BYU CONCLUDES SEASON WITH MATCHES AT HAWAI'I

With the right to host a first round Mountain Pacific Sports Federation tournament match on the line, No. 4 BYU will conclude its regular season with two match against second-ranked Hawai'i in Honolulu this weekend, Friday and Saturday, April 14 and 15. The Cougars are third in the MPSF at 14-6 and Hawai'i is second at 17-3.

BYU (18-6 overall) faces a Warriors team (21-4 overall) that has won 17-consecutive matches. Hawai'i is still in contention to win the MPSF regular season championship and the Cougars could finish anywhere from third to sixth in the league, depending on what they and Pepperdine (14-7 in the MPSF), CS Northridge (13-7) and Long Beach State (12-8) do this week.

"We both have a lot on the line this weekend," BYU coach Tom Peterson said. "We are fighting for the chance to host a first round match while they (the Warriors) are out to prove they are the best team in the league."

The matches will be the 34th and 35th meetings between BYU and Hawai'i. The Cougars own a 21-12 lead and have won the last six meetings, including two sweeps in Provo and a 3-1 win in Honolulu in 2005. Peterson is 7-1 against the Warriors since coming to BYU in 2003.

Hawai'i is the second hottest team in the country behind UC Irvine, which has won 19 match in a row. The Warriors do, however, own the tie breaker between the teams. Hawai'i is the top offensive team in the league, hitting at a .345 clip and averaging 16.35 kills per game on the season. Jose Delgado leads the team in kills per game at 4.33 and Lauri Hakala is second at 3.93 while hitting .363.

The Warriors' most recent victories were 3-1 and 3-0 wins last weekend against UC San Diego. During the 17-match win streak, Hawai'i has gone 15-0 against MPSF teams.

The Cougars are coming off back-to-back losses to Long Beach State on the road, April 6 and 7. BYU held a 2-0 lead in the first match but then allowed the 49ers to take the next three games. The Cougars won game one the next night but then dropped the next three. Russell Holmes recorded 17 blocks over the weekend and Victor Batista hit .435 (27-7-46) to lead BYU.

Holmes is making a strong case for All-America and All-MPSF status, hitting .462 on the season and averaging 2.46 kills and 1.50 blocks per game.

BYU will play in the first round of the MPSF Tournament Saturday, April 22.

LAST MATCHES - BYU vs. Long Beach

BYU dropped two matches to Long Beach State, April 6 and 7, and is now 18-6 overall and 14-6 in the MPSF. The Cougars jumped out to a 2-0 lead in the first match with 31-29 and 30-26 wins in games one and two. BYU then went flat, falling 30-26 and 30-22, in games three and four. The Cougars led 8-7 in game five but then fell behind 11-9 and could not recover as the 49ers went on to win 15-13. Yosleyder Cala had 19 kills and five blocks while Russell Holmes had 11 kills and nine blocks. BYU won game one 31-29 the second night but then Long Beach came back and won the next three games to win 3-1. Victor Batista led the Cougars with 14 kills and five blocks.

THE POLLS

BYU fell to No. 4 in the CSTV / AVCA Division I-II Men's Coaches Top 15 Poll after back-to-back losses to then No. 7 and current No. 5 Long Beach State. The Cougars previously held the second spot in the AVCA poll four-consecutive weeks. Prior to the No. 2 ranking, BYU held the top spot for four-straight weeks, starting Feb. 13 after two wins over USC, but fell to second after two five-game losses to current No. 1 UC Irvine. The Cougars are now No. 3 in the Volleyball/Molten poll.

TOURNAMENT SCENARIOS

UC Irvine and Hawai'i have locked up the top two spots in the MPSF while BYU and three other teams are fighting for the third and fourth spots, which both host a first round match. The Cougars are third in the MPSF at 14-6 with two matches versus Hawai'i remaining. If BYU earns a weekend sweep, it will finish alone at third in the league and host the No. 6 seed. If the Cougars split with the Warriors, they will finish at least tied for third and host a first round match as the third or fourth seed. If BYU loses both matches, it will need help from the other three teams to have a chance at hosting. Following are the other three teams that are in contention to host a first round match, their remaining schedules and how they fared against BYU.

THE BIG FELLAS GET IT DONE

BYU middle blockers Victor Batista and Russell Holmes dominated Pacific both matches last weekend. In the first match, Batista had 15 kills and three blocks while hitting .545 and Holmes had 12 kills and five blocks and hit .526. In the second match, Holmes had 15 kills and six blocks and hit .700 and Batista had 12 kills and eight blocks and hit .588. For the weekend, they combined to hit .590 (54-8-78) and average 7.71 kills and 3.29 blocks per game.

A LOOK AT HAWAII

Hawaii is riding a 17-match win streak and is currently 21-4 overall and second in the Mountain Pacific Sports Federation at 17-3. The Warriors have clinched a spot in the MPSF postseason tournament and will host at least a first round match. UC Irvine leads the league at 18-2 in MPSF play and both teams have two remaining matches. Hawaii owns the tie breaker between the teams. During the 17-match win streak, the Warriors have gone 15-0 in MPSF play after starting 1-2.

LAST TIME VS. HAWAII

BYU and Hawaii played three times in 2005 with all three matches going to the Cougars. The first meeting was at the Outrigger Tournament, where BYU won 3-1 (30-28, 25-30, 30-28, 30-19) and finished 3-0 to win the tournament. Later in the season, the Warriors visited Provo ranked No. 3 in the nation and in third place in the MPSF at 9-3 while the Cougars were No. 6 and fifth in the MPSF at 7-5. BYU dominated Hawaii both nights, winning 30-28, 30-19, 30-26 and 30-27, 30-24, 30-27. The Cougars had 35.0 total blocks (5.83 per game) in the two matches and limited the Warriors to .119 (72-50-185) hitting.

Tom Peterson, coach of two NCAA national championship teams, BYU alum and 1994 NCAA Coach of the Year, enters his fourth year as the head coach of the Cougar men's volleyball program. In 2005, he led BYU to a 20-10 overall record and a third-place finish in the MPSF at 15-7 despite returning just two starters from the 2004 National Championship team. It was the Cougar's fourth-consecutive 20-win season and third in three years under Peterson. He coached four All-MPSF performers and three All-Americans in 2005.



Peterson guided the Cougars to one of their most successful seasons in 2004, leading BYU to a 29-4 record and a first-place finish at the NCAA Tournament while coaching four All-Americans and the school's first AVCA National Player of the Year. He also guided the Cougars to regular-season and MPSF-tournament championships. By defeating UC Irvine in the first round of the MPSF Tournament, Peterson earned the 300th win of his collegiate coaching career. His record currently stands at 200-72 coaching NCAA men's volleyball (BYU and Penn State) and 324-151 overall.

With a victory over Lewis in the NCAA Semifinals, Peterson led BYU to its fourth National Championship match in six years. After splitting the first four games with Long Beach State, the Cougars came back from a 10-6 deficit and saved two 49er match points to win the decisive fifth game, 19-17. A native of Orem, Utah, Peterson came to BYU in 2002 with over 20 years of volleyball coaching experience, including 17 years as a collegiate head coach. In 1983, he was an assistant to women's coach Elaine Michaelis. In 1984, Peterson assumed the head-coaching duties of the BYU men's volleyball club team, guiding the Cougars to three consecutive National Collegiate Club Championships from 1986-88.

After five seasons at BYU as coach of the club team, Peterson was hired as the head coach of the Penn State NCAA men's volleyball team (1989-94). He guided Penn State to five NCAA Final Four appearances in six years, including a National Championship in 1994. That National Championship victory was one of Peterson's most memorable coaching experiences, as it was "a thrill to be the first non-California team to win." The Nittany Lions earned a 25-3 (.893) record in 1994 and Peterson was named the NCAA Men's Volleyball Coach of the Year. During his six years at Penn State, Peterson guided the Nittany Lions to a 128-50 (.719) overall record.

His next coaching stop was a three-season stint as the head women's coach at Salt Lake Community College, where he posted an 83-38 (.686) record from 1996-98. He had been working full-time as a physical education teacher at SLCC when he was asked to start a women's volleyball team. The team was ranked No. 7 in its first year.

After SLCC he coached the Utah State women's team for two seasons, leading the team to a 22-10 record in 2000, only his second year with the program. That season, the Aggies earned an NCAA Tournament berth for the first time in program history, advancing to the second round. Peterson guided Utah State to as high as No. 17 in the national polls and finished ranked No. 22, marking the program's first top-25 ranking. The University of New Mexico then hired Peterson as the head coach of its women's team. He coached the Lobos for one season before returning to BYU in 2002.

Education has always been important to Peterson, who holds a doctoral degree in physical education administration, curriculum and instruction from BYU with a minor in educational psychology (1992). He earned his bachelor's degree in physical education and his secondary teaching certificate from BYU in 1978. In 1982 Peterson earned a master's degree in professional leadership from BYU. He currently teaches sports psychology at BYU. Peterson is married to the former Sheryl Rice of Bakersfield, Calif. Sheryl is also active in the volleyball circle, having served as the director of the Lobo Volleyball League in Albuquerque, one of the largest recreational volleyball programs in the country. Outside of volleyball, the Petersons enjoy traveling, yard sales and gardening.
