#### NO. 1 COUGARS TO FACE NO. 2 ANTEATERS

Battling for the top spot in the country and the Mountain Pacific Sports Federation, the No. 1 ranked Cougars will take on No. 2 UC Irvine, Friday and Saturday, March 10th and 11th in Irvine, California. BYU is 14-2 overall and first place in the MPSF at 12-2 while the Anteaters are 15-3 overall and 10-2 in the MPSF.

"Whoever wins these matches will have the upper hand in the conference race," BYU coach Tom Peterson said. "We are the two teams that can control our own destiny. Finishing first in the MPSF would give us home court advantage in the playoffs and that would be a huge advantage. It's been a while since we've played someone this good on the road at sea level. It will be a big test."

The matches between UC Irvine and BYU will be the 34th and 35th meetings in the series. The Cougars lead 28-5 overall and 13-3 at UC Irvine. The last time BYU lost to the Anteaters was in 2000 when UC Irvine took the second of two meetings between the teams. Last season, BYU pulled out two wins at home against the Anteaters (3-1 and 3-0) and will look to do the same this weekend.

"They (the Anteaters) are great because they are very consistent and they have a lot of confidence," Peterson said. "They have a balanced attack and all of their positions are pretty solid."

Leading UC Irvine is 6-5 outside hitter, Jayson Jablonsky, who averages 4.40 kills per game and 0.72 blocks per game. Matt Webber is second on the team in kills at 4.39 per game and adds 0.89 blocks per game.

UC Irvine's last outing was a sweep of UCLA (31-29, 30-27, 30-25). Weber had 17 kills on the night, followed by Jablonsky with 13.

The Anteaters' overall hitting percentage is .321 while the Cougars are hitting .359, first in the nation. Overall averages for UC Irvine include 2.98 blocks per game while BYU records an average of 2.88 blocks per game.

Last week BYU earned back-to-back sweeps of Stanford, March 3 and 4. Sophomore Russell Holmes led the Cougars with 23 kills and a .700 hitting percentage for the two nights. Freshman Yosleyder Cala led the team with a total of 25 kills while hitting .697.

LAST MATCHES - BYU vs. STANFORD

The Cougars improved to 14-2 overall and 12-2 in the Mountain Pacific Sports Federation with two sweeps over Stanford March 3 and 4. In the first match, BYU was dominant throughout, winning 30-16, 30-23, 30-23. In game one, the Cougars hit .800 (20-0-25), a school record for highest percentage in a game with more than 20 kill attempts. Yosleyder Cala led BYU with 12 kills in just two games and hit a career-high .857. Russell Holmes and Ivan Perez added 10 kills each and Victor Batista hit .889 and had eight kills. In the second match, the Cougars dominated game one, 30-15, hitting .762 (17-1-21). Games two and three were close but Holmes pounded out the last two points to win each game (33-31, 32-30). Holmes had 13 kills and hit .800 while Cala had 13 kills and hit .579.

THE POLLS

BYU maintained its No. 1 ranking in the CSTV / AVCA Division I-II Men's Coaches Top 15 Poll for the fourth-consecutive week. The Cougars reached the top spot after earning back-to-back home wins over USC, Feb. 10 and 11. BYU received all 16 first-place votes in the CSTV / AVCA poll for the second-consecutive week. The Cougars have been No. 1 in the Molten / Volleyball Poll since Feb. 13.

EXTREME VOLLEYBALL: HOLMES EDITION

Russell Holmes had one of the best hitting weekends of his career when BYU played Stanford, March 3 and 4. In the first match, he had 10 kills and four blocks and hit .600. In the second match, he hit .800 (13-1-15) and added three blocks. For the weekend, he hit .700 (23-2-30) and came through in the clutch, recording the final two points in games two and three on Saturday. In BYU's last seven matches, Holmes is hitting .588 and averaging 2.92 kills per game and 1.33 blocks.

OFF THE CHARTS

The BYU offensive attack was unstoppable against Stanford, March 3 and 4. In game one on Friday, the Cougars tied a school record for highest hitting percentage in a single game by hitting .800 (20-0-25). In 2004, BYU hit .800 against UC San Diego (17-1-20). The Cougars finished the match hitting .537 (55-11-82). Yosleyder Cala set a personal best by hitting .857 (12-0-14) and Victor Batista hit .889 (8-0-9). On Saturday, the Cougars started out hot again, hitting .762 (17-1-21) and finished the match at .537 (54-10-82). Russell Holmes hit .800 (13-1-15) for the match. BYU now leads the nation in hitting percentage at .359. The Cougars' team hitting percentage increased from .341 to .359 following the two matches.

CALA-BRATE GOOD TIMES

Yosleyder Cala has become one of the most dominant offensive weapons in the country. Cala has played in eight matches and is hitting .497 and averaging 4.00 kills per game as an outside hitter. While he has not played in enough games to qualify for the NCAA statistical leaders, he would rank third in the nation and first among outside hitters in hitting percentage. Cala has been especially dominant in the last five matches, hitting .634 and averaging 4.64 kills per game and 1.50 digs.

A LOOK AT UC IRVINE

UC Irvine is currently ranked No. 2 in the nation and is 16-3 overall and 10-2 in the Mountain Pacific Sports Federation. The Anteaters trail BYU by two wins in conference play and are even with the Cougars in the loss column. UC Irvine is on a 10-match win streak that includes seven MPSF wins. The Anteaters have defeated UCLA and Long Beach State on the road during the streak. In conference play, UC Irvine has lost to Pepperdine and Hawai'i. The Anteaters split with Hawai'i on the road. Jayson Jablonsky and Matt Webber lead UC Irvine in kills at 4.40 and 4.39, respectively, while Aaron Harrell leads in blocks at 1.34 per game and Brent Asuka leads in digs at 3.32 per game.

LAST YEAR VS. UC IRVINE

The Cougars defeated UC Irvine twice at home in 2005 with the first match going to four games and the second going to three. In the first match, Ivan Perez led BYU with 14 kills and eight digs while Michael Burke added 13 kills and seven blocks. Victor Batista and Taylor Evans registered 12 and 10 kills, respectively. The Cougars limited the Anteaters to .175 hitting. In the second match, Burke had 10 kills and hit .769. Other BYU players with double-digit kills were Perez (13), Evans (12) and Casey Patterson (10). Rob Neilson dished out 46 assists and set the Cougars to a .436 hitting percentage. He also had a match-high seven digs.

Tom Peterson, coach of two NCAA national championship teams, BYU alum and 1994 NCAA Coach of the Year, enters his fourth year as the head coach of the Cougar men's volleyball program. In 2005, he led BYU to a 20-10 overall record and a third-place finish in the MPSF at 15-7 despite returning just two starters from the 2004 National Championship team. It was the Cougar's fourth-consecutive 20-win season and third in three years under Peterson. He coached four All-MPSF performers and three All-Americans in 2005.



Peterson guided the Cougars to one of their most successful seasons in 2004, leading BYU to a 29-4 record and a first-place finish at the NCAA Tournament while coaching four All-Americans and the school's first AVCA National Player of the Year. He also guided the Cougars to regular-season and MPSF-tournament championships. By defeating UC Irvine in the first round of the MPSF Tournament, Peterson earned the 300th win of his collegiate coaching career. His record currently stands at 200-72 coaching NCAA men's volleyball (BYU and Penn State) and 324-151 overall.

With a victory over Lewis in the NCAA Semifinals, Peterson led BYU to its fourth National Championship match in six years. After splitting the first four games with Long Beach State, the Cougars came back from a 10-6 deficit and saved two 49er match points to win the decisive fifth game, 19-17. A native of Orem, Utah, Peterson came to BYU in 2002 with over 20 years of volleyball coaching experience, including 17 years as a collegiate head coach. In 1983, he was an assistant to women's coach Elaine Michaelis. In 1984, Peterson assumed the head-coaching duties of the BYU men's volleyball club team, guiding the Cougars to three consecutive National Collegiate Club Championships from 1986-88.

After five seasons at BYU as coach of the club team, Peterson was hired as the head coach of the Penn State NCAA men's volleyball team (1989-94). He guided Penn State to five NCAA Final Four appearances in six years, including a National Championship in 1994. That National Championship victory was one of Peterson's most memorable coaching experiences, as it was "a thrill to be the first non-California team to win." The Nittany Lions earned a 25-3 (.893) record in 1994 and Peterson was named the NCAA Men's Volleyball Coach of the Year. During his six years at Penn State, Peterson guided the Nittany Lions to a 128-50 (.719) overall record.

His next coaching stop was a three-season stint as the head women's coach at Salt Lake Community College, where he posted an 83-38 (.686) record from 1996-98. He had been working full-time as a physical education teacher at SLCC when he was asked to start a women's volleyball team. The team was ranked No. 7 in its first year.

After SLCC he coached the Utah State women's team for two seasons, leading the team to a 22-10 record in 2000, only his second year with the program. That season, the Aggies earned an NCAA Tournament berth for the first time in program history, advancing to the second round. Peterson guided Utah State to as high as No. 17 in the national polls and finished ranked No. 22, marking the program's first top-25 ranking. The University of New Mexico then hired Peterson as the head coach of its women's team. He coached the Lobos for one season before returning to BYU in 2002.

Education has always been important to Peterson, who holds a doctoral degree in physical education administration, curriculum and instruction from BYU with a minor in educational psychology (1992). He earned his bachelor's degree in physical education and his secondary teaching certificate from BYU in 1978. In 1982 Peterson earned a master's degree in professional leadership from BYU. He currently teaches sports psychology at BYU. Peterson is married to the former Sheryl Rice of Bakersfield, Calif. Sheryl is also active in the volleyball circle, having served as the director of the Lobo Volleyball League in Albuquerque, one of the largest recreational volleyball programs in the country. Outside of volleyball, the Petersons enjoy traveling, yard sales and gardening.

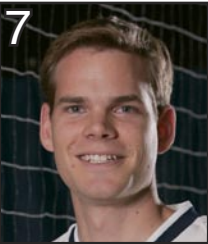
