Wildcats, Thunderbirds Invade Marriott Center Cougars Looking to Improve Regional Seeding

PROVO, Utah (March 20, 2007) – If back-to-back triangular meets weren't enough, the BYU gymnastics team will have one more when it plays host to No. 14 Arizona and in-state foe Southern Utah Friday in the Marriott Center.

With just two meets left, both of which are at home, BYU is looking to score high to improve its seeding when the NCAA Regional brackets are announced on April 2. The Cougars currently sit in the fifth spot in the North Central Region with the top six moving on to Regionals on April 14.

"We are getting some people back from injury," BYU coach Brad Cattermole said. "That will give us a better chance to get the scores we are looking for. We have to hit and be consistent like we are capable of. If we can get mid 195 to low 196, we'll have a chance to move up higher."

BYU holds a Regional Qualifying Score (RQS) of 194.440 and is ranked No. 26 in the latest polls released by Troester Consulting Monday morning. The Cougars are ranked No. 17 on balance beam with Dayna Smart ranked No. 13 on the event. Alethea Boon is ranked No. 25 on vault.

Last week in Denver, Boon picked up the first all-around title of her career while helping BYU to its second-highest floor score of the season at 48.925. Smart had strong routines on both vault and floor, while Hayley Jensen recorded a career best on beam. Freshmen Heidi Poulson and Danielle Goldman also recorded career highs on floor.

Arizona comes into Friday's meet riding the momentum of a season-high 196.650 in a quad meet last week. The Wildcats boast an RQS of 195.855 and are led by Karin Wurm, Brittney Morgan, Miranda Russell and Danielle Hicks.

No. 34 SUU enters the meet also coming off a season-best performance last weekend. The Thunderbirds recorded a 195.175 in a victory against Boise State and are competing with Iowa and Utah State for the last spot in the North Central Regional. SUU has an RQS of 193.775 and is led by Leah Sakhitab, Elise Wheeler, Shayla Garcia and Jess Langley.

Start time is scheduled for 7 p.m. The meet will be shown live on BYUTV, and live stats will be available on the women's gymnastics homepage at www.byucougars.com.

Season Record

Counting wins in dual meets and its finishes in multiple-team meets, BYU now has a 11-7 record on the season.

Team Canada in Provo

Danielle Goldman, Melissa Hough and Jenna Kerbis have all represented their native Canada in international meets before coming to BYU. Kerbis is the most recent, having helped lead the Canadian National Team to a bronze medal at the 2006 Commonwealth Games in Melbourne, Australia. Goldman competed for Canada at the 2005 Maccabbi Games in Israel, finishing third in the all-around and helping team Canada to a Silver Medal. Hough was a member of the Canadian National Team as a novice and junior and finished second in the all-around at an international meet in Belgium in 2005.

Trading Uniforms

Redshirt-freshman Megan Perner came to BYU in 2005 on a track and field scholarship. However, her first love in athletics as a child was gymnastics. After a series of tryouts and rigorous summer training, she walked on to the team. This season marks the first time in seven years she has competed in gymnastics.

She Can't Hear You

Junior Aimee Walker Pond is blind in her right eye and deaf in both ears. Many of the girls on the team and the coaches know at least some sign language to be able to communicate with her.

Cougars vs Arizona, Southern Utah

BYU will face Arizona its only time this season and SUU for the third time Friday night. The Cougars and Wildcats are no strangers to each other the last two years. The two competed against each other three times last season with Arizona coming out on top each time. The Thunderbirds have lost their last three meets against BYU and have not won in Provo since Feb. 18, 2005. The Cougars posted their highest score of the 2006 season against SUU.

Vault

The Cougars are ranked 32nd in the nation on the event. Their highest team score of the season is a 49.050. Dayna Smart and Alethea Boon have led the team in every meet this season. Boon posted a team-best 9.950, which tied the seventh-highest mark in school history, against Texas Woman's.

Bars

BYU's highest score of the season is a 48.975. The Cougars are ranked 30th in the nation on the event. Senior Kacie Capra-Callens leads the team with a team-best 9.850. Three others have posted 9.825s.

Beam

The beam squad is ranked 17th in the nation. BYU recorded a season-best 49.125 against Utah State on Jan. 22. Smart has the highest score of the season at 9.950, tying the eighth-best mark in school history. She is ranked 13th in the nation on the event. Six of the eight competitors that have been in the lineup this season have posted a 9.800 or better.

Floor

The Cougars highest score of the season is 48.975. BYU is ranked 28th in the nation on the event. Capra-Callens has posted the team's highest mark at 9.900. Three freshmen have competed on the event this year.

All-Around

Smart and Boon have been the only all-around competitors this season. Smart has five all-around titles in six meets competing on every event. Boon has posted a 39.225 and has one all-around title.

Freshman Megan Perner is out this week with a foot injury.

Boon, Floor Lift Cougars in Colorado

DENVER, Colo. (March 16, 2007) -- Alethea Boon picked up the first all-around victory of her career with a 39.100, and the No. 22 Cougar gymnasts tumbled to their second-highest mark of the season on floor to help BYU to a 193.800 outing at a triangular meet Friday in Colorado.

The Cougars came in third place behind No. 17 Denver, who recorded a 196.100, and Pac-10 competitor California at 193.875.

BYU welcomed the return of senior Kacie Capra-Callens to the bars lineup after she sat out last weekend to nurse an ankle injury. The Kingwood, Texas, native swung to a 9.775 to tie freshman teammate McKell Poulson for team-high honors on the event. Kylee Draper was close behind with a 9.750, while Lisa Willis tied a season-best 9.725 for the Cougars.

Hayley Jensen turned in a good night on beam with a career-high 9.775 to lead BYU in its second rotation. Alethea Boon was also strong with a 9.750 to finish right behind Jensen. However, the event that has been one of the Cougars' best the last two years ended up being the one that gave them the most problems Friday night.

A pair of career highs from two freshmen helped the Cougars to a 48.925 on floor to get back on track in the third rotation. First-year competitors Heidi Poulson and Danielle Goldman tumbled to career-best marks of 9.800 and 9.750, respectively, to start things off. Dayna Smart picked up a 9.800. Boon led the way for the Cougars on the event with a 9.825, the second-best mark of her career.

Boon led BYU on vault with a 9.850 in the last rotation. Smart was just behind with a 9.800. Jenna Kerbis turned in a solid 9.700 for the Cougars.

Boon picked up the highest total score over the four events to come in first place in the all-around.

BYU Vaults, Swings Past 195 Mark

PROVO, Utah (March 9, 2007) - Season-high scores on vault and uneven bars sparked the BYU women's gymnastics team to a 195.125 outing and its second-best team mark of the season.

The Cougars took second in the triangular meet just behind No. 10 Oregon State, who finished with a 195.375. Utah State took third at 194.675.

The Cougars started the meet off on a hot note as they sizzled to a season-best 49.050 on vault. Kiki Berrett and Danielle Goldman landed 9.725 and 9.750 scores, respectively, and Jenna Kerbis also notched a 9.750. Alethea Boon led the way for BYU with a 9.925. Dayna Smart was close behind with a career-tying mark of 9.900.

A trio of 9.825 scores from McKell Poulson, Aimee Walker Pond and Kylee Draper on bars kept the Cougar fire going in the second rotation as they notched a season-high 48.975. The mark notched new career highs for both Poulson and Walker Pond. Boon, competing on the event for the first time in her collegiate career, swung her way to a career-best 9.800.

Smart, the 11th ranked beam worker in the nation, led the way with a first-place 9.850 on the event. Boon recorded a solid 9.750, while Hayley Jensen nailed a career-high 9.700. Lisa Willis chipped in a strong performance at 9.725.

Smart also led the Cougars on floor with a career-best 9.875. She was followed by a pair of solid 9.750s from Willis and Boon.

Competing in the all-around for the first time in her collegiate career, Boon recorded a strong 39.225 to come in third place.

BYU was without the services of standout Kacie Capra-Callens Friday night. The senior sat the meet out with a foot injury.
