- JC Clayton is currently on a 14-game hitting streak and has gotten a hit in every game but the first of the season. She also earned PCSC Player of the Week.
- Head coach Gordon Eakin is in his 11th season with BYU and has a record of 421-185.

## BY THE NUMBERS

**6** Gordon Eakin has led BYU to six conference championships. The team won it's first conference championship in 2005, by winning both the regular season championship with a record of 16-2 and then winning three-straight games in the MWC Championship for the tournament title as well. Last year, BYU grabbed its sixth conference tournament championship in the Western Athletic Conference after beating out Fresno State in the final.

**8** BYU has secured eight-straight 40-win seasons. Last year, the team ended it's season with a record of 45-15 to keep the run going. The team also has eight-straight postseason appearances. In 2012 the team went 2-2 in the Oregon Regional. BYU has only advanced to a Super Regional once in 2010 against the University of Arizona.

**48** BYU currently has a total of 48 wins against PCSC opponents. They have the best record against Utah Valley at 25-1 and have yet to score a win against Cal State Bakersfield with a record of 0-1. The Cougars have been most competitive with San Diego, holding a record of 5-3 against the Toreros.

**416** Gordon Eakin reached the 400-win mark last season with a 5-0 win against Louisiana Tech. He ended the season with a record of 416-175. In the MWC, Eakin held the highest winning percentage in MWC history in MWC games (.750) and overall. He is also a three-time MWC Coach of the Year (2009, 2010, 2011)

**RED DESERT CLASSIC OPPONENT NOTES****San Diego State**

The Aztecs are just over .500 with a record of 8-7 this season. They have four players batting over .300 in Kameron May, Patrice Jackson, Loena Bauer and Kayla Jordan. These four batters combine for 38 of the team's 44 RBI and have all 12 home runs for the Aztecs. Danielle O'Toole and Rebecca Arbino lead SDSU from the mound and are sporting a 1.35 and 1.56 ERA, respectively. The two have only given up 21 earned runs in their combined 20 appearances this season. Four of the team's seven losses have been by less than two runs and they have yet to beat a ranked team, losing to No. 13/14 Arizona, No. 24/22 Kentucky, No. 2/1 Oklahoma, No. 7 Missouri and No. 9/11 Oregon. This tournament will be the first of the season where the Aztecs will not be facing a ranked opponent.

**Boise State**

The Broncos sit at an even 7-7 on the season and will look to jump above .500 against BYU in their first game of the San Diego Classic. Boise State is 0-2 overall against BYU and hopes it's top three batters will step up to get past the Cougars. Holly Bourke leads the Broncos with a .385 average. Sarah Barnes and Devon Bridges aren't far behind, hitting .344 and .340, respectively. Barnes has eight RBI and two home runs while Bridges has a team-high 16 RBI and three home runs. Redshirt junior Rebecca Patton has five of the Bronco's seven wins and leads with a 3.53 ERA and 32 strikeouts this season. The Broncos were chosen to finish fourth in the Mountain West Conference this year behind San Diego State, Colorado State and Fresno State.

**Fresno State**

BYU ended the Bulldog's season last year, defeating them 8-3 in the championship game of the Western Athletic Conference tournament to advance to the NCAA regionals. That was only BYU's third win against Fresno State as the Bulldogs hold an 8-3 overall advantage over BYU. Fresno State is 10-8 this season. Brooke Ortiz leads with a .361 average and 22 hits, while Brenna Moss and Stesha Brazil provide power for the Bulldogs. Moss has five triples and 10 RBI, while Brazil leads with a team-high five home runs. Taylor Langdon, Jillian Compton and Hannah Harris each have part in each of the team's 10 wins. Compton is 5-5 with 26 strikeouts and 59.2 innings pitched, while Langdon leads with a 2.15 ERA.

**New Mexico**

BYU has an overall record of 36-13 against New Mexico and is 30-5 under Eakin. The Cougars had a 13-game win streak against the Lobos before New Mexico beat them in 2011 3-2. New Mexico is another .500 team at 9-9 on the season. The Lobos lost their first seven games before rebounding to win nine of their last 11 games. The team has five pitchers who have made an appearance this season, but are led by Lauren Soles who is 4-2 with 32 strikeouts and only 13 earned runs given up in her eight appearances. Offensively, freshman outfielder Mariah Rimmer is hitting .400 with a team-high 24 hits, alongside two home runs and eight RBI. Rimmer also leads the team with 14 stolen bases to add to the team's total of 30. Junior infielder Chelsea Anaya isn't far behind, hitting .377 with two home runs and 14 RBI.

**Long Beach State**

The Cougars are 2-2 overall against Long Beach State and have won the last two meetings. The 49ers sit at 7-6 this season and are led by junior Hannah De Gaetano who is sporting a .356 batting average along with two home runs and 11 RBI on the season. Catcher Karli Sandoval and infielder Ashley Holmes also bring power to the lineup with five and three homeruns, respectively, on the season. These three batters have combined for 37 of the team's 56 RBI. Erin Jones-Wesley has the most time on the mound for the 49ers. With eight starts, she has a 4-4 record alongside 59 strikeouts and has held opponents to an average of .294.

**LAST TIME OUT**

CATHEDRAL CITY, Calif.--BYU lost four of its five games in the Mary Nutter Classic last weekend, beating only UNLV to fall to 5-10 on the season.

The BYU softball team lost both games in its opening day of the tournament after a grand slam in the top of the seventh lifted No. 11 LSU over BYU 10-6 and an error propelled Oklahoma State to the 3-2 victory against the Cougars on Thursday in Palm Springs. The Cougars had 11 hits to LSU's 12, but the Tigers hit three home runs to score eight of its 10 runs in defeat of BYU.

BYU and Oklahoma State each had five hits apiece in the game. JC Clayton and Coryn Tauali'i scored the two Cougar runs and each had a hit. Clayton also extended her season hitting streak to 11 games and still has a hit in every game of the season but one. Gordy Bravo was clutch again with a late-inning base hit to bring in the only Cougar RBI of the day. Tori Almond started the game and gave up only two earned runs on five hits in six innings of work.

BYU's only win of the tournament came against UNLV on Friday, beating the Runnin' Rebels 5-3. BYU had nine hits to UNLV's four on the day. The Cougars were down 3-1 heading into the top of the sixth, but scored four runs in the sixth and seventh innings to take home its first win of the tournament. Alexandra Hudson Shamo went 3 for 4 in the game with one RBI to lead BYU offensively. Clayton and Bravo also had two hits apiece and each scored a run for the Cougars.

"We didn't start as well as we should have, missing some opportunities offensively in the first inning, but we did finish better today," said BYU head coach Gordon Eakin. "We're fighting and I was happy with today's overall effort."

A three-run seventh inning led Northwestern to a 4-1 defeat of the BYU softball team in its first game on Saturday. BYU had only one hit leading up to the seventh inning and had bases loaded in the sixth and seventh, but weren't able to capitalize.

The Cougars faced a 10-3 deficit heading into the bottom of the seventh frame against UC Santa Barbara in its last game of the tournament, but a combined five hits, including Katie Manuma's grand slam, brought the game to a 10-10 tie. However, UCSB answered with two runs in the top of the eighth to improve to 9-3 on the season, while BYU falls to 5-10.

**TRADING CONFERENCES**

The BYU softball team will be joining its third conference in three years this season. From 2000-2011, the team was part of the Mountain West Conference. In 2012, the Cougars switched to the Western Athletic Conference for a season. This year, the team will spend the 2013 season in the Pacific Coast Softball Conference before making its final switch to the West Coast Conference in 2014. Softball will be the WCC's 14th sport.

Junior infielder Katie Manuma hit her first career grand slam against UC Santa Barbara at the Mary Nutter Classic. Down 10-3 in the bottom of the seventh inning, the Cougars rallied to score three runs and bring up Manuma with the bases loaded. Manuma took advantage with a bomb that tied up the game at 10-10 and sent the game into extra-innings. BYU wasn't able to keep the momentum in the eight and surrendered two runs to the Gauchos for the 12-10 loss. This was BYU's first grand slam of the season and Manuma's third home run.

Manuma is currently hitting .283 with seven runs scored, 15 RBI and 23 total bases. She also leads the team with 94 putouts at first base, where she has started in every game this season.

**RANKED OPPONENTS**

The BYU softball team faced a ranked opponent in each of the team's first three tournaments. This tournament will be its first without facing a ranked team.

The Cougars have an all-time record of 30-61 against ranked opponents under head coach Gordon Eakin. This year BYU won one and lost two against ranked opponents No. 6 Tennessee, No. 20 Hawai'i and No. 10/11 LSU.

In its first tournament of the season in St. George, Utah, the Cougars played No. 6 Tennessee and fell to the Lady Vols 6-3. A three-run rally in the seventh inning wasn't enough to give the Cougars the win.

At the Easton Desert Classic in Las Vegas last weekend the Cougars faced their second ranked opponent in as many weeks. BYU held on to upset No. 20 Hawai'i 4-2 behind the bats of Lacey Millett and Katie Manuma.

The Cougars faced No. 10/11 LSU in the Mary Nutter Classic. BYU was down 6-2 heading into the bottom of the sixth, but rallied to tie up the game. However, LSU dealt a blow to the Cougars in the top of the seventh with a grand slam to take the 10-6 lead. The Tigers held the lead through the bottom to take the victory.

**BYU head coach Gordon Eakin**

Eakin is entering his 11th season as the Cougars' head coach and his 14th season at BYU overall.

Eakin was named head coach in July 2002 after working as an assistant coach since the softball program's inception in 2000. Since that time he has led the Cougars to five Mountain West Conference championships, one Western Athletic Conference tournament championship and eight NCAA tournament appearances.

As MWC Coach of the Year three-straight years (2009, 2010, 2011) he has coached eleven All-Americans, seven MWC Players of the Year, one WAC Player of the Year, three MWC Freshmen of the Year and two MWC Pitchers of the Year during his tenure.

In 2010, Eakin guided the Cougars to 46 wins, the most in school history, as BYU advanced to the NCAA Super Regionals for the first time ever with wins over East Carolina and host Texas before ending its season at national runner-up Arizona. The Cougars finished second in the country in batting average, seventh in scoring and ninth in slugging percentage as a team last season.

Known as one of the best hitting coaches in the country, Eakin has helped BYU finish in the top-ten nationally six times in slugging percentage, six times in home runs per game, four times in batting average and four times in scoring.

In addition to his duties at BYU, Eakin has also been an assistant coach and the hitting coach for the USA National Team since 2009. In the summer of 2010, Eakin helped guide the National Team to a 17-2 record as USA won the World Championship in Venezuela, the World Cup in Oklahoma and the Japan Cup championship in Sendai, Japan.

Before entering the coaching ranks, Eakin was a successful baseball and softball player. After playing collegiate baseball at the University of Utah, Eakin signed with the Oakland Athletics organization where he played for three years.

Eakin went on to join the United States All-Star team, playing in three U.S. Olympic sports festivals in 1986, 1993 and 1994, winning bronze, silver and gold, respectively. While on the team, Eakin was honored on the ISC All-World First Team and was an ASA All-American. He would later go on to play shortstop on the internationally ranked Larry H. Miller Toyota Fast Pitch team, eventually earning induction into the Utah Fast Pitch Hall of Fame in 1998.

Eakin is a native of Holladay, Utah, and graduated from Granite High. He currently resides in Sandy, Utah, and is married to Barbi. They are the parents of three children (Alicia, Ryan & Parker) and have four grandsons.
