BYU QUICK HITS

- BYU played in its last USF Under Armour Showcase in 2009 where it defeated Indiana 6-0 and Ball State 5-4 and lost to Hofstra 4-0 and No. 23 Florida Gulf Coast 5-4.
- This will be BYU's last preseason tournament before returning to Provo for its home opener on Mar. 19 against Marist College.
- Junior pitcher Tori Almond went 2-0 in the San Diego Classic, pitching 9.2 innings and giving up only five hits and two earned runs. She also struck out 10 and held opponents to a .152 average. Almond was named PCSC Pitcher of the Week.
- Senior shortstop JC Clayton continued her hitting streak throughout the San Diego Classic and still has a hit in every game of the season but one. She is currently sitting at a 19-game hitting streak and is tied for the second-longest streak in PCSC history. Clayton was also named PCSC Player of the Week for the second-straight week.

BY THE NUMBERS

6 Gordon Eakin has led BYU to six conference championships. The team won it's first conference championship in 2005, by winning both the regular season championship with a record of 16-2 and then winning three-straight games in the MWC Championship for the tournament title as well. Last year, BYU grabbed its sixth conference tournament championship in the Western Athletic Conference after beating out Fresno State in the final.

8 BYU has secured eight-straight 40-win seasons. Last year, the team ended it's season with a record of 45-15 to keep the run going. The team also has eight-straight postseason appearances. In 2012 the team went 2-2 in the Oregon Regional. BYU has only advanced to a Super Regional once in 2010 against the University of Arizona.

48 BYU currently has a total of 48 wins against PCSC opponents. They have the best record against Utah Valley at 25-1 and have yet to score a win against Cal State Bakersfield with a record of 0-1. The Cougars have been most competitive with San Diego, holding a record of 5-3 against the Toreros.

416 Gordon Eakin reached the 400-win mark last season with a 5-0 win against Louisiana Tech. He ended the season with a record of 416-175. In the MWC, Eakin held the highest winning percentage in MWC history in MWC games (.750) and overall. He is also a three-time MWC Coach of the Year (2009, 2010, 2011)

RED DESERT CLASSIC OPPONENT NOTES**MAINE**

After kicking the season off with a 9-1 victory, the Black Bears have lost nine-straight and are currently 1-9 on the season. The team scored less than two runs in six of its ten games. Maine returns 12 letterwinners from last year's 17-30 squad and welcomes five newcomers to their roster. Sophomore infielder Kristen Ksolosky heads up the Bear's offense, hitting .355 with three runs scored. Junior catcher Jean Stevens brings power to the lineup with two doubles, two home runs and a team-leading nine RBI. Maine has four pitchers on its roster, but is led by senior Beth Spoehr who is 1-3 on the season. She also has an ERA of 2.26 alongside 21.2 innings pitched and only seven earned runs given up. The Black Bears have only played the Cougars once and lost the matchup 9-1 in 2010.

LIU BROOKLYN

The Blackbirds head to their fifth preseason tournament in the USF Under Armour Showcase and will face two PCSC teams in BYU and Loyola Marymount. BYU has an all-time record of 2-0 against LIU and defeated them last year 11-4 in the Cathedral City Classic. LIU sits at 2-17 this season. One of its two wins came against No. 14 Michigan, defeating them 2-1 in the FAU Kickoff Classic. Since that win the Blackbirds have lost 10-straight and have been outscored by their opponents 122-28. The team has three players who are hitting over .300 in Lauren Morizi, Emily Kakuska and Whitney West. Morizi, who hits .385, has six runs scored, six RBI and a team-high five doubles. Righthander Cassie Vondrak has both wins for the Blackhawks and has pitched 72.2 innings of the total 112.2 on the season. She has given up 60 earned runs while striking out 29.

PROVIDENCE

This will be the Friar's third tournament of the season. They started their 2013 campaign with a big 13-7 win against Northern Illinois and won close games against Connecticut and Quinnipiac to grab a 3-7 record. Stephanie Kiesel and Sarah Kitterman both lead the team with a .379 average. Kitterman has three doubles, one triple, two home runs and eight RBI for the Friars. Kiara Baldassari has provided speed for the team with six of the team's seven stolen bases and 10 of the team's 35 runs scored. Corinne Clauss, Kiara Amos and Emily O'Keefe have split time on the mound this season, but Amos has pitched a majority of the innings. She has given up 22 earned runs on 48 hits and also leads the pitching staff with 17 strikeouts. BYU hasn't played Providence since 2009 where they defeated them 5-2.

LAST TIME OUT

SAN DIEGO-The BYU softball team won two games and lost three at the San Diego Classic, defeating Boise State and New Mexico, but falling to San Diego State, Fresno State and Long Beach State.

The Cougars came out flat in their first game of the San Diego Classic, falling to San Diego State 9-1 in five innings at the SDSU Softball Complex. SDSU had 12 hits to BYU's seven and the Aztecs were able to piece those hits together to score four runs in both the third and fifth innings to take the five-inning victory.

On day two, BYU split games. They started the day with an 8-1 defeat of Boise State behind the bats of JC Clayton and Katie Manuma, who had five of the team's ten hits. Tori Almond pitched a three-hitter en route to her third win of the season and didn't allow a single hit from the Broncos until the fourth inning.

A walk-off home run lifted Fresno State over BYU 5-4 in the second game of the day. The Cougars gave up three unearned runs on three errors to keep Fresno State in the game. Clayton and Baillie Hicken led with two hits apiece while Carly Duckworth brought in two Cougar RBI. Hannah Howell pitched a full seven innings and was given the loss after surrendering the lead in the bottom of the seventh.

An 11-hit outing against New Mexico led BYU to a 6-1 victory in its first game of the day, but three home runs and four errors ended the Cougars action at the San Diego Classic with a 12-3 loss to Long Beach State on Saturday.

Almond pitched a four-inning two-hitter to earn her fourth win of the season and Howell grabbed her first save of the season after coming in to start the fifth inning and holding the Lobos to no hits. Clayton, Gordy Bravo and Duckworth each contributed with two hits apiece and combined for four of the six Cougar RBI.

In game two, BYU was able to hold the 49ers' first three batters to no hits, but four Cougar errors and three 49er home runs made up the difference and allowed Long Beach State to score 12 runs on seven hits in the game. Mylee Davis and Katie Manuma each had two hits and Manuma's home run in the top of the third scored the only BYU runs. Manuma also pitched 2.2 innings in the game, but the loss was given to Howell who left the game trailing 4-3. Clayton also had a hit in the game to extend her hitting streak to 19 games on the season.

TRADING CONFERENCES

The BYU softball team will be joining its third conference in three years this season. From 2000-2011, the team was part of the Mountain West Conference. In 2012, the Cougars switched to the Western Athletic Conference for a season. This year, the team will spend the 2013 season in the Pacific Coast Softball Conference before making its final switch to the West Coast Conference in 2014. Softball will be the WCC's 14th sport.

HITTING STREAKS

Three players for BYU have season-hitting streaks of seven games or more including freshman outfielder Gordy Bravo, junior infielder Katie Manuma and senior shortstop JC Clayton.

Bravo hales from Upland, Calif. and is currently hitting .424 for the Cougars with 11 RBI, four doubles and 10 runs scored. She is currently on a two-game hitting streak, but her career and season high is eight games.

Manuma has had hits in all but five games this season. Her seven-game hitting streak, which is a career high, was from Feb. 9-Feb. 21. Manuma has also hit a home run in every tournament so far this season, including a grand slam against UC Santa Barbara in the Mary Nutter Classic.

Clayton leads the team with a 19-game hitting streak, which surpasses her former career-high of 15 games. She is currently hitting a .457 clip with a team-high 32 hits and 13 runs scored. She is tied for the second-best streak in PCSC history and is two games away from tying the record.

GRAND OLE' SLAM

Junior infielder Katie Manuma hit her first career grand slam against UC Santa Barbara at the Mary Nutter Classic. Down 10-3 in the bottom of the seventh inning, the Cougars rallied to score three runs and bring up Manuma with the bases loaded. Manuma took advantage with a bomb that tied up the game at 10-10 and sent the game into extra-innings. BYU wasn't able to keep the momentum in the eight and surrendered two runs to the Gauchos for the 12-10 loss. This was BYU's first grand slam of the season and Manuma's third home run.

Manuma is currently hitting .311 with 11 runs scored, 20 RBI and 32 total bases. Manuma has hit a home run in every tournament of the season so far, leading the team and conference with four.

RANKED OPPONENTS

The BYU softball team faced a ranked opponent in each of the team's first three tournaments. This tournament will be its first without facing a ranked team.

The Cougars have an all-time record of 30-61 against ranked opponents under head coach Gordon Eakin. This year BYU won one and lost two against ranked opponents No. 6 Tennessee, No. 20 Hawai'i and No. 10/11 LSU.

In its first tournament of the season in St. George, Utah, the Cougars played No. 6 Tennessee and fell to the Lady Vols 6-3. A three-run rally in the seventh inning wasn't enough to give the Cougars the win.

At the Easton Desert Classic in Las Vegas the Cougars faced their second ranked opponent in as many weeks. BYU held on to upset No. 20 Hawai'i 4-2 behind the bats of Lacey Millett and Katie Manuma.

The Cougars faced No. 10/11 LSU in the Mary Nutter Classic. BYU was down 6-2 heading into the bottom of the sixth, but rallied to tie up the game. However, LSU dealt a blow to the Cougars in the top of the seventh with a grand slam to take the 10-6 lead. The Tigers held the lead through the bottom to take the victory.

BYU head coach Gordon Eakin

Eakin is entering his 11th season as the Cougars' head coach and his 14th season at BYU overall.

Eakin was named head coach in July 2002 after working as an assistant coach since the softball program's inception in 2000. Since that time he has led the Cougars to five Mountain West Conference championships, one Western Athletic Conference tournament championship and eight NCAA tournament appearances.

As MWC Coach of the Year three-straight years (2009, 2010, 2011) he has coached eleven All-Americans, seven MWC Players of the Year, one WAC Player of the Year, three MWC Freshmen of the Year and two MWC Pitchers of the Year during his tenure.

In 2010, Eakin guided the Cougars to 46 wins, the most in school history, as BYU advanced to the NCAA Super Regionals for the first time ever with wins over East Carolina and host Texas before ending its season at national runner-up Arizona. The Cougars finished second in the country in batting average, seventh in scoring and ninth in slugging percentage as a team last season.

Known as one of the best hitting coaches in the country, Eakin has helped BYU finish in the top-ten nationally six times in slugging percentage, six times in home runs per game, four times in batting average and four times in scoring.

In addition to his duties at BYU, Eakin has also been an assistant coach and the hitting coach for the USA National Team since 2009. In the summer of 2010, Eakin helped guide the National Team to a 17-2 record as USA won the World Championship in Venezuela, the World Cup in Oklahoma and the Japan Cup championship in Sendai, Japan.

Before entering the coaching ranks, Eakin was a successful baseball and softball player. After playing collegiate baseball at the University of Utah, Eakin signed with the Oakland Athletics organization where he played for three years.

Eakin went on to join the United States All-Star team, playing in three U.S. Olympic sports festivals in 1986, 1993 and 1994, winning bronze, silver and gold, respectively. While on the team, Eakin was honored on the ISC All-World First Team and was an ASA All-American. He would later go on to play shortstop on the internationally ranked Larry H. Miller Toyota Fast Pitch team, eventually earning induction into the Utah Fast Pitch Hall of Fame in 1998.

Eakin is a native of Holladay, Utah, and graduated from Granite High. He currently resides in Sandy, Utah, and is married to Barbi. They are the parents of three children (Alicia, Ryan & Parker) and have four grandsons.

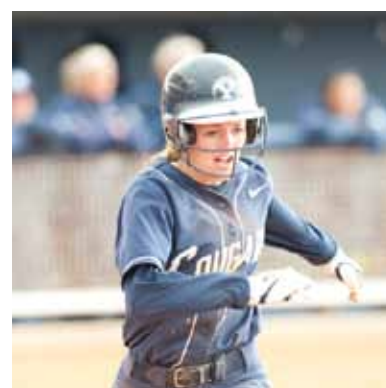
