COUGARS HEAD TO SAN DIEGO

BYU will head to UC San Diego for its second road trip of the season and play two matches versus the Tritons, Thursday and Saturday, Feb. 16 and 18. Following two home wins over USC, the Cougars are 10-2 overall and second in the Mountain Pacific Sports Federation at 8-2.

"UC San Diego is the only division II team competing in our league," BYU coach Tom Peterson said. "While they are at a disadvantage in that aspect, they work very hard and are very well coached. We want to go in there and play our hardest and show that we respect them."

BYU is coming off back-to-back wins over USC in Provo and is ranked No. 1 in the CSTV/AVCA Division I-II Men's Coaches Top 15 Poll and the *Volleyball* Magazine poll. The Cougars started the season ranked No. 1 in the *Volleyball* Magazine poll but this is the first time they have been ranked in the top spot in the CSTV/AVCA poll.

The matches will be the 19th and 20th meetings between BYU and UC San Diego. The Cougars have dominated the series, leading 18-0, including 8-0 in San Diego. BYU has swept the Tritons 14 times and the teams have never player a five-game match.

Outside hitter Jon Daze leads UC San Diego in kills at 2.82 per game and adds 1.29 digs per game. Middle blocker Garret Smith leads the team in hitting percentage at .336 and averages 2.26 kills and 0.84 blocks. As a team, the Tritons are hitting .195 and average 2.12 blocks and 8.24 digs per game.

In the first match against USC last weekend, Jonathan Charette and Russell Holmes led the Cougars to a 3-1 win. Charette tallied 13 kills and seven blocks while hitting .364 and Holmes had 12 kills and seven blocks and hit .526.

The next night, BYU dropped games one and two but won game three, 30-20, behind the play of Taylor Evans and Yosleyder Cala. The Cougars continued to roll, winning game four 30-22 and then stealing the match from the Trojans with a 15-11 win in game five. BYU hit a combined .594 (45-7-64) in games three, four and five. Cala led BYU with a team season-high 26 kills on Saturday while hitting .622 (26-3-37).

LAST MATCHES - BYU vs. USC

The Cougars improved to 10-2 overall and 8-2 in the Mountain Pacific Sports Federation with two wins over USC Friday and Saturday, Feb 10 and 11. In the first match, BYU used a balanced attack and strong defense to earn a 3-1 (30-24, 28-30, 30-27, 30-25) win. Jonathan Charette had 13 kills and seven blocks, a career high, to lead the Cougars while Russell Holmes added 12 kills and seven blocks while hitting .526. In the second match, BYU lost game one 30-25 while hitting just .032. Yosleyder Cala entered the match late in the game and provided a lift but the Cougars lost again in game two, 30-26. From there BYU dominated as the offense got going. The Cougars hit .483 and won the third 30-20 and were even better in the fourth, hitting .583 on their way to a 30-22 win. BYU was nearly perfect in game five, hitting .909 (10-0-11) to win 15-11. Cala finished with a BYU season-high 26 kills, hit .622 and added three aces while Taylor Evans recorded 17 kills. Brian Rowley tied the BYU rally scoring record for most digs in a match on Saturday with 16. He had 30 for the weekend.

THE POLLS

BYU earned a No. 1 ranking in the CSTV/AVCA Division I-II Men's Coaches Top 15 Poll for the first time in 2006. The Cougars reached the top spot after earning back-to-back home wins over USC. BYU received nine of the possible 16 first-place votes while Pepperdine received the other seven. The Cougars are also ranked No. 1 by *Volleyball* Magazine. BYU was No. 1 in the first three polls but dropped to No. 2 after losing to UCLA.

CALA DOMINATES TROJANS

Yosleyder Cala dominated USC Saturday, Feb. 11 when he recorded 26 kills and hit .622. It took the 6-8 freshman just 37 swings to reach the BYU season high as he recorded just three hitting errors. Cala used power and various tip shots to fool the USC blockers. He also added three aces, five digs and two blocks. Cala finished the match with 30.0 points.

CAN YOU DIG IT?

Brian Rowley had the best defensive weekend of his career when BYU defeated USC in back-to-back matches last Friday and Saturday. On Friday, he tied his career high with 14 digs in BYU's 3-1 win. On Saturday, he tied the BYU rally scoring record with 16 digs in the Cougars' come-from-behind 3-2 win. BYU lost games one and two on Saturday but dominated USC in games three, four and five to capture the win and improve to 9-1 at home. Rowley recorded 14 digs twice last season and his previous high this season was 11, which he accomplished against Cal Baptist and Cal State Northridge.

NATION'S BEST FANS

BYU fans continued to show their support for the men's volleyball team as several thousands showed up to cheer on the Cougars when they played USC. On Friday, Feb. 10, 3,263 attended the match while 2,718 came out on Saturday night, despite the fact that there was a men's basketball game that night starting an hour before the volleyball match. BYU sold out both of its matches against Pepperdine and over 4,300 fans attended each night against Cal State Northridge and over 3,500 attended each night against UC Santa Barbara. The Cougars are now averaging 3,823 fans per match, the best in the NCAA.

PEREZ SWEEPS PLAYER OF THE WEEK AWARDS (Jan. 23)

Ivan Perez swept the national and league weekly honors by being named the American Volleyball Coaches Association and Mountain Pacific Sport Federation Player of the Week for his play in then-No. 2 BYU's back-to-back wins over then-No. 8 UC Santa Barbara. On Jan. 20, the sophomore from Puerto Rico had a season-high 23 kills, hit .472 (23-6-36) and recorded six digs and four blocks in leading the Cougars to a 3-1 win over Santa Barbara. BYU started the match with 14 kills on 15 attempts, including Perez going six-for-six. Perez continued his hot play by pounding out a match-high 19 kills and hitting a season-high .571 (19-3-28) on Jan. 21.

For the weekend, Perez averaged 6.00 kills per game, hit .516 (42-9-64) and had 46 service return attempts without and error. In 2005, Perez was an AVCA second-team All-American. A BYU student-athlete has earned the AVCA national honor 14 times, the last being Rob Neilson on March 21, 2005.

A LOOK AT UC SAN DIEGO

UC San Diego is 1-10 overall and 0-7 in the Mountain Pacific Sports Federation. The Tritons' only win this season came Feb. 1 against Princeton. In league play, UC San Diego has faced Long Beach State twice, Pacific, Stanford, Pepperdine, USC and UC Santa Barbara. The Tritons have also played Ohio State and Cal Baptist. While UC San Diego participates in the MPSF, it is the only division II school in the league. The Tritons are coached by Kevin Ring, who was named the head coach this season after spending nine years as an assistant for the Tritons.

LAST YEAR VS. UC SAN DIEGO

The Cougars swept UC San Diego twice in Provo in 2005. In the first match, the Cougars limited the Tritons to a .116 (33-23-86) hitting percentage while recording a .375 (44-14-80) clip. Victor Batista had a match-high 12 kills and four blocks while Michael Burke had 10 kills and three blocks. Russ Hardy had nine kills to lead the Tritons while Dickens Tai had a match-best 10 digs. BYU was equally dominant the next night as Batista and Casey Patterson had nine kills apiece and Burke had seven blocks in another sweep. The Cougars limited the Tritons to .060 (29-24-84) percent hitting.



Tom Peterson, coach of two NCAA national championship teams, BYU alum and 1994 NCAA Coach of the Year, enters his fourth year as the head coach of the Cougar men's volleyball program. In 2005, he led BYU to a 20-10 overall record and a third-place finish in the MPSF at 15-7 despite returning just two starters from the 2004 National Championship team. It was the Cougar's fourthconsecutive 20-win season and third in three years under Peterson. He coached four All-MPSF performers and three All-Americans in 2005.

Peterson guided the Cougars to one of their most successful seasons in 2004, leading BYU to a 29-4 record and a first-place finish at the NCAA Tournament while coaching four All-Americans and the school's first AVCA National Player of the Year. He also guided the Cougars to regular-season and MPSF-



With a victory over Lewis in the NCAA Semifinals, Peterson led BYU to its fourth National Championship match in six years. After splitting the first four games with Long Beach State, the Cougars came back from a 10-6 deficit and saved two 49er match points to win the decisive fifth game, 19-17. A native of Orem, Utah, Peterson came to BYU in 2002 with over 20 years of volleyball coaching experience, including 17 years as a collegiate head coach. In 1983, he was an assistant to women's coach Elaine Michaelis. In 1984, Peterson assumed the head-coaching duties of the BYU men's volleyball club team, guiding the Cougars to three consecutive National Collegiate Club Championships from 1986-88.

After five seasons at BYU as coach of the club team, Peterson was hired as the head coach of the Penn State NCAA men's volleyball team (1989-94). He guided Penn State to five NCAA Final Four appearances in six years, including a National Championship in 1994. That National Championship victory was one of Peterson's most memorable coaching experiences, as it was "a thrill to be the first non-California team to win." The Nittany Lions earned a 25-3 (.893) record in 1994 and Peterson was named the NCAA Men's Volleyball Coach of the Year. During his six years at Penn State, Peterson guided the Nittany Lions to a 128-50 (.719) overall record.

His next coaching stop was a three-season stint as the head women's coach at Salt Lake Community College, where he posted an 83-38 (.686) record from 1996-98. He had been working full-time as a physical education teacher at SLCC when he was asked to start a women's volleyball team. The team was ranked No. 7 in its first year.

After SLCC he coached the Utah State women's team for two seasons, leading the team to a 22-10 record in 2000, only his second year with the program. That season, the Aggies earned an NCAA Tournament berth for the first time in program history, advancing to the second round. Peterson guided Utah State to as high as No. 17 in the national polls and finished ranked No. 22, marking the program's first top-25 ranking. The University of New Mexico then hired Peterson as the head coach of its women's team. He coached the Lobos for one season before returning to BYU in 2002.

Education has always been important to Peterson, who holds a doctoral degree in physical education administration, curriculum and instruction from BYU with a minor in educational psychology (1992). He earned his bachelor's degree in physical education and his secondary teaching certificate from BYU in 1978. In 1982 Peterson earned a master's degree in professional leadership from BYU. He currently teaches sports psychology at BYU. Peterson is married to the former Sheryl Rice of Bakersfield, Calif. Sheryl is also active in the volleyball circle, having served as the director of the Lobo Volleyball League in Albuquerque, one of the largest recreational volleyball programs in the country. Outside of volleyball, the Petersons enjoy traveling, yard sales and gardening.


