### **Coach Vance Law**

Coach Vance Law is in his 12th season as head coach at BYU. He played 14 years of pro ball, including 11 years in the majors with six different teams. In 2001 he was named Coach of the Year in the Mountain West Conference. The 54-year-old coach entered this season with a 344-294-2 (.539) record. He is assisted by Ryan Roberts, in his ninth year at BYU. Pitching coach Bobby Applegate is in his eighth year with BYU, having last coached at the Air Force Academy.

### **Hitting Streaks**

Andrew Law leads the team with a current eight-game hitting streak. Dane Nielsen and Jaycob Brugman each have current seven and fourgame hitting streaks, respectively.

### **Good GPAs**

Last winter semester (2010) pitcher David Parry recorded a 4.0 grade point average. The accounting major made the Dean's List. Dane Nielsen was nominated to the CoSida Academic All-America ballot.

### **Home Season**

BYU drew 17,952 fans in it's 19-game home schedule this season for a 12-7 record. The Cougars have a 134-74 (.644) record at Larry H. Miller Field which seats 2,204 fans in its 10th season since it was built. In the previous nine years BYU drew 218,981 fans for an average of 1,177 and 142,248 at night for an average of 1,452. The crowd of 3,081 against Utah last season was the fourth-largest in school history and the second-largest at Miller Park. The largest crowd at home during 2010 was 1,826 in the finale vs. Utah and the crowd of 3,744 fans at Utah Valley was the largest on the road.

### **Taking Series**

In 2010 BYU won series against UC Davis, Washington, UNLV, San Jose State, No. 20 Kansas State, Utah, San Diego State and Air Force. Thus far BYU has won vs. Northern Illinois, Washington and Portland in 2011.

### **NCAA Statistics**

In the first NCAA stax released earlier this week, BYU is 26th in triples, Stephen Wells is 8th in doubles, Jaycob Brugman is 24th in triples, Ryan Bernal is 29th in slugging percentage, and Andrew Law is 24th in sacrifice bunts.

### **Baseball-Softball Doubleheaders in Provo**

BYU's baseball (Larry H. Miller Field)-softball (Gail Miller Field) complex known as Miller Park was host to eight "doubleheaders" this season. On March 24 baseball hosts San Diego State at 6 p.m., while softball hosts Weber St. at 4 p.m. On April 19, softball hosts Utah Valley while baseball hosts Utah at TV--both games are at 6 p.m. On April 21, softball hosts New Mexico, while baseball also hosts New Mexico--both games are at 6 p.m.; on April 22 & 23, softball hosts TV games with CSU at 6 and 2 p.m., while baseball again hosts New Mexico at 6 and 1 p.m.; on April 28-30, softball hosts SDSU at 6 p.m., then UNLV at 6 and 2 p.m., while baseball hosts TCU in three TV games at 6, 6 and 1 p.m.

### **Regarding BYU This Season**

- BYU has 10 players who are married (Ryan Bernal, Chase Frampton, Wes Guenther, Austin Hall, Alex Hancock, Matt Neil, Dane Nielsen, Blake Torgerson, Stephen Wells and Alex Wolfe).
- Incorporated into this year's team are five players who have just finished serving two-year Church missions (Taylor Cole, Bret Lopez, Michael Peterson, Daniel Sechrest and Daniel Welch).
- Six players transferred to BYU (Taylor Cole is the newest transfer to BYU, joining from previous seasons Ryan Bernal, Alex Hancock, David McKnight, Jared Miller and Alex Wolfe).
- Among those who could throw batting practice to BYU again this season is former Cy Young winner Vernon Law (1960 Pittsburgh Pirates), father of BYU head coach Vance Law. Vernon turned 80-years-old on March 12 of 2010, had seven-by-pass heart surgery six years ago and recently had his second knee replacement surgery.

### Wolfe two-time MWC Player of Week & CollegeBaseballinsider.com Regional Player of Week

Alex Wolfe homered the first four home games last April, with multiple RBI in each of those games. He had the game-winning RBI with a two-run double in BYU's 16-4 romp over Washington--in that game he doubled and hit a two-run homer for four RBI in that 13-run second inning. In game one vs. Washington as a first baseman, he had a diving rollover assist on the first batter in the fifth inning to complete the putout to the pitcher. He was on the end of five double plays in game two vs. Washington. He had a slugging average of 1.556 for the three-game series.

Against Utah he accounted for both of BYU's game-winning RBI with a walk-off homer in the finale. That opposite field two-run homer with two out in the ninth gave BYU a 6-4 win on a 1-1 count. In that game he played at third base and stopped Utah's rally in the eighth when he cut off a throw from left field to catch a Utah runner between bases for a 7-5-6 putout to end that inning with another runner on base after the Utes had scored their fourth run. In game one vs. Utah he played at first base and had a two-run double down the right field line with two outs and a 2-2 count, not counting fouling off two pitches to give BYU an 8-7 lead. He scored BYU's ninth run in that eighth inning. In that 9-7 game he was on base in each of his five trips to the plate, including being hit by a pitch. Both game-winning RBI came off pitches from Utah reliever Zach Adams, whom he coached the previous summer. Wolfe had a slugging percentage of .909 for the week and an on-base percentage of .643. He raised his batting average from .321 to .338.

This is BYU's final year in the MWC since it will join the West Coast Conference next season. Here are a couple of interesting baseball facts on the WCC (BYU has a 46-52-1 record against that league). Pepperdine won the College World Series in 1992. Of the eight current WCC teams, only St. Mary's has not participated in the NCAA post-season tournament. BYU's 1-1 tie against Pepperdine came in the second game of a doubleheader in 1963. BYU's win-loss baseball records and last action against the current WCC teams is: 11-12 vs. Gonzaga, 2010, split 2 games 7-14-1 vs. Pepperdine, 2004, BYU W 5-0 9-8 vs. Portland, 2011, BYU won 7-6 7-3 vs. San Diego, 1997, USD won 11-2 6-1 vs. St. Mary's, 2006, BYU won 10-5 3-6 vs. San Francisco, 2010, USF won 20-4 2-5 vs. Santa Clara, 2004, split 2 games 1-3 vs. Loyola Marymount, 1972, LMU won 13-7
