— BYU is a combined 6-13 all-time against this week's Cathedral City Classic opponents.

— BYU holds a 1-2 record against ranked teams thus far on the year, defeating No. 19 Texas A&M, 7-2, and losing 3-2 to No. 14 Oregon and 7-4 to No. 18 Stanford. The Cougars will face two more ranked teams, No. 18 Nebraska and No. 8 Tennessee, both on Friday, Feb. 25.

— Senior catcher Jessica Fitu was named the MWC Player of the Week after hitting .750 last week, including a 5-for-5 performance against Cal State Northridge, including the fourth grand slam of her career, a BYU record.

— Sophomore Hannah Howell was also named MWC Pitcher of the Week after winning two games versus SIUE and Cal Poly. Howell held opponents to zero runs and 15 strikeouts in 11.1 innings.

— BYU currently leads the MWC in batting average, on base percentage, runs, hits, RBI, doubles, total bases and walks.

OPPONENTS SERIES NOTES

BYU and Florida State have faced off just twice, splitting a doubleheader in Provo in 2005. FSU has won five of its last six games and is lead by Kelly Hensley with a .421 average, including eight hits and two home runs. Tiffani Brown leads the team with 14 hits, including three triples, while Sarah Hamilton has 53 strikeouts for FSU, sporting a 3-3 record and 1.34 ERA.

This will be the fourth meeting in the last five years between BYU and Virginia, with the Cougars holding a current two-game win streak. The Cavaliers will play their first games outside of North Carolina this weekend after going 3-2 last week. Virginia's Stephanie Harris has 12 hits and Taylor Williams has 11 to pace the Cavaliers with Melanie Mitchell starting all but two games this year, currently sitting at a 4-2 record and 2.61 ERA.

Nebraska has a long history with the Cougars, leading BYU in the series, 5-3. However, BYU has won three of the last four, including a 5-1 win last season. The Cornhuskers have started off hot this season with a 10-1 record, their only loss coming to Arizona. Taylor Edwards has had a huge year so far, recently breaking an NCAA record by hitting a home run in seven-straight games. She is batting .405 with 15 hits and 19 RBI. Pitcher Ashley Hagemann boasts a team-high 1.51 ERA and 7-1 record, including 62 strikeouts in nine overall appearances.

Tennessee has never lost to BYU in three tries, including a 4-0 win last time the two teams met in 2009. Like BYU this season, the Lady Volunteers have defeated Cal Poly, Boise State and SIUE while losing to Stanford. Seven Tennessee starters are hitting at least .400 led by Shelby Burchell's .565 average and four home runs. Cat Hosfield has a 0.60 ERA in five appearances.

BYU is also looking for its first win against Ohio State. The Buckeyes have won just two of their last six games. Alicia Herron leads the team with 15 hits and eight RBI. Kasie Kelly has pitched 36.0 innings for OSU and has a 3.50 ERA and 2-1 record.

LAS VEGAS (Feb. 17, 2011) - No. 23 BYU softball saw double all over the scoreboard at the Desert Classic, doubling up Southern Illinois University Edwardsville, 10-5, on Thursday.

The Cougars, facing the Cougars of SIUE for the first time, used a slew of doubles to stay within reach of SIUE and eventually take the lead after six runs in the fourth inning and career performance from sophomore pitcher Hannah Howell.

Howell entered the game for BYU in the second inning after SIUE had jumped out to a 5-2 lead with no outs. The sophomore ended the inning with no more runs and the Cougars would never threaten again. Howell held SIUE scoreless for the remainder of the game, allowing three hits and striking out a career-high nine batters, including the SIUE side in the seventh inning.

At the plate, the first BYU double resulted in two Cougars runs in the first inning. Senior catcher Jessica Fitu's shot to center field scored sophomore JC Clayton and junior Tiffany Messerschmidt.

Another double by junior Delaney Willard started off the second inning for BYU. With the bases loaded three batters later, it was Messerschmidt's turn to bring teammates in, jolting a two-run single to bring BYU within a run, 5-4.

BYU took the lead and then pulled away with a six-run fourth inning. With the bases loaded and one out, senior Caschjen Atagi doubled down the left-field line, bringing in Messerschmidt and sophomore JC Clayton. Junior Stacie Graham and Clayton would add RBI singles later in the inning.

Fitu went 3-for-3 with two RBI and one run. Messerschmidt also finished with three hits, adding two RBI and two runs.

CAL POLY (L, 3-5) & BOISE STATE (W, 12-11)

LAS VEGAS (Feb. 18, 2011) - Another strong relief appearance by sophomore pitcher Hannah Howell and patient hitting were the keys in No. 23 BYU softball's 8-6 win over Cal Poly after which BYU staved off a furious run by Boise State to claim a 12-11 win at the Louisville Slugger Desert Classic on Friday.

After holding SIUE scoreless Thursday evening to earn her first win of the year, Howell came on in third inning against the Mustangs with BYU down 6-3, again allowing no runs and striking out five.

Three drawn walks by BYU loaded the bases, then brought in two runs in the third inning. In the fourth, BYU slowly chipped away at the Mustangs with a mixture of walks, fielder's choices and singles. After Jessica Dugas walked and JC Clayton singled, Tiffany Messerschmidt reached on an error to load the bases and Kristin Delahoussaye got enough on the ball for an RBI ground out.

Senior Kristin Delahoussaye buried the slump she had been in since the beginning of the young season against Boise State, exploding for two doubles and a home run on her way to hitting 4-for-5 with five RBI and two runs. Fellow senior Jessica Fitu added a homer and a double, hitting 3-for-5 with two RBI and two runs.

Up one run at 6-5, BYU appeared to pull away with a six-run sixth inning. Junior Stacie Graham hit a triple that scored Delaney Willard and Madisen Robb. JC Clayton's single brought in Graham, and the Cougars had two on base after Tiffany Messerschmidt reached on a bunt. Delahoussaye finished off the inning with a 3-run blast to left field, giving BYU a 12-6 lead needing three outs to finish off the Broncos.

But Boise State wouldn't quit, collecting a flurry of singles off the three Cougar pitchers needed to end the inning. Up by a single run and with runners on first and second, freshman Katie Manuma finally forced a fly ball into left field to end the game.

STANFORD (L, 4-7) & CS NORTHRIDGE (W, 11-0)

LAS VEGAS (Feb. 19, 2011) - No. 23 BYU came away empty against No. 18 Stanford, 7-4, before romping past Cal State Northridge, 11-0 behind Jessica Fitu's grand slam at the Louisville Slugger Desert Classic on Saturday.

Falling behind 5-1 midway through game one, BYU capitalized on two Cardinal errors and a two-run single by senior Kristin Delahoussaye to score three runs in the bottom of the fourth.

But with the bases loaded and two outs in the third and fourth and only one out with the bases full in the sixth inning, the Cougars couldn't post more runs to the scoreboard.

Stanford was content to intentionally walk senior Fitu, a .536 hitter coming into the game, twice to load the bases, but the Cougars couldn't make the Cardinal pay, leaving a total of 11 runners on base in all.

Up 2-0, Fitu's long ball to right center buried Northridge and made Fitu BYU's all-time leader in career grand slams with four. Fitu finished a monstrous game by hitting 5-for-5 with six RBI and a run for the Cougars.

JC Clayton, Tiffany Messerschmidt and Delahoussaye added two hits apiece for BYU in the team's first shutout of the year. Freshman pitcher Tori Almond went the distance for the Cougars to earn her first-career win, allowing no runs on three hits and six strikeouts.

FITU, HOWELL MWC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

COLORADO SPRINGS, Colo. (Feb. 22, 2011) – BYU catcher Jessica Fitu has been named Mountain West Conference Softball Player of the Week, while teammate Hannah Howell has been named Pitcher of the Week, for games played from Feb. 14-20.

It is Fitu’s fourth career honor and Howell’s first of her career. Fitu’s previous three honors came in 2009 when she was a sophomore and going by her maiden name, Jessica Purcell. The nationally-ranked Cougars went 4-1 last week in the Louisville Slugger Desert Classic in Las Vegas.

Fitu, a 5-9 senior from Walnut, Calif., hit .750 over five games last week. Fitu recorded 12 hits in 16 at-bats and had six walks and a hit by pitch to up her on-base percentage to .826.

She started the tournament hitting 3-for-3 with a run scored, a double and two RBI in BYU’s 10-5 win against Southern Illinois-Edwardsville on Feb. 17. Against Cal Poly on Friday morning, Fitu was walked three times in five plate appearances and followed up with a 3-for-5 performance against Boise State with two runs scored, a double, a home run and two RBI. The Cougars won both games, 8-6 vs. Cal Poly and 12-11 against Boise State. Stanford walked Fitu three times, twice intentionally, to start the action on Saturday morning. She was able to get a hit and an RBI in the 7-4 loss to the Cardinal. In an 11-0 win against Cal State Northridge to cap off the tournament, Fitu was 5-for-5 with a run scored, a grand slam home run and 6 RBI.

Howell, a 5-3 sophomore from Winnfield, La., threw 11.1 innings of relief over three games last week, not allowing an earned run while collecting 15 strikeouts and earning her first two wins of the season. Howell started the week with 6.0 innings against Southern Illinois-Edwardsville, holding the Cougars to no runs and just two hits. She struck out a career-high nine batters, helping BYU come from behind to a 10-5 win. Her second win of the season came against Cal Poly with 5.0 innings of five-hit and five-strikeout ball in the 8-6 win.

BYU SOFTBALL TO JOIN THE WAC

PROVO, Utah (Jan. 27, 2011) — Brigham Young University and the Western Athletic Conference today announced that BYU will join the WAC for softball beginning with the 2011-12 athletic season.

On Sept. 1, 2010, BYU announced its football program would go independent and the Cougars would join the West Coast Conference in the majority of its other sports. Because the WCC does not sponsor softball, the BYU athletic administration has been actively exploring other options for conference affiliation.

“As a softball program, we are excited to compete in the WAC,” said BYU head softball coach Gordon Eakin. “It has been a nationally competitive league, and we are looking forward to contributing to the success of the conference.”

The Cougars are coming off the most successful season in school history and are ranked No. 16 heading into 2011. BYU claimed its second-straight conference title in 2010, finishing the season ranked No. 15 with a 46-13 record—the most wins in program history.

“Our softball program has been very successful under the direction of Coach Eakin,” said BYU director of athletics Tom Holmoe. “Last spring the team advanced to the NCAA Super Regionals for the first time in school history, and we are excited about the future of the program. Commissioner Karl Benson and his staff have been very accommodating and we look forward to having our softball program compete in the WAC.”

Beginning with the 2012 softball season, BYU will compete in the WAC against seven other schools including Fresno State, Hawai’i, Louisiana Tech, Nevada, Mexico State, San Jose State and Utah State.

“The WAC looks forward to working with BYU and its softball program and expects this partnership to be a ‘win-win’ for all involved, especially all of our student-athletes,” Benson said.

BYU was a founding member of the WAC in July 1962. The Cougars competed in the conference for 37 years before joining the Mountain West Conference in July 1999. Currently, the WAC crowns team and individual champions in 19 sports—eight men’s and 11 women’s.

FITU ON PLAYER OF THE YEAR WATCH LIST

OKLAHOMA CITY (Feb. 7, 2011) - BYU senior catcher Jessica Fitu was named to the Amateur Softball Association (ASA) of America's initial "Watch List" for the 10th Annual USA Softball National Collegiate Player of the Year Award.

Fitu, a native of Walnut, Calif., was an All-American selection in 2009 and is a two-time All-MWC and All-Region honoree. Last season, Fitu was second in the Mountain West Conference in triples and third in RBI as the Cougars won the MWC title and advanced to the NCAA Super Regional.

The 2011 Pre-Season Watch List is comprised of 50 players representing 36 schools and 15 different NCAA Division I Conferences with the Pac-10 Conference leading the way with seven schools represented. The list includes 23 seniors, 12 juniors and 15 sophomores.

This award, which is considered the most prestigious honor in Division I women's collegiate softball, is designed to recognize outstanding athletic achievement by female collegiate softball players across the country. Past winners of this award include UCLA's Stacey Nuve-man, Florida State's Jessica Van der Linden, three-time winner Texas pitcher Cat Osterman, Tennessee's Monica Abbott, Virginia Tech's Angela Tincher and two-time winner Washington's Danielle Lawrie.

The ASA will announce the 25 finalists on April 13. A player does not have to appear on this initial watch list to be considered as a top 25 finalist. However, once the top 25 finalists are named the winner of the award will come from that list.

FITU SHINES ON USA FUTURES TEAM

OKLAHOMA CITY, Okla. (July 26, 2010) - Named as the final selection to the USA Softball Women's Futures National Team less than a month ago, BYU catcher Jessica Purcell-Fitu earned a starting role and provided the key hit in a win over Canada at the 2010 KFC World Cup of Softball last weekend.

After sitting out the Futures' first game, a 3-2 loss to the Japanese National Team the day before, Purcell-Fitu made her USA debut on Friday, July 23, as the starting catcher against the Canadian National Team.

With the Futures down 4-2 going into the bottom of the sixth inning, the BYU All-American hit a game-tying, two-RBI single to center field off a 2-1 pitch by the reigning USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year Danielle Lawrie. Purcell-Fitu advanced to second on the throw.

The BYU senior-to-be's hit also led to the game-winning run after Niki Williams came in as a pinch runner for Purcell-Fitu and scored one batter later.

"She did a terrific job behind the plate," said Futures head coach Kate Drohan of Fitu according to a USA Softball press release. "She only had three days to get to know our pitchers, learn our game plan and get comfortable. Then for her to come up with a huge at bat, battle it out and get a huge hit with two strikes; that's a big time play for us."

Purcell-Fitu also excelled on the defensive end, stopping a potential run with a play at the plate in the fourth inning.

Purcell-Fitu and the USA Futures played two games on Saturday, July 24. Starting again at catcher, Purcell-Fitu went 0-for-2 with four putouts and one assist in a 1-0 loss to the world champion USA National Team. It was a rare chance for Purcell-Fitu to be in the opposing dugout to her usual coach, BYU head coach Gordon Eakin, an assistant on the National Team.

Later in the day the Futures lost again, this time a 5-4 loss to Canada with Purcell-Fitu sitting out. She made her final appearance on July 25, going 0-for-3 with two putouts in a 2-1 win over Japan.

EAKIN, ALVEY NAMED TO USA COACHES POOL

PROVO, Utah (Feb. 1, 2011) - BYU head coach Gordon Eakin and associate head coach Vaughn Alvey were both selected to the USA Softball Women's National Team Coaching pool.

Eakin and Alvey are two of 24 coaches who may be selected as assistant coaches for the Women's and Junior Women's National team events this summer. BYU is the only school to have two coaches in the pool.

"We are thrilled to have a great cross section of coaches for the Women's National team program for the next two years," said ASA and USA Softball Executive Director Ron Radigonda. "With the ISF change of World Championships every two years, we are excited to assist coaches in gaining international experience and opportunities."

The placement is a stamp of approval for Eakin, who was the USA National Team hitting coach last summer. In 2010, Eakin helped the USA win tournaments around the world, including the World Championship in Venezuela and the World Cup in Oklahoma.

A two-time Mountain West Coach of the Year, Eakin has led the Cougar softball program since 2003, compiling a 331-142 (.700) record and the highest winning percentage in MWC history.

Alvey, BYU's top assistant and pitching coach for the last eight seasons, was selected to the coaching pool for the first time. At BYU, Alvey has coached Paige Affleck and Christie Zinanti, two of the most accomplished pitchers in BYU history, helping the Cougars win four conference championships in the last six years.

Alvey is a member of the Utah Sports Hall of Fame and coached at Alta High in Utah for 17 seasons, leading the Hawks to eight state titles. He also coaches girls summer programs, winning the AFA National Championship in 1992.



BYU HEAD COACH GORDON EAKIN

BYU head coach Gordon Eakin is entering his 10th season as the Cougars' head coach and his 12th season at BYU overall.

Eakin was named head coach in July 2002 after working as an assistant coach since the softball program's inception in 2000. Since that time he has led the Cougars to four Mountain West Conference championships and six NCAA tournament appearances.

The MWC Coach of the Year in 2010 and 2009, Eakin has coached eight All-Americans, seven MWC Players of the Year and three MWC Freshmen of the Year during his tenure.

In 2010, Eakin guided the Cougars to 46 wins, the most in school history, as BYU advanced to the NCAA Super Regionals for the first time ever with wins over East Carolina and host Texas before ending its season at national runner-up Arizona.

Known as one of the best hitting coaches in the country, Eakin helped the Cougars finish second in the country in batting average, seventh in scoring and ninth in slugging percentage as a team last season. Overall BYU has finished in the top-ten nationally in slugging percentage six times, home runs per game six times, batting average four times and scoring four times.

In addition to his duties at BYU, Eakin has also been an assistant coach and the hitting coach for the USA National Team since 2009. In the summer of 2010, Eakin helped guide the National Team to a 17-2 record as USA won the World Championship in Venezuela, the World Cup in Oklahoma and the Japan Cup championship in Sendai, Japan.

Before entering the coaching ranks, Eakin was a successful baseball and softball player. After playing collegiate baseball at the University of Utah, Eakin signed with the Oakland Athletics organization where he played for three years.

Eakin went on to join the United States All-Star team, playing in three U.S. Olympic sports festivals in 1986, 1993 and 1994, winning bronze, silver and gold, respectively. While on the team, Eakin was honored on the ISC All-World First Team and was an ASA All-American.

He would later go on to play shortstop on the internationally ranked Larry H. Miller Toyota Fast Pitch team, eventually earning induction into the Utah Fast Pitch Hall of Fame in 1998.

Eakin grew up in Holladay, Utah, and graduated from Granite High. He currently resides in Sandy, Utah, and is married to Barbi. They are the parents of three children (Alicia, Ryan & Parker) and have four grandsons.

BYU PICKED FIRST IN MWC PRESEASON POLL

PROVO, Utah (Feb. 3, 2011) - A voting panel of the six Mountain West Conference head softball coaches chose defending league champion BYU as the favorite to win the 2011 MWC regular-season title.

The Cougars collected four first-place votes and 24 total points. San Diego State was a close second with 22 points and two first-place votes, while UNLV was picked third, totaling 15 points. Colorado State received 13 points for fourth place in the poll, while Utah (11 points) and New Mexico (five points) claimed fifth and sixth place, respectively, to round out the preseason rankings.

In 2010, BYU (46-13 overall, 12-3 MWC) registered its sixth consecutive 40-win season on the way to its fifth MWC regular-season title and sixth straight NCAA Tournament appearance. The Cougars became the first MWC team to advance to an NCAA Super Regional. BYU head coach Gordon Eakin returns 11 letterwinners from last year's MWC championship squad, including seven starters. Among the returning starters are 2010 all-MWC honorees Paige Affleck (three-year starting pitcher), Jessica Purcell-Fitu (catcher) and Kristin Delahoussaye (second base).

The 2011 MWC softball season is set to begin on Thursday, Feb. 10, as BYU takes on Oregon and Texas Tech, and Utah faces Mississippi at the Kajikawa Classic in Tempe, Ariz. Conference play opens Friday, Apr. 8, with three games on the docket.

BYU MARKS HISTORIC SEASON IN 2010

The 2010 softball season for BYU was arguably the best in program history as the Cougars set new team and individual marks all across the board, highlighted by a first-ever trip to the NCAA Super Regional, a school-best 46-13 record, and a final No. 15 ranking, the highest ever for the Cougars.

After claiming their sixth Mountain West Conference title since the program began in 2000, the Cougars traveled to Austin, Tex., to compete in an NCAA Regional for the sixth time. BYU would sweep the Regional, defeating East Carolina before knocking off the host, No. 7-seeded Texas, and beating East Carolina again to move on to the Super Regional.

BYU faced powerhouse Arizona in Tucson Super Regional, falling 2-1 in the first of a three-game series before losing again the next day to finish the season.

"It was a journey we knew we had potential to finish the way we finished," said BYU head coach Gordon Eakin, "but we had a lot of challengers where it made the season more sweet. Peaking at the right time and playing the way we knew we were capable was a nice capstone."

BYU was led by Mountain West Conference Player of the Year Angeline Quiocho. In her senior season, Quiocho tallied numbers never before seen in BYU and MWC history. Quiocho led the NCAA averaging 0.47 home runs per game, 1.53 RBI per game, and 90 RBI. She also finished second in the nation with 1.29 runs per game and was third in country with 28 home runs, 173 total bases and a .956 slugging percentage.

Quiocho led the MWC in home runs, runs, walks, RBI, total bases, slugging percentage and on-base percentage while trailing only freshman teammate J.C. Clayton in hits and batting average. The senior leader finished atop the BYU and MWC records in numerous game, season and career records.

But Quiocho was not alone in BYU's success. The Cougars led the MWC with six All-Conference selections. Quiocho, Clayton, junior pitcher Paige Affleck, junior second baseman Kristin Delahoussaye, junior catcher Jessica Purcell-Fitu and senior first baseman Andrea Ramirez were all named to the team while Clayton also picked up MWC Freshman of the Year. Head coach Gordon Eakin won his second-straight MWC Coach of the Year award after leading BYU to a school-record 46-13 mark and a 12-3 conference record.

In addition, Ramirez, Delahoussaye and Quiocho were named to the NFCA/Louisville Slugger Pacific All-Region First Team while Affleck and Purcell-Fitu were placed on the second team.

BYU ran off a seven-game win streak, including a walk-off grand slam by sophomore Delaney Willard against San Jose State, to begin the season before facing a preseason schedule full of top-ranked teams, including nine teams that would advance to the NCAA tournament. At No. 19 Texas A&M's tournament in early March, BYU beat the host team twice in two days.

After 31 games on the road, BYU hosted its first home game with a 12-2 win over Southern Utah. In a 12-1 win over Idaho State, Ramirez and Caschjen Davis-Atagi hit two home runs apiece. Just a few days later, Davis-Atagi hit another walk-off grand slam for the Cougars, this one defeating UNLV, 7-3.

Quiocho hit the first of her BYU record-tying three grand slams in a season in an 11-5 win over Idaho State, a game in which she also hit a solo homer. The senior later hit her second career three-homer game late in the season against UNLV, the first of which gave Quiocho the BYU season home run record.

Other highlights included senior Amanda Vance-Kellum hitting a grand slam to end a contest against Colorado State through the mercy rule, 12-4, and a 20-0 win over Utah Valley, the most runs BYU has scored in a game since April 2008.

In a close race for the MWC championship late in the season, junior pitcher Paige Affleck bested SDSU ace Samantha Beasley, leading the Cougars to a 2-1 victory and earning her 27th win of the season, a new BYU record.

On Senior Day against New Mexico, Christie Zinanti pitched a complete game, striking out seven while giving up just one hit for her final home win. Seniors honored after the game included Zinanti, Quiocho, Ramirez, Vance-Kellum, catcher Amy Holt and utility player Whitney Nix-Thomas.

BYU AIMING TO BUILD ON LAST YEAR'S SUCCESS

After the most successful season in the history of the program in 2010, BYU softball will aim to build on its growing reputation as one of the best programs in the country in 2011.

BYU made its first-ever NCAA Super Regional appearance last year after sweeping three-straight games at Austin, Texas, in the Regional, including two wins against East Carolina and a victory over No. 7-seed Texas. The Cougars ended the season at Arizona in the Super Regional, the eventual national runner-up, but not before earning the most wins in school history with a 46-13 record and achieving their highest ranking ever, finishing 15th in the country.

The Cougars also claimed their second-straight Mountain West Conference title with a 12-3 conference record, the fourth championship in the last six years for BYU.

BYU lost MWC Player of the Year Angeline Quiocho, who smashed multiple BYU records and finished in the top 10 nationally in half a dozen categories. Combining her numbers with fellow graduate Andrea Ramirez, the Cougars lose a combined 47 home runs and 41-percent of their RBI production from last season.

But BYU head coach Gordon Eakin isn't concerned about the lost production or a dip in rising national prominence thanks to a deep, multi-talented squad in 2011.

"The home runs certainly won't be to the point they were last year," Eakin said. "Any time you lose 50 home runs in two players, which is essentially what we did, that's going to dent your lineup. But I wouldn't think we'll be too far off of last year's total. We'll score with the long ball, we'll score with the short game and we'll score with speed."

BYU returns 11 letterwinners from last year's squad, including seven starters. The Cougar seniors, including three-year starting pitcher Paige Affleck, catcher Jessica Fitu, second baseman Kristin Delahoussaye and power hitter Caschjen Atagi will look to cap off their careers at BYU with another conference championship and deep run into the postseason.

Known for her expertise on and off the field, Affleck enters her final season already as BYU's career leader in wins, strikeouts and innings pitched—passing former teammate Christie Zinanti who graduated last season. An All-Region, All-MWC and Academic All-District pick last year after winning a school-record 32 games, Affleck is an All-American and Academic All-American candidate who will carry the majority of the load in the circle for BYU while also finishing up her master's thesis in just her fourth year of school.

With the loss of Zinanti, BYU brings in freshman Tori Almond, a two-time Utah Gatorade Player of the Year who will play a significant role, while sophomore Hannah Howell also returns after seeing considerable time in 2010.

Reprising her role as the best catcher in the league last season, Fitu returns for BYU after batting .374 with 65 hits in addition to a stint during the summer on the USA Futures National Team. This year, the senior hopes to get back to her sophomore-year form when she was named an All-American after racking up 17 home runs and 16 doubles.

"With her summertime experience with the Futures team, I expect Jessica to have a banner year," Eakin said. "She's motivated, she's gained more confidence and more experience, and I think she'll have a very good year."

Other catchers on the team include Delahoussaye, who will spell Fitu mainly on five-game weekends, and senior April Thorson, a transfer from BYU-Hawaii.

At first base, freshman Katie Manuma and junior Stacie Graham will battle for the starting spot following Ramirez's graduation. Manuma, the Hawaii Gatorade Player of the Year, is a great defensive stop who will take up some of the power BYU lost. Graham is an NJCAA All-American transfer from Salt Lake Community College and one of the best all-around athletes on the team who can play multiple positions in the infield.

A stalwart at second base, Delahoussaye returns as the emotional leader for the Cougars. A clutch hitter with an outstanding glove, BYU has high expectations for "House."

"I think House is an All-American talent," Eakin said. "A lot of the things we do defensively are around House. I think she's the best second baseman in the country. If we have a cornerstone or a focal point we work around, it's Kristin at second base."

Continuing around the bases, sophomore JC Clayton played one of the best freshman seasons in conference history after leading the conference in batting average (.430), hits (80) and on-base percentage (.476) in 2010. Starting the bulk of the season at shortstop, Clayton's production led to the newcomer earning MWC Freshman of the Year and All-MWC honors.

Clayton, freshman Madisen Robb, junior Krista Hicks and Atagi are all in the mix to gain playing time at shortstop and third base in 2011. Robb, a Vernal, Utah, native, was an All-State honoree who is already pushing for playing time. Hicks, a defensive specialist, returns, while Atagi may see time at the corner or in her usual spot at left field.

Junior Tiffany Messerschmidt looks to be a regular in the lineup again after nagging injuries limited her last season. In 2008, Messerschmidt batted .357 with 55 hits.

"Tiffany is going to be an offensive force this year," Eakin said. "Her speed and what she does in the short game is irreplaceable. I think she's going to have a breakout year for us."

Sophomore Alexandra Hudson, who batted .319 last season, and junior Jessica Dugas, a mid-year insert into the starting lineup who led the MWC with a perfect fielding percentage in center field, will also vie for playing time in the outfield.

Junior Delaney Willard will start for the Cougars in right field. Willard is one of the best pure hitters on the team and has stepped up as one of BYU's upperclassmen.

"She's shown signs this year already that she's improved her leadership skills and her confidence levels," Eakin said. "I expect Delaney to have a great year."

Freshmen outfielder Carly Duckworth, infielder Jenna Engel and outfielder Lacey Millett each join BYU right out of high school and will look for playing time while junior outfielder Bailie Hicken, a transfer from Dixie State, will redshirt in 2011.
