### BYU QUICK HITS

- BYU's freshmen stepped it up in the team's series against CSU Bakersfield. Gordy Bravo hit .462 (6x13) and had five runs scored and four RBI, alongside a triple and double. Coco Taualii hit .417 (5x12) and had one home run, six RBI and two runs scored.
- Sophomore pitcher Caroline Umphlett went 2-0 against CSU Bakersfield to earn her first win since Feb. 9 against Idaho State in the first tournament of the season.
- This will be the first time that BYU and Saint Mary's will play at Gail Miller Field. BYU has an overall record of 4-0 against the Gaels and this conference series will be the last of the season for both teams.
- BYU defeated Southern Utah 8-0 twice in Tuesday's doubleheader at home. Coco Taualii hit 5 for 6 and had four RBI on the night.
- JC Clayton is one stolen base away from tying the all-time career record at BYU.

## BY THE NUMBERS

**6** Gordon Eakin has led BYU to six conference championships. The team won it's first conference championship in 2005, by winning both the regular season championship with a record of 16-2 and then winning three-straight games in the MWC Championship for the tournament title as well. Last year, BYU grabbed its sixth conference tournament championship in the Western Athletic Conference after beating out Fresno State in the final.

**8** BYU has secured eight-straight 40-win seasons. Last year, the team ended it's season with a record of 45-15 to keep the run going. The team also has eight-straight postseason appearances. In 2012 the team went 2-2 in the Oregon Regional. BYU has only advanced to a Super Regional once in 2010 against the University of Arizona.

**48** BYU currently has a total of 48 wins against PCSC opponents. They have the best record against Utah Valley at 25-1 and have yet to score a win against Cal State Bakersfield with a record of 0-1. The Cougars have been most competitive with San Diego, holding a record of 5-3 against the Toreros.

**416** Gordon Eakin reached the 400-win mark last season with a 5-0 win against Louisiana Tech. He ended the season with a record of 416-175. In the MWC, Eakin held the highest winning percentage in MWC history in MWC games (.750) and overall. He is also a three-time MWC Coach of the Year (2009, 2010, 2011)

**OPPONENT NOTES****Saint Mary's**

Saint Mary's has a record of 20-27 on the season and is 11-9 in PCSC play. The Gaels had an off week last week to prepare for their last series of the season against the Cougars. The Gaels are led by Megan Smith, who is hitting a .309 clip alongside a team-high 26 RBI. Brittany Sabatini provides speed and power for the team, leading them with 25 runs scored and nine stolen bases. She also has four home runs and five doubles on the season. Lujane Mussadi leads the team from the mound with a 1.76 season ERA and a record of 13-10. She's only given up 44 earned runs in 37 appearances. She also ranks in the top 50 in the NCAA in ERA (1.69), saves (3) and walks allowed per seven innings (1.33).

SMC has won eight of their last nine games, including a 5-2 victory over No. 15/16 Stanford. In those games four players in Sabatini, Elizabeth Slaughter, Megan Smith and Sarah Lira, are hitting over .300 with Sabatini leading the way for her .464 clip. In conference, the Gaels won their four-game series against CSU Bakersfield (3-1) and Santa Clara (4-0), split series games with San Diego and Utah Valley and were swept by Loyola Marymount.

With a season batting average of .202 Saint Mary's is way below BYU's average of .289. However, the Gaels have out-hit BYU in home runs with 23 to the Cougars' 14.

## LAST TIME OUT

PROVO, Utah--The BYU softball team broke its season high in runs and hits in game two on Friday night, beating CSU Bakersfield 13-6 after a 4-1 defeat of the Roadrunners in game one at Gail Miller Field. On Saturday, CSUB avoided the sweep in game two with a 3-1 win, after being handed its third loss in game one, 8-5.

BYU (25-22, 14-4 Pacific Coast Softball Conference) had just six hits in its 4-1 game one victory, but came out on all cylinders to hit a season-high 15 hits in game two on its way to a 13-6 defeat of CSUB (14-31, 9-13 PCSC).

Alexandra Hudson Shamo had two RBI for BYU in game one. Coco Taualii led the team in game two, going 3 for 4 with two runs scored and four RBI, including a three-run home run in the sixth. Lacey Millett, Bravo, Manuma and Robb each added two hits apiece in the game.

CSU Bakersfield held a 3-0 lead through the first four innings of game one on Saturday, but BYU fought back, scoring eight runs in the fifth and sixth for an 8-5 final and the win. In game two, BYU out-hit CSU Bakersfield 5-2, but the Roadrunners took advantage of seven walks to avoid the sweep.

BYU defeated Southern Utah 8-0 in both games on Tuesday. Coco Taualii had four RBI in game one and Megan Arnold had three in game two to lead the Cougars.

Hannah Howell (12-14) pitched 5 and 2/3 inning of relief to earn the win in game one. Taualii led four Cougars who registered a multi-hit game, going 4 for 4 with three RBI and one run scored. JC Clayton recorded three hits and Carly Duckworth and Madisen Robb each added two hits.

Mylee Davis led the team in game two, going a perfect 3 for 3 while Arnold punched in two hits, two runs scored and three RBI in game two. Tori Almond improved to 9-6 on the season after throwing four scoreless innings and giving up just three hits.

## SENIOR SEASON HIGHLIGHTS

The BYU softball team will recognize its seniors JC Clayton, Baillie Hicken, Hannah Howell and Alexandra Hudson Shamo on Saturday following the conclusion of the series against Saint Mary's.

JC Clayton has had a record-breaking year, becoming the all-time leader in career hits at BYU. She also set the single-game record for stolen bases in a game with four against San Diego and is just two stolen bases away from tying the all-time career record at BYU. Clayton was named to the Top 50 Watch List for the 2013 USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year at the start of the season, is a three-time PCSC Player of the Week and an Easton Second-Team All-American.

Baillie Hicken leads the team in PCSC statistics with a .367 clip. She has nine runs scored in conference play and a career-high five RBI. Hicken hit the first double of her career against Santa Clara and had a career-high three hits, two runs scored and two RBI in the game. Last year Hicken was named to the Academic All-WAC team and is also a WAC Scholar-Athlete.

Hannah Howell pitched just the second perfect game in BYU softball history against LMU on Apr. 13. She was named the PCSC Pitcher of the Week for the week of Apr. 14-20 and PCSC College Madness Player of the Week for the week of Mar. 17-23. Howell has a 1.44 ERA in conference play and has given up just 12 earned runs in 12 appearances. She has 35 strikeouts alongside a record of 7-2 in PCSC play.

Alexandra Hudson Shamo has had the best season of her career, hitting a career-high .350 alongside career highs in hits (42), runs (14), walks (27), triples (2), and putouts (45). Shamo leads the conference with an on-base percentage of .473.

## PERFECT HOWELL

Senior pitcher Hannah Howell recorded the first perfect game of her career and the second in BYU softball history on Saturday against Loyola Marymount. Summer Tobias has the only other perfect game in BYU history against Utah Valley in 2005. Howell pitched a clean five innings to lead the team to an 11-0 victory over the Lions, alongside three strikeouts in the game. Howell earned both wins against LMU on Saturday to save BYU's run at the NCAA tournament with a series-split against the Lions.

This season, Howell has pitched a total of 159 innings and compiled a record of 12-14. She has an ERA of 1.44 in conference play to lead the team, with a 7-2 record and 35 strikeouts in nine appearances. Her career record at BYU is 38-26 alongside 347 strikeouts and a 2.84 ERA.

**IN THE RECORD BOOKS**

There are a number of BYU softball players who are currently setting all-time season and career records at BYU.

Senior shortstop JC Clayton broke the all-time hit record with six hits against San Diego to surpass Angie Quiocho. She now has 295 career hits and 70 hits so far on the season. Clayton is also fourth all-time in career runs with 184 and is just one stolen base away from tying the all-time record of 46.

Sophomore Lacey Millett set a record for the most stolen bases in a season at BYU with 21 so far this season. Lindsey Hodgen Kelly held the previous record of 20 stolen bases in her 2000 and 2001 seasons.

Pitchers Tori Almond and Hannah Howell are tied for fifth in season wins, each with 20 in 2012. They have also both moved up in the area of career strikeouts at BYU. Almond is fourth with 360 and Howell is not far behind in fifth with 347. Howell also became the second pitcher in BYU softball history to pitch a perfect game with her five-inning performance against LMU on Apr. 13.

**CONSISTENT CLAYTON**

Senior shortstop JC Clayton has been as consistent as they come for BYU softball. The California native made an impact right away for the Cougars, starting in 54 games her freshman year. She had a career-high 80 hits that season alongside a .430 batting average and a career-high 56 runs scored. Her consistency throughout the season helped lead BYU to its first ever NCAA Super Regional against Arizona.

In her sophomore and junior seasons she started in every game and continued to add to her impressive freshman stats, leading the Cougars to two more NCAA Regional appearances and two conference championships.

In her first three years at BYU, Clayton garnered Mountain West Conference Freshman of the Year, Mountain West All-Conference First Team, Easton Second-Team All-American, NFCA All-Region First Team, All-WAC First Team and two BYU Offensive Player of the Year accolades.

At the beginning of this season, she was named to the Top 50 Watch List for the 2013 USA Collegiate Softball Player of the Year. With six hits against USD in the conference opener, she surpassed Angie Quiocho to hold the new all-time hit record at BYU with 275 career hits. Clayton also set a game record in game two against the Toreros for stolen bases in a game with four.

Clayton is also second in career batting average with .403, fourth in career runs scored with 184, second in career triples with 9 and second in career stolen bases with 45. Clayton is just one stolen base away from tying the all-time career record. She has also won three PCSC Player of the Week honor's so far this season. She currently has 295 career hits.

**PCSC PLAYER/PITCHER OF THE WEEK**

PROVO, Utah—Senior pitcher Hannah Howell garnered her first Pacific Coast Softball Conference Pitcher of the Week honor for her performance against Santa Clara on Friday and Saturday.

Howell, who pitched BYU softball's second perfect game in school history against Loyola Marymount on Apr. 13, has a career record of 38-25 at BYU alongside 336 strikeouts and a 2.87 ERA.

In the last two weeks of conference play, Howell has compiled a record of 4-1 in 23.0 innings pitched. Against Santa Clara, she grabbed a record of 2-0 after holding the Broncos scoreless on just three hits in 12.0 innings pitched. Howell is 7-2 in conference play with a 1.14 ERA and just eight earned runs given up in nine appearances.

Brittany Sabatini of Saint Mary's was named PCSC Player of the Week for her .444 batting average, two home runs and four runs scored in the team's series against CSU Bakersfield. Other top performers include BYU's JC Clayton who hit .500 alongside five runs scored against Santa Clara, Utah Valley's Kylee Brinkerhoff and San Diego's Chloe Kaneko.

Other top performances from the mound include San Diego's Cassidy Coleman, Utah Valley's Tiffany Mills and Saint Mary's Lujane Mussadi.

BYU returns home on Friday to kick off an 11-game home stand, starting with a doubleheader against CSU Bakersfield set to begin at 5 p.m. MDT.

**PRESEASON POLLS**

PORTLAND, Ore.-BYU softball grabbed the top spot in the Pacific Coast Softball Conference preseason poll for 2013.

All seven head coaches participated in the poll and six of the seven gave BYU a first-place vote, each worth seven points. BYU received 48 votes overall followed by Loyola Marymount with 39 and San Diego with 32.

Saint Mary's received the other first place vote as the defending conference champions and were picked to finish just behind San Diego with 31 votes. Utah Valley finished with 18, CSU Bakersfield with 15 and Santa Clara with 13 votes.

In their first season in the PCSC, the Cougars will look to improve upon their record of 45-15 and 15-4 in conference play last year. BYU finished the 2012 season after winning the Western Athletic Conference tournament championship and traveling to the NCAA Oregon Regional for its eight-straight postseason appearance. The Cougars ended their season against Oregon in a 4-1 loss.

**BYU head coach Gordon Eakin**

Eakin is entering his 11th season as the Cougars' head coach and his 14th season at BYU overall.

Eakin was named head coach in July 2002 after working as an assistant coach since the softball program's inception in 2000. Since that time he has led the Cougars to five Mountain West Conference championships, one Western Athletic Conference tournament championship and eight NCAA tournament appearances.

As MWC Coach of the Year three-straight years (2009, 2010, 2011) he has coached eleven All-Americans, seven MWC Players of the Year, one WAC Player of the Year, three MWC Freshmen of the Year and two MWC Pitchers of the Year during his tenure.

In 2010, Eakin guided the Cougars to 46 wins, the most in school history, as BYU advanced to the NCAA Super Regionals for the first time ever with wins over East Carolina and host Texas before ending its season at national runner-up Arizona. The Cougars finished second in the country in batting average, seventh in scoring and ninth in slugging percentage as a team last season.

Known as one of the best hitting coaches in the country, Eakin has helped BYU finish in the top-ten nationally six times in slugging percentage, six times in home runs per game, four times in batting average and four times in scoring.

In addition to his duties at BYU, Eakin has also been an assistant coach and the hitting coach for the USA National Team since 2009. In the summer of 2010, Eakin helped guide the National Team to a 17-2 record as USA won the World Championship in Venezuela, the World Cup in Oklahoma and the Japan Cup championship in Sendai, Japan.

Before entering the coaching ranks, Eakin was a successful baseball and softball player. After playing collegiate baseball at the University of Utah, Eakin signed with the Oakland Athletics organization where he played for three years.

Eakin went on to join the United States All-Star team, playing in three U.S. Olympic sports festivals in 1986, 1993 and 1994, winning bronze, silver and gold, respectively. While on the team, Eakin was honored on the ISC All-World First Team and was an ASA All-American. He would later go on to play shortstop on the internationally ranked Larry H. Miller Toyota Fast Pitch team, eventually earning induction into the Utah Fast Pitch Hall of Fame in 1998.

Eakin is a native of Holladay, Utah, and graduated from Granite High. He currently resides in Sandy, Utah, and is married to Barbi. They are the parents of three children (Alicia, Ryan & Parker) and have four grandsons.
