Two Road Meets Await No. 23 Cougars

PROVO, Utah (Jan. 17, 2007) – Two road meets await the No. 23-ranked BYU women's gymnastics team in the coming week. The Cougars will be in Boise, Idaho, to tangle with Boise State Friday and will head to Logan to face in-state rival Utah State Monday night.

BYU has a season average of 193.675 through two meets this year. Dayna Smart has led the team on vault, beam and floor to help the Cougars to their No. 23 ranking in the latest gymnastics polls released by Troester Consulting Monday morning.

"The girls are trying really hard to improve," BYU coach Brad Cattermole said. "They are working very hard and giving it their best shot."

Last week in its home opener, BYU scored a 193.325 against Texas Woman's. Several gymnasts recorded strong outings against the Pioneers. Juniors Smart and Kylee Draper recorded career highs on floor at 9.850 and 9.800, respectively. Draper also tied with teammate Kacie Capra-Callens for team-high honors on bars at 9.825. Freshman Jenna Kerbis notched a career-best 9.800 on beam to tie with Smart for the team's highest mark on the event.

The Broncos are coming off their first meet of the season last Friday. BSU recorded a 187.250 at the Flips Invitational in Reno, Nev. Freshman DeAvera Todd led the team on vault and in the all-around. The Broncos are led by senior Lindsay Ward and sophomore Taylor Jacob.

USU is coming into its third meet of the season. Last week the Aggies scored a 191.400 against Washington. Megan Tschida had the team's best score on any of the four events with a 9.800 on floor. USU is led by senior Jessica Parenti-Otte in the all-around.

Friday's meet with BSU is scheduled to start at 7 p.m. in the Taco Bell Arena, while Monday's meet will begin at 6:30 p.m. in the Dee Glen Smith Spectrum. Live stats will not be available for either meet.

Cougar Notes

Cracking the Polls

After being among teams receiving votes in the Preseason Coaches Poll, the Cougars are ranked No. 23 in the first poll of the season released Monday morning. Unlike other sports, gymnastics rankings are based on a team's scores.

Season Record

With a third-place finish in Cancun and a win against Texas Woman's in its last meet, BYU now has a 2-2 record on the season.

Team Canada in Provo

Danielle Goldman, Melissa Hough and Jenna Kerbis have all represented their native Canada in international meets before coming to BYU. Kerbis is the most recent, having helped lead the Canadian National Team to a bronze medal at the 2006 Commonwealth Games in Melbourne, Australia. Goldman competed for Canada at the 2005 Maccabbi Games in Israel, finishing third in the all-around and helping team Canada to a Silver Medal. Hough was a member of Canadian National Team as a novice and junior and finished second in the all-around at an international meet in Belgium in 2005.

Trading Uniforms

Redshirt-freshman Megan Perner came to BYU in 2005 on a track and field scholarship. However, her first love in sports as a child was gymnastics. After a series of tryouts and rigorous summer training, she walked on to the team. This season will be the first time in seven years she has competed in gymnastics.

She Can't Hear You

Junior Aimee Walker Pond is blind in her right eye and deaf in both ears. Many of the girls on the team and the coaches know at least some sign language to be able to communicate with her.

Cougars vs. Broncos

BYU will travel to Boise for its first of two meets with Boise State this season. The Cougars topped the 194.500 mark in both meets against the Broncos last year, with each team winning at home.

Cougars vs. Aggies

BYU won both meets with in-state rival Utah State last season. The Cougars have posted two of the highest beam scores in school history against the Aggies.

Vault

The Cougars have seen some struggles on vault thus far this season. Dayna Smart has led the team in its first two meets this season. Three freshmen have competed on the event to this point.

Bars

Senior Kacie Capra-Callens and junior Kylee Draper have posted the team's highest scores on the event this season at 9.825. Each recorded that mark against TWU last weekend.

Beam

After being BYU's most consistent event last year, Beam has been its strongest event thus far this season. Smart, a junior, has led the team in both meets this year. She posted a season-best 9.850 in Cancun and tied with freshman Jenna Kerbis for team-high honors against TWU.

Floor

The Cougars have had falls on floor in both meets this season. Smart tied a career-high 9.850 against TWU last weekend. Capra-Callens posted many of the team's highest marks last year, including a career- and team-best 9.875. She and Smart led the way in Cancun at 9.725.

All-Around

Noone has competed on all four events in the first two meets this year.
