

- After last week's series agaisnt Idaho State, BYU jumped back into the top 100 in three categories. They are No. 80 in home runs per game (0.78), No. 90 in fielding percentage (.963) and No. 90 in scoring (4.88).
- Sydney Broderick picked up BYU's fourth WCC Player of the Week award this season. She hit .600 with two home runs and two triples last week. She joins McKenzie St. Clair who won the award for week one and Katie Manuma who won in week's two and four.
- McKenna Bull is 13 strikeouts from passing Christie Zinanti for second on the freshman strikeout charts. She finished with 20 strikeouts last week in 17.1 innings to give her 107 on the season. In order to have a top 10 strikeout season she will need 83 strikeouts over the final 22 games.
- BYU currently has a total of 40 wins against WCC opponents. They have the best record against Saint Mary's at 8-0. Last year the Cougars played against all WCC teams except Pacific earning a combined record of 14-2. The Cougars have been most competitive with San Diego and Loyola Marymount, holding a record of 9-3 against the Toreros and a 12-4 record agains the Lions.

IN THE RECORD BOOKS

McKenna Bull is third in strikeouts for a freshman at BYU with 107. With 13 more strikeouts she will pass up Christie Zinanti for third all-time. She is on pace to break the freshman record held by Paige Affleck (134) by the end of the year. She needs 82 strikeouts to tie Daniela Urincho Snow for the tenth best strikeout season at BYU.

Pitcher Tori Almond is fourth in career wins (44), third in career strikeouts (428) and fourth in career shutouts (10). With one more win she will tie Summer Tobias for third all-time. She is BYU's career leader in lowest opponent batting average allowed at .206 ahead of Paige Affleck (.211). Almond also pitched the first no-hitter of her career on May 4, 2013. This marked the 15th no-hitter in BYU history.

It took Sydney Broderick eight weeks to get the first home run of her career, a lead-off solo shot to center field against Idaho State on Friday. She got her second the very next game with a two-run homer over the scoreboard in left field on Saturday.

She also added two triples in those games to tie Megan Fogelsong of Pacific for the conference lead. In the first game Saturday, Broderick was one double away from becoming the first softball player to ever hit for the cycle.

BYU head coach Gordon Eakin

Eakin is entering his 12th season as the Cougars' head coach and his 14th season at BYU overall.

Eakin was named head coach in July 2002 after working as an assistant coach since the softball program's inception in 2000. Since that time he has led the Cougars to five Mountain West Conference championships, one Western Athletic Conference tournament championship and eight NCAA tournament appearances.

As MWC Coach of the Year three-straight years (2009, 2010, 2011) he has coached eleven All-Americans, seven MWC Players of the Year, one WAC Player of the Year, three MWC Freshmen of the Year and two MWC Pitchers of the Year during his tenure.

In 2010, Eaking guided the Cougars to 46 wins, the most in school history, as BYU advanced to the NCAA Super Regionals for the first time ever with wins over East Carolina and host Texas before ending its season at national runner-up Arizona. The Cougars finished second in the country in batting average, seventh in scoring and ninth in slugging percentage as a team last season.

Known as one of the best hitting coaches in the country, Eakin has helped BYU finish in the top-ten nationally six times in slugging percentage, six times in home runs per game, four times in batting average and four times in scoring.

In addition to his duties at BYU, Eakin has also been an assistant coach and the hitting coach for the USA National Team since 2009. In the summer of 2010, Eakin helped guide the National Team to a 17-2 record as USA won the World Championship in Venezuela, the World Cup in Oklahoma and the Japan Cup championship in Sendai, Japan.

Before entering the coaching ranks, Eakin was a successful baseball and softball player. After playing collegiate baseball at the University of Utah, Eakin signed with the Oakland Athletics organization where he played for three years.

Eakin went on to join the United States All-Star team, playing in three U.S. Olympic sports festivals in 1986, 1993 and 1994, winning bronze, silver and gold, respectively. While on the team, Eakin was honored on the ISC All-World First Team and was an ASA All-American. He would later go on to play shortstop on the internationally ranked Larry H. Miller Toyota Fast Pitch team, eventually earning induction into the Utah Fast Pitch Hall of Fame in 1998.

Eakin is a native of Holladay, Utah, and graduated from Granite High. He currently resides in Sandy, Utah, and is married to Barbi. They are the parents of three children (Alicia, Ryan & Parker) and have five grandsons.






