Season Finale Friday For BYU Gymnasts

The BYU women's gymnastics team will take the floor for the last time in the 2009 regular season this Friday at 7 p.m. The Cougars will wrap up the year in style hosting No. 2 Utah at the Marriott Center in a meet televised live by BYUTV.

"The Utah meet is always a fun meet," said BYU head coach Brad Cattermole. "Our team is looking forward to competing on Friday. It's been a challenging year with all the injuries with such a young team, but it's been a good year in that a lot of our gymnasts have gained valuable experience and we've grown together as a team."

BYU has indeed had more than its share of injury issues as six Cougars suffered season-ending injuries or illness, including the team's two co-captains. But several other gymnasts have stepped up to the plate, including several freshmen. Newcomer Jennifer Lezeu stood out last week at Utah State with two career highs. Lezeu posted her first personal best on the vault at 9.700. She followed that up with a 9.875 on the balance beam, helping BYU post its top score of the year on that event at 48.800. Lezeu also came just .025 short of tying her career high on the floor (9.725).

A stellar team performance on the balance beam last week helped BYU to a score of 191.975 last Friday at Utah State in another solid outing for the Cougars. However, the Aggies posted an overall tally of 193.825 to top BYU in the Cougars' final road meet of the year. Three BYU gymnasts tallied career highs led by junior beam specialist Kaylee Gallup. Gallup used the four-inch apparatus to full advantage with a tremendous score of 9.925, the highest mark posted by any Cougar on any event this year.

The Cougars will have their work cut out for them against in-state rival and second-ranked Utah. The Utes have been strong all year, spending every week but one in the top two and enjoying three weeks as the nation's No. 1 team. The Utes are No. 1 on floor, No. 2 on vault, No. 3 on bars and No. 4 on beam. Kristina Baskett checks in at No. 2 in the all-around, No. 2 on bars, No. 4 on vault and No. 13 on floor. Nina Kim is No. 12 in the all-around and No. 4 on beam; Annie DiLuzio is tied for No. 9 on vault and No. 20 on floor; Jamie Deetscreek is No. 20 in the all-around.

COUGAR NOTES**Last Meet In Review**

A stellar team performance on the balance beam helped the BYU women's gymnastics team to a score of 191.975 on Friday at Utah State in another solid outing for the Cougars. However, the Aggies posted an overall tally of 193.825 to top BYU. The Cougars saved the best for last in the competition as they put up their best score of the season on the event at 48.800. Three BYU gymnasts tallied career highs led by junior beam specialist Kaylee Gallup with a tremendous score of 9.925, the highest mark posted by any Cougar on any event this year.

BYU Performer of the Week - Jennifer Lezeu

Cougar freshman Jennifer Lezeu helped spark BYU at Utah State with two career highs. Lezeu posted her first personal best on the vault at 9.700. She followed that up with a 9.875 on the balance beam, the second-best score recorded by any Cougar this season. The mark helped BYU post its top score of the year on that event at 48.800. Lezeu also came just .025 short of tying her career high on the floor (9.725).

Youth Reigns Supreme

BYU's 2009 roster features no seniors and 11 freshmen, more than the number of sophomores and juniors combined. "I think this is our youngest, most inexperienced team ever, but this is one of those teams that it's just fun to work with," said BYU head coach Brad Cattermole. "They're good gymnasts; they just need to get a little healthier and get a little experience." Six freshmen have competed this season for the Cougars.

Injury Issues

The Cougars have suffered crushing blows this season in the injury department. BYU lost junior co-captain McKell Poulson-Merkley in the middle of January to a torn ACL. Then the injury bug struck again as freshmen Holland Davis and Natalie Eyre both went down with knee injuries. BYU lost junior co-captain Megan Donehue to an ankle injury, and freshman Krysten Koval had to have an emergency appendectomy three weeks ago. Freshman Kylie Gallacher is the most recent Cougar casualty with a knee injury. All six gymnasts are out for the year.

Brad Cattermole begins his 21st full season as the head coach of BYU gymnastics. Cattermole has quietly built the Cougar program into a respected national power.

Since becoming the head coach, he has guided the Cougars to eight National Championship Tournament appearances and 18 NCAA Regionals berths, missing Regionals just once since becoming coach.

After taking over the program midway through the 1988 season, he promptly led the Cougars to the first 185 in school history. In 1998, the Cougars broke the 196 barrier for the first time, hitting a 196.325 against Utah in the final meet of the season in Provo. In 2000, once again in Provo, Cattermole's squad broke 196 for the second time with a 196.05 to 195.975 victory over national-power Utah. In 2001, the Cougars surpassed the 196 mark five times. On March 16th of the same year, BYU reached the 197 mark for the first time in school history with a 197.325 mark against Utah State. Then one week later the Cougars broke that record again with a 197.375 at Utah, a full 1.450 points higher than their previous high road score. In this record-setting season, the Cougars set new team highs in every event and in the all-around. In 2004, Cattermole's squad raised the standard even higher, scoring a school-record 198.025 at Utah State. During that same year, the team also set school highs of 49.625 on vault, 49.675 on beam and 49.675 on floor.

Before conference meets were eliminated in 1994, Cattermole's teams were league runner-ups five times, and seven athletes earned 10 all-conference honors. Seven gymnasts have earned 17 NCAA All-America awards under his tutelage.

His recruiting efforts have netted five U.S. National Team members, six Canadian National Team members and numerous Junior Olympic National and Elite champions.

Cattermole has coached four gymnasts to perfect 10.0 scores during his time at BYU. In 2002 Christy McAdams recorded the first perfect 10.0 score in school history. In 2003, Kari Dye-Lords scored a perfect 10.0 on balance beam, and Brogan Jacobsen recorded a 10.0 with a scintillating floor routine against Southern Utah, Utah State and Central Michigan. In 2004, Jaime Mabray added the fourth perfect 10.0 and second perfect vault in school history against Texas Woman's University and Air Force.

Along with his duties at BYU, Cattermole and his wife Dawn own and operate All-American Gymnastics in Lindon, Utah. Highly successful since its establishment in 1976, All-American has earned more State Class I and Class II championships than any other club in Utah. Several athletes – former Cougar stars Marianne Williams Squires, Kelli Rose-Rhyssman, Korie Jackman, Cristen Cos-



grave-Barlow, Angela Gunnell Anderson and Jessica Nelson-Taylor – earned national club honors while competing for All-American Gymnastics under Cattermole's tutelage.

Born in Stormlake, Iowa, Cattermole grew up in Los Angeles. He competed on the 1971 BYU men's gymnastics team. Following his freshman year, he left school to serve a mission for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints to Peru. His competitive career ended when he broke his hand in practice shortly after returning from his mission. He was a part-time assistant women's gymnastics coach at BYU and part-time coach at Provo Gymnastics during the 1975-76 season while he continued his

schooling at BYU.

He is married to Dawn Cattermole. They have three sons and one granddaughter.
