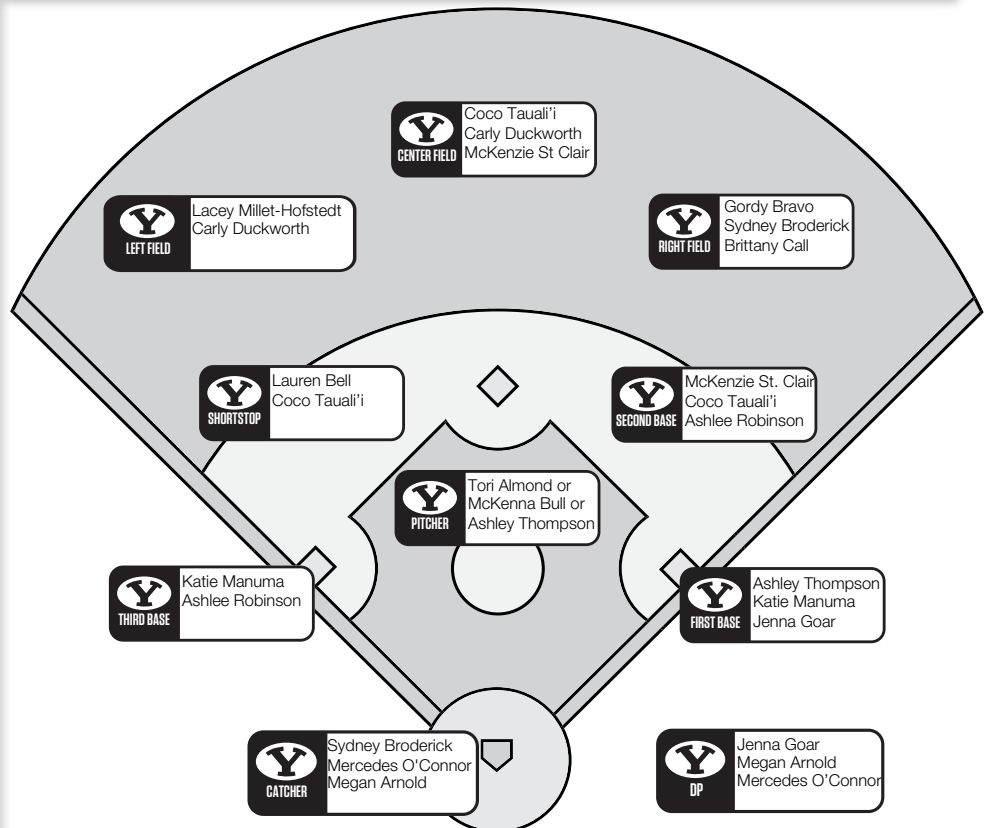

BY THE NUMBERS

- 3** After last week's series against Idaho State, BYU jumped back into the top 100 in three categories. They are No. 80 in home runs per game (0.78), No. 90 in fielding percentage (.963) and No. 90 in scoring (4.88).
- 4** Sydney Broderick picked up BYU's fourth WCC Player of the Week award this season. She hit .600 with two home runs and two triples last week. She joins McKenzie St. Clair who won the award for week one and Katie Manuma who won in week's two and four.
- 13** McKenna Bull is 13 strikeouts from passing Christie Zinanti for second on the freshman strikeout charts. She finished with 20 strikeouts last week in 17.1 innings to give her 107 on the season. In order to have a top 10 strikeout season she will need 83 strikeouts over the final 22 games.
- 40** BYU currently has a total of 40 wins against WCC opponents. They have the best record against Saint Mary's at 8-0. Last year the Cougars played against all WCC teams except Pacific earning a combined record of 14-2. The Cougars have been most competitive with San Diego and Loyola Marymount, holding a record of 9-3 against the Toreros and a 12-4 record against the Lions.

OPPONENT NOTES**UTAH STATE**

After opening MWC play with a home sweep of Colorado State to cap off an eight game winning streak, Utah State lost four consecutive contests on the road to SUU and Fresno State.

Freshman Victoria Saucedo leads the Aggies from the plate in almost every offensive category with a .344 batting average, five doubles, four home runs, 18 runs and 16 RBIs. Junior Hailey Froton has four home runs and 16 RBIs of her own while Paxton Provost has three home runs and 16 RBIs.

Sophomore Noelle Johnson is the ace in the circle for Utah State with a 12-10 record, a 2.57 ERA and 149 strikeouts.

LAST TIME OUT

PROVO, Utah – After falling behind 10-0 in the first game, the BYU softball team made its largest ever comeback in team history to win 11-10 over Idaho State and followed up with a 9-2 win to complete the sweep on Saturday.

"I told the team that today was sort of a defining moment for us," BYU softball coach Gordon Eakin said. "The first three innings of the first game looked like it was very defining, but I'm proud of them because they didn't quit and we found a way to fight and come back and win. I think that was a test of character, so that was a nice moment for us."

Freshman Sydney Broderick was a perfect 3-for-3 in the first game, nearly hitting for the cycle with a home run, triple and 3 RBIs. She followed with a 2-for-3 performance in the second game with another triple and an RBI. Redshirt freshman McKenzie St. Clair was 5-for-7 on the day with five RBIs, a double and three runs. Freshman McKenna Bull also had a strong outing despite being sick. She had a save in the first game and won the second game going all seven innings with nine strikeouts and allowing only two hits.

Trailing 10-7 in the fifth of the first game, the Cougars (13-19) produced four runs on three hits to win the game. Broderick, who had a two-run homer in the third batted 3-for-3 and Lacey Millett Hofstedt and St. Clair (4 RBI) were each 3-for-4 for the Cougars.

IN THE RECORD BOOKS

McKenna Bull is third in strikeouts for a freshman at BYU with 107. With 13 more strikeouts she will pass up Christie Zinanti for third all-time. She is on pace to break the freshman record held by Paige Affleck (134) by the end of the year. She needs 82 strikeouts to tie Daniela Urincho Snow for the tenth best strikeout season at BYU.

Pitcher Tori Almond is fourth in career wins (44), third in career strikeouts (428) and fourth in career shutouts (10). With one more win she will tie Summer Tobias for third all-time. She is BYU's career leader in lowest opponent batting average allowed at .206 ahead of Paige Affleck (.211). Almond also pitched the first no-hitter of her career on May 4, 2013. This marked the 15th no-hitter in BYU history.

It took Sydney Broderick eight weeks to get the first home run of her career, a lead-off solo shot to center field against Idaho State on Friday. She got her second the very next game with a two-run homer over the scoreboard in left field on Saturday.

She also added two triples in those games to tie Megan Fogelsong of Pacific for the conference lead. In the first game Saturday, Broderick was one double away from becoming the first softball player to ever hit for the cycle.

WEST COAST CONFERENCE PITCHER OF THE WEEK

MCKENNA BULL, FR., RHP, BYU

Freshman RHP McKenna Bull led BYU to wins over No. 2/3 Oregon and Idaho State this past week pitching 17.1 innings with 20 strikeouts and a 2.42 ERA. She pitched 6.1 innings against the Ducks with five strikeouts and giving up three earned runs. Despite being sick on Saturday, Bull came in to get the save in BYU's 11-10 victory over Idaho State before holding the nation's No. 11 scoring offense to two runs and striking out nine in a complete game 9-2 victory.

WEST COAST CONFERENCE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

SYDNEY BRODERICK, FR., C/O, BYU

Freshman C Sydney Broderick led BYU at the plate hitting .600 in four games with two home runs, two triples, five RBIs, four runs and four walks. In the second game against Idaho State on Saturday, Broderick was a perfect 3-for-3 with a home run, a triple and three RBIs helping the Cougars overcome a 10-0 deficit. With the tying run at first in the top of the seventh, Broderick caught the runner stealing for the final out of the game to seal the win. In the next game, she went 2-for-3 with an RBI and a triple in a 9-2 victory.

PRESEASON POLLS

PROVO, Utah – West Coast Conference coaches selected BYU as the favorite to win the conference's first softball regular-season championship and selected three Cougars to the preseason all-conference team.

"As a program we feel honored to be selected as the preseason conference champions," BYU head coach Gordon Eakin said. "There are a number of excellent teams in the WCC that are worthy of that same selection, and we will do our best to live up to the high expectations this season."

Last year the Cougars won the Pacific Coast Softball Conference in a tight contest that went down to the last week of conference play. BYU has won five straight conference championships and has a 40-9 record against WCC opponents. This will be the fourth different conference the Cougars have played in over the last four years.
