annually to the nation's top tight end. On the season, Coats has hauled in 10 passes for 112 yards. He is sixth on the team in receptions and leads Cougar tight ends in both receptions and yards.

Matt Payne, 6-4, 234, Punter/Kicker: Matt Payne has been selected to the Lou Groza Award and Ray Guy Award "watch lists." The Groza Award is given annually to the nation's best place kicker, while the Ray Guy Award is gven to the nation's best punter. Payne punted nine times against the Irish, pinning them inside their 20 six times. He also kicked two field goals-a 44- and a 53-yarder. Payne followed up his excellent performance against the Irish with a solid day against Stanford, punting the ball four times for 180 yards which averages out to 45 yards a kick. In the third game of the season against USC, Payne punted eight times for 386 yards (48.3), including a MWC record 79-yard punt, which is also the second longest punt in BYU's history. He also kicked a 46-yard field goal that gave BYU an early 3-0 lead He kicked two field goals against BSU he punted seven times for an average of 44 yards and kicked two field goals. Payne kicked 52-yarder at CSU and punted five times, averaging 47.6 yards per kick. Payne made two field goals against UNLV-including a 50-yarder- and averaged 45.1 yards per punt. Against Wyoming, he tied the record for most consecutive field goals between 40-49 yards after he nailed a 46-yarder against the Cowboys. On the season, Payne has connected on 10 of 12 field goal attempts, including an amazing 9-9 from beyond 40 yards. He is currently seventh in the nation in punting (45.34) and fourth in net punting (41.17). Both marks lead the MWC.

#### **COUGARS FACE TOUGH SCHEDULE**

BYU is scheduled to play the ninth toughest non conference schedule based on opponents' winning percentage last season. The Cougars non conference schedule includee Notre Dame, Stanford, co-National Champion and preseason No. 1 USC and Boise State who combined for a 34-16 record in 2003. The overall record of BYU's opponents including Mountain West Conference tea,s in 2003 was 82-54 (.603). Five of the Cougars' 11 opponents went to a bowl game last year. The teams finished with a 3-2 bowl record, including USC's victory over Michigan in the Rose Bowl that earned the Trojans a share of the National Title. Following the fifth week of the season, BYU's opponents are 43-26 (.623), with their non-conference opponents posting a 21-4 (.840) record through Oct. 16. #### TALE OF THE TAPE

BYU's projected starting offensive line averages an enormous 6-foot-4 and 312 pounds. They will face an Air Forcedefensive line that averages 6-foot-2 and 265 pounds. When the Falcons have the ball, Cougar defensive linemen that average 6-foot-4 and 293 pounds will face an Air Force front five that are listed at 6-foot-4 and 283 pounds.

#### **SWEET REVENGE**

Since 1999, BYU holds a 7-3 (.700) record in payback games against non conference opponents. Last year the Cougars defeated Georgia Tech in BYU's home opener 24-13 after losing to the Yellow Jackets 28-19 the previous year. This year BYU had payback opportunities on its non-conference schedule. The Cougars defeated Notre Dame 20-17, lost to Stanford 37-10 and lost to USC 42-10. #### PAYNE EARNS THIRD MWC PLAYER OF THE WEEK HONOR

Matt Payne was named the MWC Special Teams Player of the Week for the third time in five weeks.Payne connected on a 52-yard field goal to give BYU an early 3-0 lead with 9:55 left in the second quarter against CSU and split the uprights on four point-after attempts on the night. He was also credited with another bone-jarring tackle in kickoff coverage. Payne averaged 47.6 yards per punt, marking his highest average since posting 48.3 yards per punt against top-ranked USC. Only two of his five punts were returned for a combined total of five yards, establishing a 46.6 net punting average. Three of Payne's punts were downed inside the 20-yard line, including two punts inside the five-yard line. As a result, Colorado State was forced to start five drives with an average field position from their own 14-yard line.

His 52-yard field goal was the second longest of the season. Payne is a perfect 6-for-6 from 40 yards or more on the season, and 2-for-2 from over 50 yards. With four PAT's on the night, Payne has connected on 55 straight PAT's, dating back to the Cougars' season-opening victory against Syracuse in 2002. His streak currently ranks as the 10th longest in the country. Payne has made 11 consecutive point-after attempts this season. This is the sixth time Payne has been named special teams player of the week in his career.

#### **KING OF PAYNE**

After seven games, Matt Payne is seventh in the nation in punting with an average of 45.3 yards per kick. He has pinned opponents inside the 20-yardline 18 times. In the third game of the season, Payne booted a career-long and a then MWC record 79-yard punt. Unlike most punters, Payne likes to get into the thick of it during kick coverage. He had two highlight-reel quality hits against Boise State kick returner Chris Carr. On the season, Payne has racked up seven tackles on special teams, including six solo takedowns. Payne is no slouch as a kicker either. The senior from North Ogden, Utah has booted 10 of 12 field goals, including a perfect 9 of 9 from 40-yards or greater. His 46-yarder against Wyoming was his 12th straight make between 40 and 49 yards, tying him with John Carney who kicked 12 straight from that distance between 1984-85. On the season, there have been 30 field goals of 50-yards or more in the nation. Matt Payne has kicked three of those, including a 53-yarder against Notre Dame. He has also made all of his extra points this season. Payne has also hit 60 straight point-after attempts, dating back to the 2002 season. He needs just two more to tie Owen Pochman for the BYU record.

#### **OH AUSTIN BEHAVE**

Austin Collie has hauled in 37 passes for 437 yards on the season and leads the team in touchdown receptions with four. All four of his touchdown receptions have been 40-yards or more, including his latest which came on a half-back pass from Curtis Brown to help lead BYU past conference rival Wyoming. Collie is the nation's top-ranked freshman receiver, averaging 5.29 receptions per game.

#### **GOING DEEP**

Junior College transfer Todd Watkins has made an immediate impact for the Cougars. He leads the team with 707 receiving yards on 38 receptions and is second on the team in touchdown catches with three. He has caught touchdown passes of 69 and 79 yards on the season, leading Sports Illustrated to dub him the nation's top "deep threat." Watkins is second in the conference and 12th nationally in receiving yards per game with a 101 yard average.

#### **GOOD GRIEF CURTIS BROWN**

Despite a slow start, sophomore running back Curtis Brown has picked up the pace in his last three games. Over that stretch Brown has racked up 354 yards, including two straight games over 100 yards. His best performance came against Wyoming where he accumulated 230 yards (159 rushing, 40 passing and 31 receiving) and accounted for two of BYU's three touchdowns. On the season Brown has rushed for 457 yards and four touchdowns. Brown accounted for 230 of the Cougars' 416 total yards in the Cougars' 24-13 win over Wyoming. He carried 24 times for 159 yards, threw one time for 40 yards and had three receptions for 31 yards. He also scored one rushing touchdown on a nine-yard run in the fourth quarter to give the Cougars a 17-13 lead with 13:37 remaining in the game. Brown's touchdown run capped a nine-play, 80-yard drive. In the first quarter Brown accounted for 95 of the Cougars' 96 total yards, including 55 yards rushing and 40 yards passing. Brown connected with freshman receiver Austin Collie on a 40-yard touchdown strike to give the Cougars a 7-0. The game marked Brown's second straight 100-yard rushing performance -- the third of his career. Brown leads the team with 528 yards rushing, posting 354 yards rushing in the last three games. On the season, Brown is averaging 75.6 yards per game, while over the past three games, he has recorded an average of 118 yards per contest.

Of the 105 players who participated in fall camp, 35 are married. The 35 married players have a total of eight children. Included among the nine children are new additions to Manaia Brown's, Brady Poppinga's and Jason Kukahiko's families. Brown's wife Tupusina gave birth to Manaia Vaega Vaifoa on Aug. 9, while Poppinga's wife Brooke gave birth to their new daughter, Jasmine Rene, on Aug. 12. There will be two more additions to the Cougar family later this fall. Kukahiko's wife Kristin gave birth to the couple's first child Kate Anna on Sept. 7. Defensive back Brett Cooper and his wife, Diana, are expecting their first child in October.

### ATHLETIC EXCELLENCE

The Cougars have experienced athletic success on a national level. Since 1970 when BYU captured its first NCAA title, the Cougars have won ten national championships, including four in crosscountry and three in men's volleyball since 1997. BYU also won the national championship in football in 1984. BYU has also ranked high in the NACDA Director's cup, an award given to the nation's best athletic program. ### LAST WEEK: BYU vs. WYOMING

Cougar running back Curtis Brown led the way for BYU's 24-13 victory over Wyoming,, rushing for 159 yards and one touchdown and throwing for another score. This was the most Brown has gained since he torched the Utah State defense for 217 yards and three touchdowns as a freshman in 2002. BYU got on the board first following Brown's 40-yard halfback pass to a wide-open Austin Collie. Wyoming countered with a 45-yard field goal by Deric Yaussi. The Cougars would then trade field goals with the Cowboys to take a 10-6 lead into halftime. Wyoming took the lead on a 35-yard pass from Corey Bramlet to Jovon Bouknight. The lead was short-lived as BYU marched down the field behind the running of Brown and his backfield-mate Fahu Tahi. Brown scored on a nine-yard run to put BYU up for good, and Tahi put the game away with a 15-yard scamper late in the fourth quarter.

#### **OFFENSIVE NOTES**

BYU enters its game against Air Force ranked fifth in the MWC and 65th in the nation in total offense. The Cougars are averaging 363.71 yards per game. Last week against Wyoming BYU's running game exploded for 237 yards rushing and is now ranked seventh in the conference in rushing. Quarterback John Beck is fifth in the conference in pass efficiency, recording a 107.44 rating. As a team, the Cougars rank third in the conference and 17th in the nation in passing, averaging 272.86 yards per game. BYU will face off against an Air Force defense that ranks sixth in the conference in total defense giving up 388.17 yards per game. The Falcons rank 93rd in the country and seventh in the MWC in rush defense giving up 193.50 yards on the ground, while they rank third in the conference in pass defense (194.67 YPG).

#### **DEFENSIVE NOTES**

Defensively, BYU ranks fourth in the conference and 64th in the nation in total defense, giving up 371.43 yards per game. The Cougars rank second in the conference and 29th in the nation in rushing defense giving up just 112 yards per game on the ground. BYU will face a tough test against Air Force, who leads the conference and is ranked eighth in the nation in rushing offense, averaging 256 yards per game. The Falcons boast four players among the conference's top 16 rushers. BYU is ranked last in the conference in pass defense, giving up 259.43 yards a game through the air. Air Force is seventh in the conference in passing, accumulating only 145 yards per game.

#### **1984 NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP HONORED AT FIRST HOME GAME**



Marking the 20th anniversary of the Cougars' 1984 National Championship the teamwas this year's sole induction into the BYU Athletic Hall of Fame. The induction ceremony took place Friday evening, Sept. 3, at the Wilkinson Center Ballroom. The team was honored the next day at Lavell Edwards Stadium during the BYU-Notre Dame game in pre-game and halftime ceremonies. Only two other Cougar teams have been inducted into the Hall of Fame: the 1951 NIT Championship Basketball team and the 1966 NIT Championship Basketball team. Cosmo, the Cougarettes and the BYU Marching Band played a part in the game-day festivities. There was also be an informal golf tournament Friday afternoon where some of the players participated as celebrity guests. In addition to the celebration in the stadium, a lithograph has been commissioned in honor of

the '84 team. 1,984 numbered lithographs will be available for purchase. The artwork will feature individually autographed pictures of the 24 starters, including Vai Sikahema and Lee Johnson, along with a team picture and a picture of coach LaVell Edwards.

Familiar players like Glen Kozlowski, Vai Sikahema, Lee Johnson, Mark Bellini and Kelly Smith put Provo on the map in the world of college football. All-Americans like Robbie Bosco, Kyle Morrell, David Mills, Leon White and Marv Allen helped make the team a threat on both sides of the ball. In total, 15 players from the 1984 squad were drafted by 12 different NFL teams. Now, these players-hopefully all 120 of them-will be returning to LaVell Edwards Stadium to be recognized by their alma mater on the 20th anniversary of their epic season. After a perfect 12-0 season, the Cougars went on to defeat Michigan in the Holiday Bowl at Jack Murphy Stadium. Robbie Bosco's heroic return from an early, second-quarter knee injury, along with a circus catch from Kelly Smith, was only part of the 13-game saga. Many fans remember the famous goal-line stand against Hawaii where Kyle Morrell soared over the offensive line to sack the Warrior quarterback and in the process kept their season unblemished.

#### **ELECTION YEAR RECORD**

Since 1972, BYU has posted an 81-28 (.743) record during election years, including 2004. Some of BYU's most significant moments on the gridiron have occurred while republicans and democrats are fighting for a seat in the oval office. During the 1972 presidential election, LaVell Edwards took over as BYU's head coach. In 1976, BYU was invited to its first bowl game, the Fiesta Bowl against Oklahoma State. The 1980 presidential election year brought the Cougars their first bowl victory and a 12-1 record. BYU won the national championship in 1984, and in 1996, the Cougars posted 14 victories and earned their first trip to a New Year's Day bowl game.

Crowton, 47, came to BYU with a long and proven list of coaching accomplishments. Prior to serving as the offensive coordinator with the NFL's Chicago Bears, where his offense ranked third in the NFL in passing yardage during the 1999 season, Crowton was head coach at Louisiana Tech from 1996-1998. There he guided the Bulldogs to a 21-13 (.618) record over three seasons, including a 9-2 mark in 1997.

Competing as an independent for three straight years, Louisiana Tech recorded wins over the likes of Mississippi State, Cal and Alabama. Using its Crowton-designed, high-powered offense, the program also recorded impressive wins by scoring 50 or more points against eight different opponents, including games of 60 or more points in five different games. Crowton's offense ranked third in the nation, both in passing and total offense, while the Bulldogs racked up 12,746 yards passing in three years, an average of 4,249 yards per season. The prolific Tech offense also produced 115 touchdown receptions, averaging 38.3 TDs per season.

Under Crowton, NFL first-round draft pick Troy Edwards recorded a Techrecord 280 receptions and 4,352 yards receiving. Over a span of 34 games, Crowton's offense at Louisiana Tech engineered 22 different 300-yard passing games, including school-record 10, 300-yard outings during the 1998 season. In 1998, Crowton's final season at Louisiana Tech, the Bulldogs combined for a school record 4,943 yards passing.

Crowton's coaching career actually began in 1982 as a student assistant under Edwards at BYU. While at BYU, he worked with current Seattle Seahawks head coach Mike Holmgren and future NFL Hall of Famer Steve Young. From BYU, Crowton moved on to Snow College in Ephraim, Utah, where he coached from 1983-86. While at Snow College, Crowton moved from defensive backs coach to offensive coordinator. Under his offensive leadership, the Badgers won the National Junior College Athletic Association National Championship in 1985.

From Snow College, Crowton moved to Western Illinois, where he directed the Leathernecks' passing game for a single season. In 1988, Crowton was hired as the offensive coordinator at New Hampshire, where the Wildcats were the top-rated passing team in the Yankee Conference from 1988-90. In 1991, Crowton was hired as the quarterback coach at Boston College under head coach Tom Coughlin. There he helped develop quarterback Glenn Foley as a candidate for the Heisman Trophy. After three successful seasons with the Eagles, Crowton was hired as the co-offensive coordinator at Georgia Tech, where his offense led the Yellow Jackets to a No. 21 national ranking in his first and only season in Atlanta. In 1995, Crowton was hired as the offensive coordinator at Louisiana Tech, where he would become the head coach the following season.

Crowton was an all-league quarterback at Orem High School before earning All-American honors at Snow College. Crowton transferred to Colorado State, where he finished his career. Following an LDS Church mission to South Korea, Crowton attended Idaho State, where he ran track for the Bengals. After returning to BYU in 1982, Crowton earned his bachelor's degree in physical education in 1983.

Crowton, who is the first-ever head football coach at BYU to serve an LDS Church mission, is married to the former Maren Peterson of Bountiful, Utah. The couple was married on August 3, 1985. The Crowtons have seven children, Dane (18), Tara (16), Jenessa (13), Quinn (10), Mikauli (8) Toriana (4) and Macloud (2).

#### EDWARDS SELECTED TO HALL OF FAME



The National Football Foundation and College Hall of Fame has announced the 2004 College Football Hall of Fame Division I-A Class. Former BYU head football coach LaVell Edwards is among the list of 14 inductees to this year's class. A coaching icon, whose success and longevity are paralleled by few, Edwards guided BYU to heights never before reached in the program's history. Edwards posted a record of 257-101-3 (.716) over a span of 29 seasons at BYU. From 1972 until his retirement following the 2000 season, Edwards roamed the sidelines at BYU—a tenure that ranks fifth all-time among coaches at one school. In 21 of those 29 seasons, the Cougars claimed the league title. Guiding BYU to 22 bowl game appearances,

including a streak of 17 straight bowl appearances, Edwards reached the pinnacle of coaching success in 1984 by winning the National Championship. His 257 wins rank him sixth in NCAA Division I-A history, and he has more victories than every other coach in BYU history combined. At the helm, Edwards compiled a program best .716 win percentage, coached one Heisman Trophy winner, two Outland Trophy recipients, four Davey O'Brien award winners and 32 All-Americans---not to mention countless players who went on to professional careers in the NFL. BYU's success didn't come without personal reward for Edwards either. He was named NCAA District 8 Coach of the Year eight times, the Bobby Dodd National Coach of the Year in 1979 and AFCA National Coach of the Year in 1985. Named the State of Utah's Coach of the Century, Edwards is a member of the State of Utah Sports Hall of Fame. Edwards becomes the fifth person affiliated with BYU football to be inducted in to the College Football Hall of Fame. It is no surprise that the four BYU players who are currently enshrined in the Hall of Fame often credit Edwards for their success. BYU's other College Football Hall of Famers include Steve Young (Class of 2001), Jim McMahon (Class of 1998), Marc Wilson (Class of 1996), Gifford Nielsen (Class of 1994). Edwards, who will turn 74 in October, recently returned from an LDS Church mission to New York City. Along with his wife, Patti, the Edwards' served as public affairs missionaries for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints in the Northeastern United States, as well as Eastern Canada. The Edwards have been married for nearly 53 years and have three children, Ann, John and Jim. The Edwards have 14 grandchildren.

#### **RECORD WATCH**

After kicking two field goals and two extra points against Notre Dame, senior kicker Matt Payne moved past Jamal Willis and Kurt Gunther into third place on BYU's all-time scoring list. One of Payne's field goals was a 53-yarder that matched his career-high that was set in 2003 against USC. In the history of Cougar football there have only been four kicks of 53 yards or more. Matt Payne has two of those kicks. During his sophomore and junior campaigns, he led the team in scoring. After scoring six points against Wyoming, he needs seven more points to catch Luke Staley, who is currently second on BYU's all-time scoring list. Safety Aaron Francisco currently has 302 career tackles. He trails former Cougar and current Indianapolis Colts linebacker Rob Morris by 43 tackles for ninth place on BYU's all-time career tackle list.
