The Cougars lead the series against the Cardinal 20-8 and 10-2 in Provo. BYU has not lost to Stanford since the first match of the 2002 season when the Cardinal won in four sets in Provo. Since that time, BYU has won the last 11 matches and swept Stanford in six of those. Two of those matches went to four games, but the Cardinal has not forced a fifth game since the 2003 season when BYU beat Stanford in back-to-back five-set matches.

## COUGARS IN PRESEASON RANKINGS

For the third consecutive season, BYU made an appearance in the pre-season top-5, this time at No. 1. Last year, BYU started the season ranked second behind UC Irvine, and in 2006 the Cougars held the top spot in the preseason polls.

## PRESEASON EXHIBITION

BYU finished its exhibition schedule having won three of four matches. The only preseason exhibition loss came in a four game loss to Cal State Northridge.

## HOME COURT ADVANTAGE

BYU finished its 2007 regular season with an 11-1 (.917) record at the Smith Fieldhouse. The record was the fifth best mark in Cougar history behind the 1998 (11-0, 1.000), 2004 (16-1, .941), 1999 (15-1, .938), and 2006 (13-1, .929) seasons. BYU started 2007 with five consecutive home wins before losing to No. 2 UC Irvine when the two teams split two matches in Provo. The Cougars then ran off six straight wins to finish the season. The team is 4-0 at home this season after facing off against the No. 1 NAIA team, Cal Baptist, and No. 6 Cal State Northridge.

## PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Feb. 4 - Ivan Perez: 41 kills in two wins against CSUN, including a double-double (20 kills, 10 digs)... .365 on the weekend and had 46 total points

Feb. 19 - Russell Holmes: 30 kills in two wins against UC Irvine with a combined attack percentage of .444... also tallied 20 blocks, three service aces and second double-double of the season.

## PERFECT STARTS

The Cougars began the 2007 season with nine straight wins, but nine is where the streak ended with a loss in Provo against then No. 2 UC Irvine. Before that, the last time BYU won that many matches to start a season was 2001 when the team rambled off 10 wins to start the season. The best start the team has ever had to a season was 1999 when the team won its first 15 matches and finished the year as National Champions with a 30-1 record. The team currently has 11 straight wins without a loss, and Stanford and Pacific stand in the Cougars' way of tying their best start ever.

## 300 CLUB

The Cougars have only hit below .311 as a team four times this season, with the season high at .438 in a three-set sweep at UCSD on Jan. 12. Of the 33 double-digit kill performances BYU has recorded on the year, 23 of those have come with .300-plus hitting percentages and seven have come with .500-plus hitting percentages. In contrast, no team has hit .300 against the Cougars this season. UC Irvine has the lowest percentage against BYU this season at .106 in a 3-1 Cougar win in Irvine, Calif., February 16.

## DOUBLE-DOUBLES

Ivan Perez has recorded four double-doubles on the season, including two last weekend at No. 6 UC Irvine. Russell Holmes has two double-doubles on the year with impressive performances at the net all season. Jonathan Charette and Andrew Stewart each have one double-double on the season that came in the same match, also against UC Irvine.

## SETTING THREE DEEP

Reigning National Newcomer of the Year Yamil Perez was expected to headline the list of setters on the BYU roster in 2008, but injury prevented Perez from competing much during the first part of the season. However, the Cougar hitting has not skipped a beat thanks to exceptional performances from senior Brian Congelliere and sophomore Reed Chilton. The setting trio has led the team to a combined .313 hitting percentage. Congelliere leads the team with 313 set assists and an average of 9.48 assists per game. Chilton is not far behind with 269 set assists and an average of 10.35 assists per game.



## APPROACHING A MILESTONE

BYU currently has 239 conference wins and is hoping to reach the 250 mark this season. The team would need at least a 17-5 MPSF mark to reach the milestone.

## LONGEST FIFTH SET IN MPSF HISTORY

February 15th saw the longest fifth set in BYU and MPSF history. BYU edged UC Irvine on the Anteaters' home court 28-26 in the fifth to earn its tenth win of the season. Previously, the longest fifth set in BYU history went to 21-19 twice against Stanford in consecutive seasons. The Cougars topped the Cardinal 21-19 in Provo during the 2002 MPSF Tournament, and again the following season in Palo Alto, Calif., in the second match of the season.

## OLYMPIC HOPEFULS

Senior outside hitter Ivan Perez and sophomore libero Joel Silva each play for their respective national teams of Puerto Rico and Venezuela. Silva will compete with the Venezuelan team in Beijing this summer in the country's first trip to the Olympic Summer Games in volleyball. Perez and his Puerto Rican compadres are still trying to qualify for the games.

## ALL-AMERICANS

With Yosleyder Cala and Ivan Perez being named First Team and Russell Holmes being named Second Team AVCA All-Americans last year, it marked the 15th consecutive season the Cougars have had at least one All-American. Since 1993, 21 different players have earned 39 citations, 15 of which are first-team honors and 13 of which are second-team honors. Yamil Perez also returns after being named the 2007 National Newcomer of the Year.

## 20-WIN SEASONS

After finishing the 2006 season with a 18-9 record, BYU was held without 20 wins for the first time since the 2000 season. With 2007's 23-6 finish, the Cougars have recorded nine 20-win seasons. The first BYU team to record 20 wins was the 1994 team. The 1994 team finished its season with a 21-6 record and advanced to the final of the MPSF Tournament, losing to Stanford in four games.

## EVERY THREE YEARS...?

Since BYU's first national championship in 1999, the Cougars won the NCAA tournament a total of three times (1999, 2001 and 2004). Since the '99 season, has won the NCAA Championship at least once every three years until the chain was broken in 2007.

## PATCHELL RETAINED AS INTERIM COACH

After guiding the Cougars in 2007 with co-interim head coach Ryan Millar, Shawn Patchell has been retained as the head coach on an interim basis. Earlier this year, Millar announced his decision to return to the U.S. National Team and to also compete professionally. During the summer of 2005, Patchell coached the US World University Games team and in 2006, he was part of the U.S. Boys' Youth National Team coaching staff.

## COACHES OR PLAYERS?

Both members of BYU's coaching staff are coaching at their alma mater. Interim head coach Shawn Patchell starred for the Cougars in his playing days while assistant coach Rob Neilson earned All-MPSF honors for BYU just two seasons ago.

## WHERE ARE YOU FROM?

Players come from all over the world to play with BYU's volleyball team. The Cougars have players from Brazil, Puerto Rico and Venezuela on their roster. Five states are also represented on this year's team: California, Ohio, Nevada, Pennsylvania and Utah. California leads the way with eight players hailing from the Golden State.

## BYU IN THE MPSF TOURNAMENT

Since 1993, BYU has qualified for the MPSF postseason tournament in 13 of 14 seasons including 11 consecutive trips. The Cougars all-time record in the MPSF tournament is 17-11. BYU has won the MPSF tournament three times and holds an 9-5 record in the first round, 4-5 record in the semifinals and a perfect 3-0 record in tournament finals. The Cougars won consecutive MPSF tournament championships in 2003 and 2004.

## BYU IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT

The Cougars have made four NCAA tournament appearances in the program's history. Impressively, BYU has brought home the hardware in three of its four NCAA tournament appearances. The Cougars boast a 7-1 overall record in NCAA tournament play and a perfect 4-0 record in national semifinal matches. The Cougars only loss in the NCAA tournament was in 2003 when they lost to Lewis in a five-game thriller. BYU has earned automatic bids to the Final Four by winning the MPSF tournament three times: 1999, 2003 and 2004.

## A LOOK AT THE CARDINAL

Stanford is currently 9-5 on the season and 5-5 in conference play. Last weekend Stanford beat Pacific on the road to avenge a Pacific sweep earlier in the season and even the Cardinal's MPSF record at 5-5. Sophomore opposite Evan Romero leads the Cardinal attack with an average of 4.5 kills a game and 216 total kills on the year. Junior middle blocker Brandon Williams has 34 total blocks on the season as the anchor of Stanford's block.

## COACH SHAWN PATCHELL



With a career record of 23-6, Shawn Patchell enters his second year as head coach and sixth year overall as a member of BYU's staff. Patchell came to BYU from Laguna Beach High School where he was head coach for both the boy's and girl's volleyball teams.

In addition to his BYU coaching responsibilities, Patchell has been selected to be the 2008 Junior National Team Head Coach. He also coached the Youth National Team at the FIVB World Championships in Mexico in 2007, the first US team to participate in the Youth World Championships.

During the summer of 2005, Patchell also coached the US World University Games team. In 2006 Patchell assisted the Youth National Team to a win over Cuba and a silver medal in the Dominican Republic NORCECA tournament which qualified team USA for the World Championships.

In six seasons at Laguna Beach High School, Patchell's teams qualified for the CIF playoffs every year and were CIF finalists in 1998, 1999 and 2001 and state qualifiers in 1998 and 2001. The Laguna Beach Artists won seven Pacific Coast League Titles with Patchell at the helm. In six seasons, Coach Patchell posted a 137-67 record at LBHS and twice was selected to coach the South Orange County All-Stars. Patchell also coached basketball at Irvine High School and assisted the men's volleyball team at the University of California at Irvine along with coaching at Pepperdine and Stanford during the summer.

A member of BYU's first NCAA men's volleyball team, Patchell was a starter from 1990-93 and recorded a .398 career hitting percentage. In 1992, Patchell's junior year, he led the nation in hitting percentage at .488 and was honored as All-Academic Western Intercollegiate Volleyball Association. He was ranked fourth and 10th nationally in hitting and blocking his senior year. Patchell played professionally in Spain for the Euro Cup qualifier and No. 1-ranked Gran Canaria Team in the Canary Islands and also represented the US in the Federation International Volleyball Association Sand Volleyball Circuit in Europe.

Patchell earned his BA in English with a minor in business management from BYU in 1993 and a master's degree in English Literature from the University of California at Irvine in 2000. He is a part-time member of the BYU English Department where he teaches Masterpieces of American and British Literature and a composition class. Patchell taught English Literature in high schools in Kauai, Hawai'i, Irvine and Laguna Beach, California. Shawn and his wife Davis enjoy surfing, skiing, snowboarding, horseback riding, reading and camping with their three daughters: Jordan (11), Sage (9) and Soren (5). The Patchell's newest addition to the family, Kai, was born in March 2007.

## LAST YEAR VS. STANFORD

Jan. 19, 2007 -- BYU (5-0, 3-0 MPSF) extended its winning streak over Stanford (0-6, 0-3) to seven consecutive matches as the Cougars swept the Cardinal, 30-23, 30-25 and 30-28. The sweep marks the third consecutive match between the two teams that BYU won in three straight games.

"We won it straight games but we have a lot to work on," co head coach Shawn Patchell said. "Credit Stanford, they have a young team that played very well."

BYU got out to a quick start, jumping to a 19-14 game-one lead. In the middle of the first game the Cougars began struggling with their passing as the Cardinal picked up four straight points thanks in part to three passing errors by BYU. The Cougars persevered and came back to win game one, 30-23.

"I felt we got out-passed throughout the night," Patchell said. "They served us tough and we got in a lot of trouble passing."

BYU was led by Yosleyder Cala's 11 kills on .450 hitting. The middle tandem of Rodnei Santos and Russell Holmes had an efficient night hitting .750 and .667, respectively. Senior Scott Cox also hit well on the night, swinging at a .444 clip.

"The good thing about tonight is that all 13 of our players got playing time," Patchell said. "Guys like Scott Cox came off the bench and played well for us."

The Cougars out-blocked Stanford, 13.5 to eight with Holmes leading the Cougars with six total blocks and two block solos.

"Our middles didn't get enough swings tonight," Patchell said. "That is an indication of how we passed. We need to do a better job passing."

Jan. 20, 2007 -- BYU's perfect season start continued, as the Cougars (6-0, 4-0 MPSF) swept Stanford (0-7, 0-4) for the second consecutive night and the fourth consecutive match overall, 30-24, 30-20 and 30-28.

"We were better tonight than last night," co-head coach Shawn Patchell said. "One of our goals this season is to be better on Saturday than Friday and we accomplished that tonight."

Ivan Perez led BYU with 14 kills while hitting .524 (14-3-21) while Rodnei Santos registered his second consecutive .750 (6-0-8) hitting performance. Perez added six digs and three service aces on the night. Libero Joel Silva added a career-best 11 digs for the Cougars.

BYU hit .374 on the match while holding the Cardinal to just a .219 performance. Russell Holmes led Cougar blockers with four while adding seven kills and hitting .438 (7-0-16).

"I'm especially pleased with our serving and passing," Pachell said. "We did both better tonight. Our middles were both very efficient and that is something we always like to see. When our middles get involved like they did tonight you can tell we passed well."

In game one it didn't take long for BYU to assert itself. The Cougars got off to a quick 7-3 lead when setter Yamil Perez dealt an ace. Stanford came back with a 6-3 run to cut BYU's lead to 10-9. From there the Cougars took off, building a 26-19 lead. The two teams traded points for the rest of the match with Holmes driving home a game-winning kill.

The Cougars never trailed in the second game. With BYU leading game two 20-16, the Cougars closed the game with a 10-4 run. After a service error by Stanford's Kawika Shoji, Yosleyder Cala stepped to the service line with a 25-19 lead. Cala's serving led BYU to four consecutive points. The Cougars won the game on a service error by the Cardinal's Matt Ceran.

Game three was a close game throughout its entirety with neither team building a lead larger than three points. With the Cardinal holding to a 22-19 lead, the Cougars came roaring back. After an Ivan Perez kill that sent him to the service line, the Cougars rolled off three consecutive points to give BYU a 25-23 lead. Stanford followed with a 5-2 run to force a Cougars timeout. Out of the timeout Cala got a kill and an ace to give BYU a match point. Cala's serve helped put the Cardinal away as Stanford committed an attack error on the Cougars first match point.

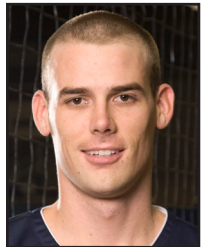
