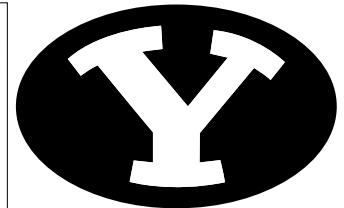

**SAN FRANCISCO** - The No. 22 BYU women's soccer team scored in the first five minutes and the last five minutes of the first half before going on to win 2-0 over San Francisco on Thursday night. Senior forward Niki Fernandes scored the first goal in the fifth minute as Cloee Colohan came away with a rebound and found Fernandes in the box. She looped a shot over the keeper and into the back of the net for a 1-0 lead. Ashley Hatch also assisted on the goal which was Fernandes' first of the season.

Colohan scored BYU's second goal as a pass across the top of the box from Miranda Bailey gave her an open window. Colohan fired to the far post across her body and beat the keeper for a 2-0 lead in the 40th minute. Colohan scored a goal and made an assist for the second straight game, accomplishing the feat against Baylor last Friday. Colohan is now tied for the team lead in goals with three. Rachel Manning and Ashley Hatch have also scored three goals this season.

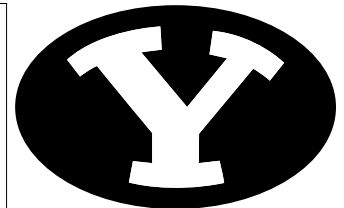

## BYU VS. SANTA CLARA AT A GLANCE

BYU takes on Santa Clara in their first WCC Women's Soccer Game of the Week this season. The Broncos were preseason conference favorites and will face San Diego on Thursday before taking on the Cougars. The Broncos defeated San Diego in their WCC opener 1-0 on Thursday night at home. Santa Clara has faced four top 10 teams so far this season. The Broncos tied California, but lost to Virginia, North Carolina and Stanford. The Cougars have faced four teams that have been ranked this season, beating LSU, Nebraska and Baylor, while losing to Denver. Santa Clara has two Hermann Trophy candidates on their roster this season. Returning All-American

Julie Johnston and All-America transfer Morgan Marlborough. Johnston has six goals and two assists, while Marlborough has five goals and two assists. Junior Sofia Huerta has also scored four goals and has an assist. Since BYU joined the WCC, the Cougars and Broncos have yet to score against one another. Both games have ended in 0-0 ties after two overtime periods. The teams have also faced one another four times in the NCAA tournament. All four were played in consecutive years from 1997-2000. Santa Clara won each of them, one came in the first round, two in the second round and one in the Sweet 16.

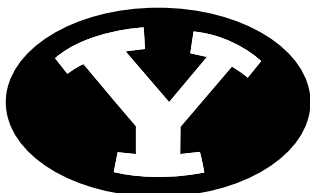

**MORE ABOUT COACH**

Prior to becoming the head coach, Rockwood led BYU's highly successful club soccer team for seven years. In that time she amassed an overall record of 128-25-9. The final two years she took her teams to the Western National Collegiate Club soccer Association (NCCSA) title and placed second in the NCCSA National Championships.

The Lake Oswego, Ore. native was a four-sport athlete in high school playing soccer, softball, basketball and track. After one year at Rick's College on a basketball scholarship, she transferred to BYU where she became a four-year starter at center midfield on the Cougars' club soccer team and graduated in finance, business management. Rockwood has also coached youth club programs, high school teams and the Utah Olympic Development Program.

**GAME STORYLINES**

- BYU head coach Jennifer Rockwood won her 300th game on Thursday and is the sixth coach in Division-I to win 300 games all at the same institution. Rockwood is currently in her 19th season coaching.
- Rockwood is the fifth winningest active coach by win percentage and seventh all-time in Division I. She is also 16th all-time in D-I total victories.
- BYU has been in the NSCAA Top 25 for more than a calendar year. They reached as high as No. 2 last November and started the streak at No. 17 on Sept. 10, 2012.
- Against Utah on Sept. 6, BYU set an attendance record for the second time this season with 5,402 fans. The game was the 14th highest attended women's NCAA soccer game of all-time outside of the NCAA tournament.
- This season BYU has hosted crowds that are the 14th (Sept. 6, W 1-0 Utah) and 22nd (Aug. 31, W 3-0 Nebraska) highest attended games all-time outside of the NCAA tournament. BYU has also hosted three of the five highest attended games in South Field history this fall (Utah, Sept. 6; Nebraska, Aug. 31; UC Irvine, Sept. 14).
- The Cougars lead the nation in average attendance so far this season. South Field has averaged 3,546 fans over five games, 626 more fans than the next closest in average attendance.
- BYU has had nine players score goals this season. Last season they had 12 different players score a goal. Five players have scored multiple times
- Defenders Paige Hunt and Ella Johnson both scored in the win over Oklahoma. Hunt and Johnson are the only defenders to get on the scoresheet for the Cougars this season. Hunt scored against LSU and Oklahoma and is third on the team in goals scored.
- BYU senior goalkeeper Erica Owens is currently third in the West Coast Conference in goals against average at .88 and has allowed the second fewest goals.
- BYU and Santa Clara have yet to score against one another in West Coast Conference play. Both matches have ended in 0-0 ties.
