### COUGARS IN PRESEASON RANKINGS

For the third consecutive season, BYU made an appearance in the pre-season top-5, this time at No. 1. Last year, BYU started the season ranked second behind UC Irvine, and in 2006 the Cougars held the top spot in the preseason polls.

### PRESEASON EXHIBITION

BYU finished its exhibition schedule having won three of four matches. The only preseason exhibition loss came in a four game loss to Cal State Northridge.

### MPSF PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Feb. 4 - Ivan Perez: 41 kills in two wins against CSUN, including a double-double (20 kills, 10 digs)... .365 on the weekend and had 46 total points

Feb. 19 - Russell Holmes: 30 kills in two wins against UC Irvine with a combined attack percentage of .444... also tallied 20 blocks, three service aces and second double-double of the season.

### APPROACHING A MILESTONE

BYU currently has 245 conference wins and is hoping to reach the 250 mark this season. The team would need at least a 17-5 MPSF mark to reach the milestone.

### 300 CLUB

The Cougars have only hit below .300 as a team nine times this season, with the season high at .438 in a three-set sweep at UCSD on Jan. 12. Of the 58 double-digit kill performances BYU has recorded on the year, 39 of those have come with .300-plus hitting percentages and 14 have come with .500-plus hitting percentages. In contrast, only two teams have hit .300 against the Cougars this season with Long Beach State setting the high opponent mark at .338 March 21. UC Irvine has the lowest percentage against BYU this season at .106 in a 3-1 Cougar win in Irvine, Calif., February 16.

### A TOUGH STRETCH

BYU is coming out of its toughest stretch of the season with matches against Pepperdine, UCLA, and Long Beach State, which are three of the four teams on BYU's schedule that have winning records against the Cougars overall. The Cougars recorded a weekend sweep at home against Pepperdine, the team that had the best record against BYU of all the team's on the Cougars' 2008 schedule (now 21-15 overall). The Cougars then split matches at UCLA, the team that now has the best winning percentage against BYU with a 26-16 advantage. The Cougars just dropped two matches at Long Beach State, which now edges the Cougars with a 18-15 advantage overall.



## HOME COURT ADVANTAGE

BYU finished its 2007 regular season with an 11-1 (.917) record at the Smith Fieldhouse. The record was the fifth best mark in Cougar history behind the 1998 (11-0, 1.000), 2004 (16-1, .941), 1999 (15-1, .938), and 2006 (13-1, .929) seasons. The team is 9-1 at home this season after facing off against the No. 1 NAIA team Cal Baptist, No. 6 Cal State Northridge, No. 9 Stanford, Pacific, and most recently No. 5 Pepperdine.

## TONIGHT'S ATTENDANCE IS...

The average attendance at BYU home matches this season is 2,585 in contrast to an average of 1,131 at matches on the road. The 3,566 people in attendance at the Cougars' first home match of the season, January 25 against Cal Baptist, set the season-high mark. The 2,049 fans at IPFW on January 18 is the largest crowd BYU has seen on the road this season.

## DOUBLE-DOUBLES

Ivan Perez has recorded seven double-doubles on the season, his last coming in with 26 kills and 10 digs at LBSU March 21. Russell Holmes has two double-doubles on the year with impressive performances at the net all season. Jonathan Charette and Andrew Stewart each have one double-double on the season that came in the same match against UC Irvine.

## SETTING THREE DEEP

BYU's setting lineup consists of senior Brian Congelli, sophomore Reed Chilton, and reigning National Newcomer of the Year Yamil Perez. The setting trio has led the team to a combined .317 hitting percentage. Congelli leads the team with 557 set assists and an average of 10.13 assists per game. Chilton is not far behind with 454 set assists and an average of 9.66 assists per game.

## UPPERCLASS ADVANTAGE?

BYU currently has five seniors on the roster, all of whom start and are significant contributors: OPP Jonathan Charette, S Brian Congelli, MB Russell Holmes, OH Ivan Perez, MB Trent Sorensen. Two sophomores are also in the regular starting lineup (OH Andrew Stewart and LIB Joel Silva), but there are no juniors currently on the roster. After starting five seniors in 2008, it is likely the team will have none on the roster at all in 2009.

## COUGS IN THE FIFTH SET

BYU is 4-0 in the fifth set this season, a drastic improvement from years past. In the three seasons preceding 2008 (2005-07), the Cougars were only 3-9 in the fifth set.

## LONGEST FIFTH SET IN MPSF HISTORY

February 15th saw the longest fifth set in BYU and MPSF history. BYU edged UC Irvine on the Anteaters' home court 28-26 in the fifth to earn its tenth win of the season. Previously, the longest fifth set in BYU history went to 21-19 twice against Stanford in consecutive seasons. The Cougars topped the Cardinal 21-19 in Provo during the 2002 MPSF Tournament, and again the following season in Palo Alto, Calif., in the second match of the season.

## OLYMPIC HOPEFULS

Senior outside hitter Ivan Perez and sophomore libero Joel Silva each play for their respective national teams of Puerto Rico and Venezuela. Silva will compete with the Venezuelan team in Beijing this summer in the country's first trip to the Olympic Summer Games in volleyball. Perez and his Puerto Rican compadres are still trying to qualify for the games.

## ALL-AMERICANS

With Yosleyder Cala and Ivan Perez being named First Team and Russell Holmes being named Second Team AVCA All-Americans last year, it marked the 15th consecutive season the Cougars have had at least one All-American. Since 1993, 21 different players have earned 39 citations, 15 of which are first-team honors and 13 of which are second-team honors Yamil Perez also returns after being named the 2007 National Newcomer of the Year.

## WHERE ARE YOU FROM?

Players come from all over the world to play with BYU's volleyball team. The Cougars have players from Brazil, Puerto Rico and Venezuela on their roster. Five states are also represented on this year's team: California, Ohio, Nevada, Pennsylvania and Utah. California leads the way with eight players hailing from the Golden State.

## COACHES OR PLAYERS?

Both members of BYU's coaching staff are coaching at their alma mater. Interim head coach Shawn Patchell starred for the Cougars in his playing days while assistant coach Rob Neilson earned All-MPSF honors for BYU just two seasons ago.

## PATCHELL RETAINED AS INTERIM COACH

After guiding the Cougars in 2007 with co-interim head coach Ryan Millar, Shawn Patchell has been retained as the head coach on an interim basis. Earlier this year, Millar announced his decision to return to the U.S. National Team and to also compete professionally. During the summer of 2005, Patchell coached the US World University Games team and in 2006, he was part of the U.S. Boys' Youth National Team coaching staff.

## PERFECT STARTS

The best start the team has ever had to a season was 1999 when the team won its first 18 matches and finished the year as National Champions with a 30-1 record. The team began the 2008 campaign with 11 straight wins and suffered its first loss against No. 9 Stanford February 23.

## 20-WIN SEASONS

After finishing the 2006 season with a 18-9 record, BYU was held without 20 wins for the first time since the 2000 season. With 2007's 23-6 finish, the Cougars have recorded nine 20-win seasons.

## EVERY THREE YEARS...?

Since BYU's first national championship in 1999, the Cougars won the NCAA tournament a total of three times (1999, 2001 and 2004). Since the '99 season, has won the NCAA Championship at least once every three years until the chain was broken in 2007.

## BYU IN THE MPSF TOURNAMENT

Since 1993, BYU has qualified for the MPSF postseason tournament in 13 of 14 seasons including 11 consecutive trips. The Cougars all-time record in the MPSF tournament is 17-11. BYU has won the MPSF tournament three times and holds an 9-5 record in the first round, 4-5 record in the semifinals and a perfect 3-0 record in tournament finals. The Cougars won consecutive MPSF tournament championships in 2003 and 2004.

## BYU IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT

The Cougars have made four NCAA tournament appearances in the program's history. Impressively, BYU has brought home the hardware in three of its four NCAA tournament appearances. The Cougars boast a 7-1 overall record in NCAA tournament play and a perfect 4-0 record in national semifinal matches. The Cougars only loss in the NCAA tournament was in 2003 when they lost to Lewis in a five-game thriller. BYU has earned automatic bids to the Final Four by winning the MPSF tournament three times: 1999, 2003 and 2004.

## A LOOK AT THE GAUCHOS

UC Santa Barbara has lost five of its last seven matches, but has won two of its last three in three-set sweeps over USC and Cal-Baptist. Freshman Jeff Menzel leads the attack for the Gauchos ranking fourth in the nation with an average of 4.84 kills per game. Senior Theo Brunner also averages 3.60 kills per game with a .382 attack percentage. Sophomore Sam Moisenko averages 1.27 blocks per game, which is 16th best in the country.

## COACH SHAWN PATCHELL



With a career record of 23-6, Shawn Patchell enters his second year as head coach and sixth year overall as a member of BYU's staff. Patchell came to BYU from Laguna Beach High School where he was head coach for both the boy's and girl's volleyball teams.

In addition to his BYU coaching responsibilities, Patchell has been selected to be the 2008 Junior National Team Head Coach. He also coached the Youth National Team at the FIVB World Championships in Mexico in 2007, the first US team to participate in the Youth World Championships. During the summer of 2005, Patchell also coached the US World University Games team. In 2006 Patchell assisted the Youth National Team to a win over Cuba and a silver medal in the Dominican Republic NORCECA tourney which qualified team USA for the World Championships.

In six seasons at Laguna Beach High School, Patchell's teams qualified for the CIF playoffs every year and were CIF finalists in 1998, 1999 and 2001 and state qualifiers in 1998 and 2001. The Laguna Beach Artists won seven Pacific Coast League Titles with Patchell at the helm. In six seasons, Coach Patchell posted a 137-67 record at LBHS and twice was selected to coach the South Orange County All-Stars. Patchell also coached basketball at Irvine High School and assisted the men's volleyball team at the University of California at Irvine along with coaching at Pepperdine and Stanford during the summer.

A member of BYU's first NCAA men's volleyball team, Patchell was a starter from 1990-93 and recorded a .398 career hitting percentage. In 1992, Patchell's junior year, he led the nation in hitting percentage at .488 and was honored as All-Academic Western Intercollegiate Volleyball Association. He was ranked fourth and 10th nationally in hitting and blocking his senior year. Patchell played professionally in Spain for the Euro Cup qualifier and No. 1-ranked Gran Canaria Team in the Canary Islands and also represented the US in the Federation International Volleyball Association Sand Volleyball Circuit in Europe.

Patchell earned his BA in English with a minor in business management from BYU in 1993 and a master's degree in English Literature from the University of California at Irvine in 2000. He is a part-time member of the BYU English Department where he teaches Masterpieces of American and British Literature and a composition class. Patchell taught English Literature in high schools in Kauai, Hawai'i, Irvine and Laguna Beach, California. Shawn and his wife Davis enjoy surfing, skiing, snowboarding, horseback riding, reading and camping with their three daughters: Jordan (11), Sage (9) and Soren (5). The Patchell's newest addition to the family, Kai, was born in March 2007.

## LAST YEAR VS. UC SANTA BARBARA

**SANTA BARBARA, Calif. (Mar. 9, 2007)** -- Joel Silva, Ivan Perez and Yosleyder Cala led a strong defensive effort as No. 3 BYU picked up a crucial MPSF victory over No. 4 UC Santa Barbara, sweeping the Gauchos 36-34, 30-23 and 30-26.

"We did an excellent job passing and serving today," co-head coach Shawn Patchell said. "A lot of credit goes to Joel, Ivan and Cala. We also served exceptionally well and put a lot of pressure on them."

The Cougars (14-4, 10-3 MPSF) were led offensively by Cala and Robby Stowell who each picked up 12 kills. The middle tandem of Rodney Santos and Russell Holmes had very efficient offensive nights. Each added nine kills while Santos hit .583 and Holmes swung at a .500 clip. BYU also held UCSB standout Evan Patak to just eight kills and .000 hitting on the night.

UCSB got off to a quick start, jumping out to a 13-10 lead early on. BYU responded, going on a 6-1 run to grasp control of the opening game. A pair of Cala aces capped the run and forced the Gauchos to call a time out. BYU further extended its lead to 21-16 behind tough serving, forcing the Gauchos into consecutive hitting errors. With BYU serving ahead 29-26, UCSB scored three consecutive points to tie the set at 29. The Cougars kept the advantage throughout the extra points and won on a Cala kill.

"The first set was huge for us," Patchell said. "We had several game points. Credit UCSB for fighting back. We were able to make some adjustments and take over."

BYU never trailed in the second set as the Cougars jumped out to an early 7-1 lead to start the game. The Cougars scored four of their first seven points courtesy of blocks including a block solo and assist by Cala. BYU out-hit UCSB .393 to .107 in the second set as the Gauchos only managed nine kills in the game. The Cougars never let go of their early lead, allowing UCSB to cut the lead only to four points once during the set. Holmes took care of BYU's first game point by smoking a service ace to put the Cougars ahead.

After BYU trailed 2-1 in the third set, the Cougars went on another 7-1 run to open a game. The Cougars took a commanding 8-3 lead due to pressure from the service line. Yamil Perez and Cala's serving paced BYU's early run. The Cougars never relinquished their lead, finishing the third set with a Santos kill.

**SANTA BARBARA, Calif. (Mar. 10, 2007)** -- Yamil Perez had another impressive outing, leading BYU (15-4, 11-3 MPSF) to a .495 team hitting percentage as the No. 3 Cougars swept No. 4 UC Santa Barbara (14-8, 10-7) for the second consecutive night, 30-28, 30-28 and 30-26.

Perez had 53 assists and set for a team that had four players swing over .500. The only Cougars' attacker to hit under .500 was outside hitter Yosleyder Cala, who posted a .304 hitting percentage on 12 kills. Freshman Robby Stowell led BYU once again, getting 19 kills while hitting .500.

Perez also added two digs and three block assists. Russell Holmes also came up big for the Cougars, picking up eight kills while hitting .583. Holmes added five blocks and a career-high four service aces.

Early in the first set, the two teams played evenly playing to a tie at 11. With the score tied at 11, the Gauchos went on a 3-0 run to jump to a 14-11 lead and force a BYU time out. UCSB extended its lead to four at 18-14 before the Cougars began to chip away at the lead. BYU scored three consecutive points capped by a Stowell ace to narrow the margin to 18-17. After BYU and UCSB traded side outs, the Cougars scored two points in a row and two occasions to tie the game at 25. BYU then out-scored the Gauchos 3-1 on a Holmes kill followed by a combo block to take the two-point advantage. The Cougars won the set on a Cala kill.

Much like the first set, the second was closely contested with neither team building a two-point lead until the score reached double-digits. With the score tied at 13, BYU went on a 5-1 run to build a four-point advantage. UCSB came right back, with a 6-1 burst of its own to re-gain a 20-19 advantage. With the score tied at 22, the Cougars scored four consecutive points to take the lead. Rodney Santos and Ivan Perez put up a block to give BYU a 26-22 lead. Once again, the Gauchos fought back, scoring four consecutive themselves to tie the score. Ivan Perez shut the door on the second set with back-to-back kills to break a 28-all tie.

BYU caught fire in the third set, recording 21 kills while swinging .714 as a team. The Cougars jumped to an early 6-1 lead and never looked back. Behind back-to-back service aces from Holmes, the Cougars built a nine-point advantage at 24-15. BYU held off the Gauchos, with Stowell knocking home the match-winner.

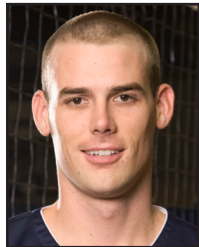
