Cougars Face No. 2 at Wilson/Demarini Invitational

With a 9-5 record, the BYU women's softball team heads to the Wilson/Demarini Invitational in Tempe, Ariz., on Feb. 29 to face Drake (4-6), Creighton (9-3) and No. 2 Arizona State (16-1).

The Cougars play two games on Friday. The first will be against Drake at 11 a.m., followed by another outing against Creighton at 3:30 p.m. On Saturday BYU faces Creighton again at 3:30 p.m. and then Arizona State at 5:30 p.m.

"We are steadily getting closer to the level of play that we are capable of," BYU head coach Gordon Eakin said. "I expect to play close to our expectations as a team, because of the amount of talent we have."

The Invitational marks the fourth time BYU has faced a top-25 team this season. Currently, the Cougars are 2-1 against ranked opponents. They fell to No. 6 Tennessee, 8-2, and No. 9 Oklahoma, 8-5, but defeated No. 22 Missouri, 4-0.

The Cougars come to the invitational after splitting their previous tournament, 2-2. BYU looks to improve on the season during their four games at the Wilson/Demarini Invitational.

This Week's Opponents

Drake



The Bulldogs come to the Wilson/Demarini Invitational with a 4-6 record. They boast shut out over No. 11 Michigan. BYU and Drake have met in 2004 where BYU won, 12-1. The Cougars face the Bulldogs on Friday at 11 a.m.

Creighton



The Jays have a 9-3 record on the season so far. Their wins include defeats of Northern Colorado and Loyola Marymount, and BYU has defeated both teams. The Cougars and Jays meet at 3:30 p.m. on both Friday and Saturday.

No. 2 Arizona State



The Sun Devils come in this week's rankings at No. 2. They are 16-1 on the season. ASU has defeated BYU four times in the past, three of the games came last season. The Cougars last met ASU in the NCAA Regional Championship, when BYU lost 6-3, its closest scoring margin to ASU ever.

About the Team . . .

Versus Ranked Opponents

The Cougars face their fourth ranked opponent during the Wilson/Demarini Invitation. They will face No. 2 Arizona State on Saturday. BYU is 2-1 against ranked opponents this season. The Cougars lost to No. 6 Tennessee on Feb. 21, 8-2. The game tied for the most runs given up this season. BYU lost its first game of the year against a ranked opponent when they fell to No. 9 Oklahoma. In the Cougars second game against a ranked opponent they came out on top of No. 22, Missouri 4-0.

On the Road Again

BYU has played all 14 games on the road, with 13 at neutral sites. The Cougars stay on the road until March 17, when they face South Dakota State during their home opener.

Going, Going, Gone

BYU has hit 18 home runs on the season, with eight coming from Angeline Quiocho and four from Dani Snow. Both Jessica Purcell and Amanda Vance have hit two bombs, and Stephanie Platt Hopkins and Whitney Nix have one to their names.

Hits, Hits and More Hits

With 8.7 hits per game average, the Cougars total 123 hits on the season, including 27 doubles and 18 home runs. BYU totalled 14 hits against Northwestern State on Feb. 14, the most hits of any game this year. The team has recorded five double-digit-hitting games this season.

Senior Trio

The Cougars are led by seniors Gwyn Trice, Daniela Snow and Emi Snow Willing. With only three seniors on the roster, BYU has a lot of young athletes competing for positions. The Cougs look to gain experience and cement positions early during their competitive schedule.

Freshmen Making Big Impact

With three freshman on the starting lineup, the young players are making a big impact for the team. Caschjen Davis and dp/outfielder Erin Olander are two of three Cougars to maintain a batting average above .400. Davis also has five doubles.

From the Circle

Three skilled pitchers make up BYU's rotation. Both Gwyn Trice and Christie Zinanti return from last season, with Paige Affleck joining the two. Gwyn Trice leads the Cougars with a 1.05 ERA. She is 3-1 so far, and has struck out 68 batters in 42.2 innings. Between the three hurlers BYU maintains a 2.08 ERA with 121 strikeouts.

Cougar Bloodlines

Freshman Jessica Purcell joins her cousin Angeline Quiocho as a Cougar. Daniela Snow and Emi Snow Willing are sisters-in-law. Daniela married Emi's brother.

MWC Preseason Champs

The Cougars were selected to win the Mountain West Conference, after finishing last season as conference Champions. Despite losing a slew of seniors, including two All-Americans, BYU looks to repeat another year of conference success.

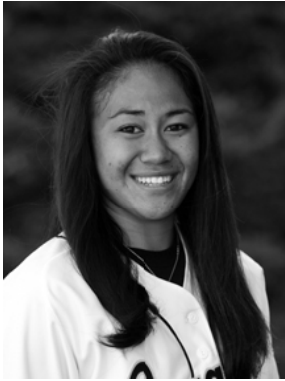
