Previous Game Recap

"Team" was the secret weapon for BYU women's basketball in their win over UNLV 74-48.

BYU now improves to 13-7 overall and 4-3 on the season. The Cougars are now tied for third place in the Conference.

Junior forward Ambrosia Anderson, senior center Danielle Cheesman, and sophomore center Dani Kubik each scored in double figures. This is the 10th straight game that three Cougars have scored in double figures. Eleven players scored points for BYU as they drilled a season high 60 percent of their shots from the field. In an unselfish effort, the Cougars also recorded a season high 25 assists.

Kubik came off the bench strong for the Cougars tying with Cheesman for a game high 14 points and recording another game high seven rebounds.

Cougar sophomore guard Melinda Johnsen was 100 percent shooting from the field.

UNLV jumped out in front at the beginning of the game led by forward RanDee Henry, who scored five of the first seven UNLV points.

With 17 minutes to play in the first half the Cougars kicked into high gear and went on a 19-1 run over seven minutes to take a lead they wouldn't give up for the rest of the game.

About the Cougars

- ◆ The Cougars current record: 13-7, 4-3
- ◆ The team's leading scorer is senior point guard Julie Sullivan, who tallies 11.0 points.
- ◆ Senior forward Danielle Cheesman tops the list in the rebound category with 8.7 per game.
- ◆ Cheesman notched her fifth double double of the season with 12 points and 10 rebounds in the Utah game on 01/29/05. It was her 12th overall.
- ◆ Cheesman joined BYU's elite 1,000 point club when she hit a three-point bucket just minutes into the Weber State game on 12/30/04. She becomes the 14th student-athlete who has reached that similar milestone during their BYU college career.
- ◆ Senior point guard Julie Sullivan is one of the team's best free throw shooter, with a percentage of .797, (55-69).
- ◆ Anderson picked up her first double double of the 2004-05 campaign with the 20 points and 12 rebounds against SEMO on 12/10/04.
- ◆ Freshman Mallary Gillespie put in seven three pointers in the game vs. Nevada on 11/24/04, that's two shy of BYU's all-time record holder in three pointers, Erin Thorn. Thorn tallied nine treys vs. Arkansas Pine-Bluff at a tournament in Denver on 12/14/01.

About Colorado State University

CSU has a 13-7, 4-3 record and is tied with BYU with the same record for second place in the current MWC standings. The Rams have not lost a league game at home going 3-0 with victories over SDSU, UNLV and Wyoming. Three CSU players scored in double digits led by a team high 14.9 points from junior forward Melissa Dennett. Lindsay Thomas follows with 12.9 points and a team high 8.3 rebounds a game. Junior guard Vanessa Espinoza rounds out the double figure scoring with an average of 11.7 points and 3.0 boards a game. As a team, CSU shoots 43 percent from the field, 70 percent at the free throw line and 32 percent from behind the arc. After 20 games played, the Rams are averaging 66.7 points and hold opponents to 59.5 points per game.

Series Record: 38-22 in favor of the Cougars

Last Meeting: BYU and CSU met once already this season, in Provo where the Cougars picked up the home win with a score of 74-54. The Cougars are 11-14 when playing at Moby Arena. The last time BYU picked up a win at the Arena was during the 1994 season when both teams were part of the WAC. Both teams played to a second overtime period with the Cougars finally getting the win, 79-78. In five of the last seven losses in Fort Collins, BYU has lost each game by six or less points.

About University of Wyoming

As the first half of MWC play ends, the Cowgirls have a 12-8, 3-4 record. They host Utah on Thursday night before playing BYU on Saturday afternoon. At home, Wyoming has a 7-1 overall record and is 2-0 in conference play. Topping the list in scoring for the team is senior Ashley Elliott who contributes with 16.9 points and 3.9 rebounds per game. Freshman forward Hanna Zavec follows with 15.0 points and 5.7 boards per game. Erin Hicks, a junior guard rounds out the double figure scoring with 10.2 points. Hicks also leads the team in the rebound category, grabbing 7.3 boards a game. Wyoming is shooting 37 percent from the field and 75 percent at the free throw line. When shooting from three-point range, the Cowgirls shoot 32 percent. The team averages 59.9 points per game and allows opponents 55.0 points a contest.

Last Meeting: In the first meeting between the Cougars and Cowgirls, Wyoming got the win in Provo by the score of 74-63. It was the opening game of this year's MWC race. At Arena Auditorium, BYU has a 16-10 record, although the Cougars have lost the previous two times in Laramie.



Head Coach - Jeff Judkins

Overall Record: 71-42, begins his fourth season at BYU.

Under Coach Judkins, the team has gone to back-to-back NCAA appearances as well as to the title games of the MWC Championships, winning the title game in 2001-02.

An all-state selection in basketball, football and baseball, Judkins played basketball for the University of Utah from 1974-78. While playing for the Utes, he helped the team win one conference championship and two berths in the NCAA Tournament.

He was a second-team academic All-American and three-time first-team District VII academic selection. Judkins earned three first-team All-WAC honors and was a member of the 1977 United States World Games team that captured the gold medal.

He played five years in the NBA for the Boston Celtics, Portland Trailblazers, Detroit Pistons and the Utah Jazz. He was a second-round pick by the Celtics in 1978, the same year the Celtics selected Larry Bird with the sixth pick overall.

After his NBA career, he returned to the U of U in 1989, and remained with the men's program for 10 years. Judkins, a Salt Lake City native, graduated from Utah in 1978 with a degree in health and physical education. He is a member of the Utah Sports Hall of Fame and the Crimson Club Hall of Fame.

He and his wife Mary Kay, are the parents of five children: Jessica (24), Jordan (22), Jenna (20), Jaime (17), Jaxson (14).
